

#### Disturbance 1 (as of 7:00 am EST)

- Several hundred miles S of the southern tip of the Baja California, Mexico
- · Moving slowly N
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (80%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (80%)

#### Disturbance 2 (as of 1:00 am EST)


- Several hundred miles WSW of Baja California, Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (Near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (Near 0%)

### Tropical Outlook – Pacific

#### **Tropical Storm Fengshen** (Warning #12 as of 5:00 a.m. EST)

- Located about 320 miles NE of Guam; 105 miles **ESE** of Alamagan
- Moving west at 17 mph
- Maximum winds of 65 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend 105 miles
- Expected to strengthen becoming a typhoon shortly after it passes the Marianas
- Typhon Warning in effect for northern CNMI, expected early Friday morning
- CPA:
  - 9 miles to Alamagan Nov 14, 10 a.m. EST
  - 24 miles to Pagan Nov 14, 11 a.m. EST
  - 67 miles to Agrihan Nov 14, 12 p.m. EST







Potential track area:

#### National Weather Forecast









#### Forecast Lows/Wind Chills


