

# **FEMA Daily Operations Briefing** Friday, October 25, 2019 8:30 a.m. EDT

### National Current Operations & Monitoring



#### Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Kincade Fire CA; Tick Fire CA
- Elevated/Critical/Extreme fire weather CA
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible Lower Mississippi Valley

#### **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1 (70%); Disturbance 2 (20%)
- Eastern Pacific: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

#### Food, Water, Sheltering:


• Two shelters open with 138 occupants (ARC Midnight shelter count as of 6:08 am EDT)

 Geyser Geothermal Power Plant; two of the power units have received some damage, additional details are unknown



# **Tropical Outlook Atlantic**


#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located over the western Gulf of Mexico
- Could become a short-lived tropical depression before it merges with a cold front later today
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (70%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (70%)

### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. EDT)

- Located few hundred miles SW of the western Azores
- Moving ENE
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)
