- Heavy Rain and Flash Flooding possible – TX, OK, AR, & MO

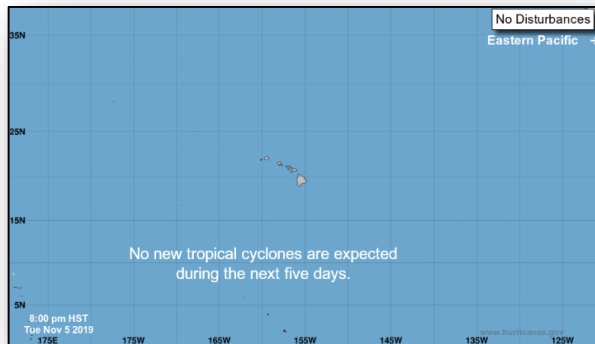
Tropical Activity:

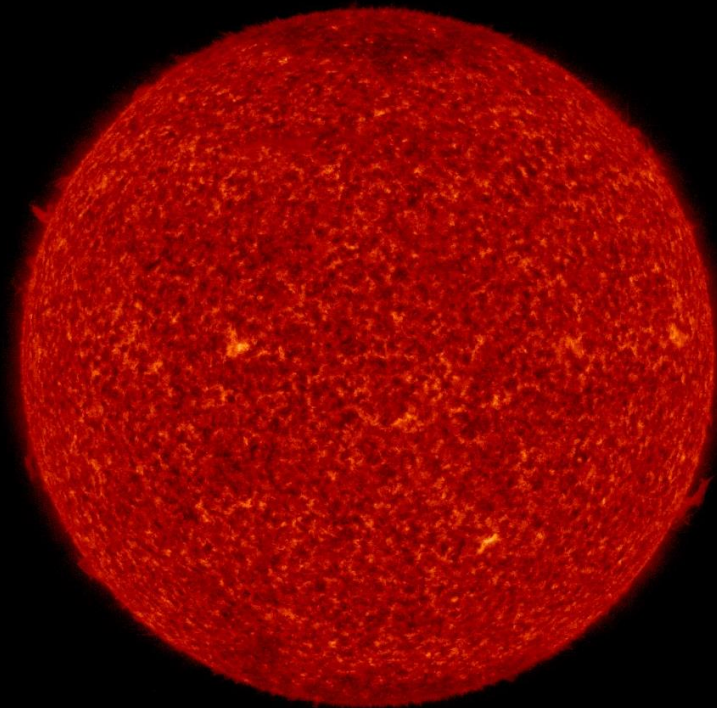

National Weather Forecast



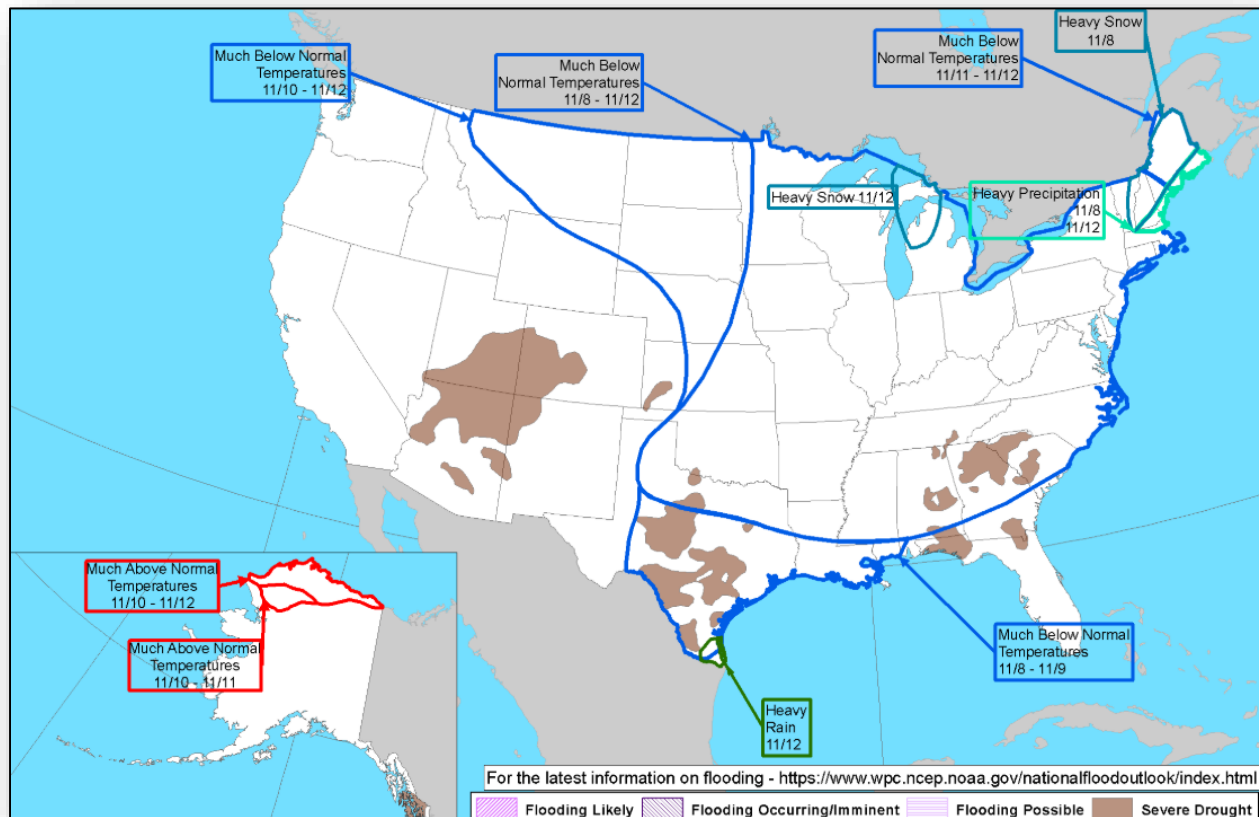
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

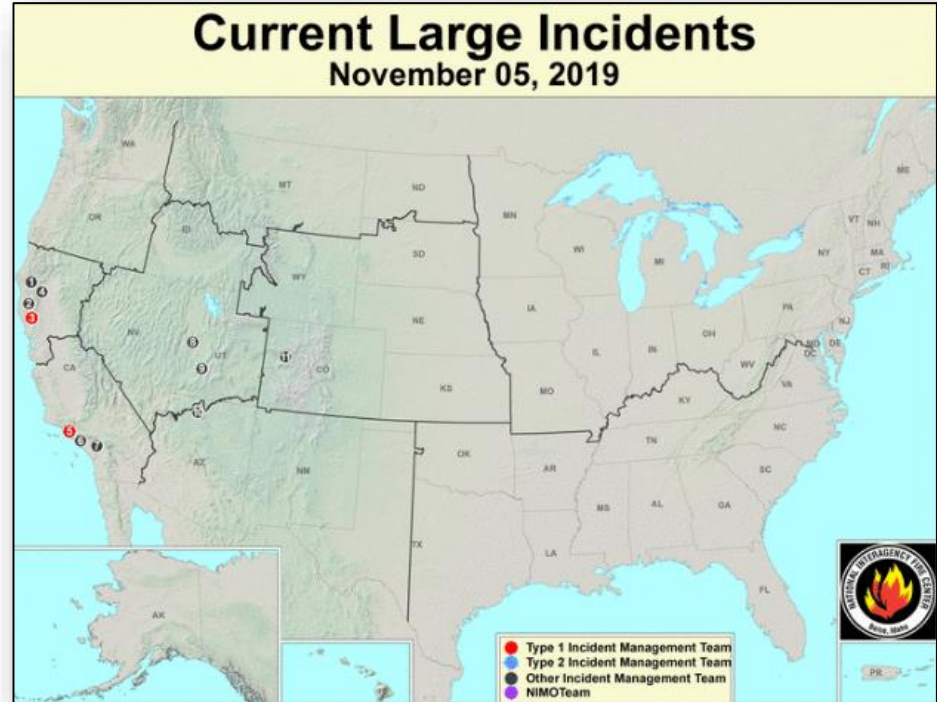
