Significant Incidents or Threats:

Red Flag Warnings – UT and WY

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Remnants of Fifteen FINAL; Disturbance 1: Medium (50%)
- Eastern Pacific: Potential Tropical Cyclone Seventeen-E; Disturbance 1: Low (30%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests


Tropical Outlook – Atlantic


Remnants of Fifteen (Advisory #7 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT) FINAL

- 90 miles N of Cabo Verde Islands
- Moving NW at 8 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 30 mph
- TD Fifteen has dissipated and this is last public advisory

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located just offshore of the coast of southern Mexico in the Bay of Campeche
- A subtropical cyclone could form late this week over the western or central Gulf of Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (30%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (50%)





Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




Potential Tropical Cyclone Seventeen-E (Advisory #2A as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- 30 miles SSW of Salinas Cruz, Mexico
- Moving NW at 13 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- Expected to move inland over southeastern Mexico during the next several hours

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- 1,200 miles SW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula, Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)








Precipitation Forecast















