### WHAT IS THIS OPPORTUNITY?

# In Spring 2019, 332 Indiana educators participated in scoring the ILEARN tests!

Many educators shared positive feedback about this process; it enabled them to learn more about the scoring process and obtain hands-on experience.

The American Institutes for Research (AIR) and Measurement Incorporated (MI) are recruiting Indiana educators to be involved in the scoring process for the upcoming ILEARN assessment in Spring 2020.

## WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

- Currently employed as an educator at an accredited Indiana school
- Currently licensed by State of Indiana (e.g., instructional, administrative, school services)
- Access to a computer/online device that meets the minimum technical requirements, high-speed internet access, and a secure work area
- Demonstrate ability to apply scoring criteria as directed and maintain consistent and reliable scoring throughout the project
- Willing to engage in a repetitive task situation and maintain confidentiality

#### WHAT IS THE REQUIRED COMMITMENT AND PAY RATE?

#### **Work Hours and Commitment:**

- Teachers
  - Evening Shift
    - 6 p.m. 10 p.m. ET
  - Required Commitment:
    - Three nights per week for three weeks
  - \$16.00 hourly rate
- Instructional Coaches
  - Dav Shift
    - 8:30 a.m. 4:15 p.m.
  - Required Commitment:
    - Three to four total days
  - \$16.00 hourly rate
