- Severe thunderstorms possible Mid-Atlantic
- Heavy snow possible Central Rockies and Central Plains

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Tropical Storm Pablo
- Eastern Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests






Tropical Storm Pablo (Advisory #7 as of 5:00 a.m. EDT)


- 400 miles ENE of Lajes Air Base in the Azores










Severe Weather Outlook










Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall















6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




