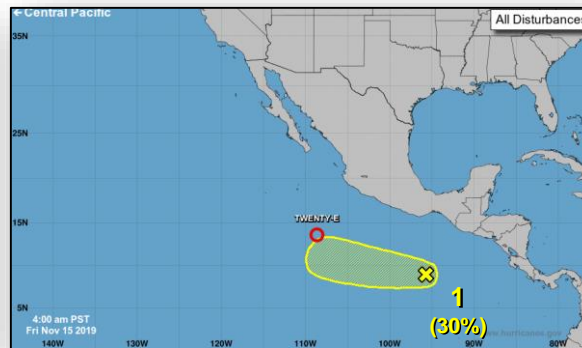
- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days

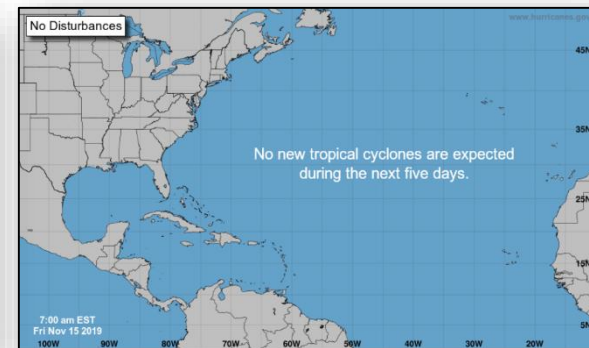

- Expected to become a tropical storm today

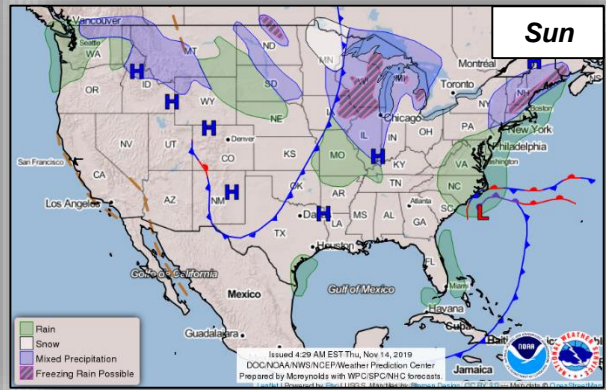
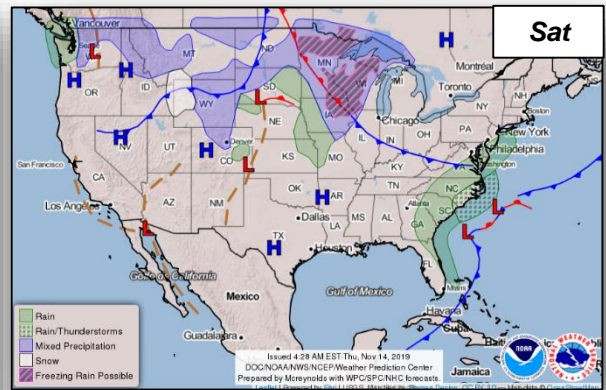
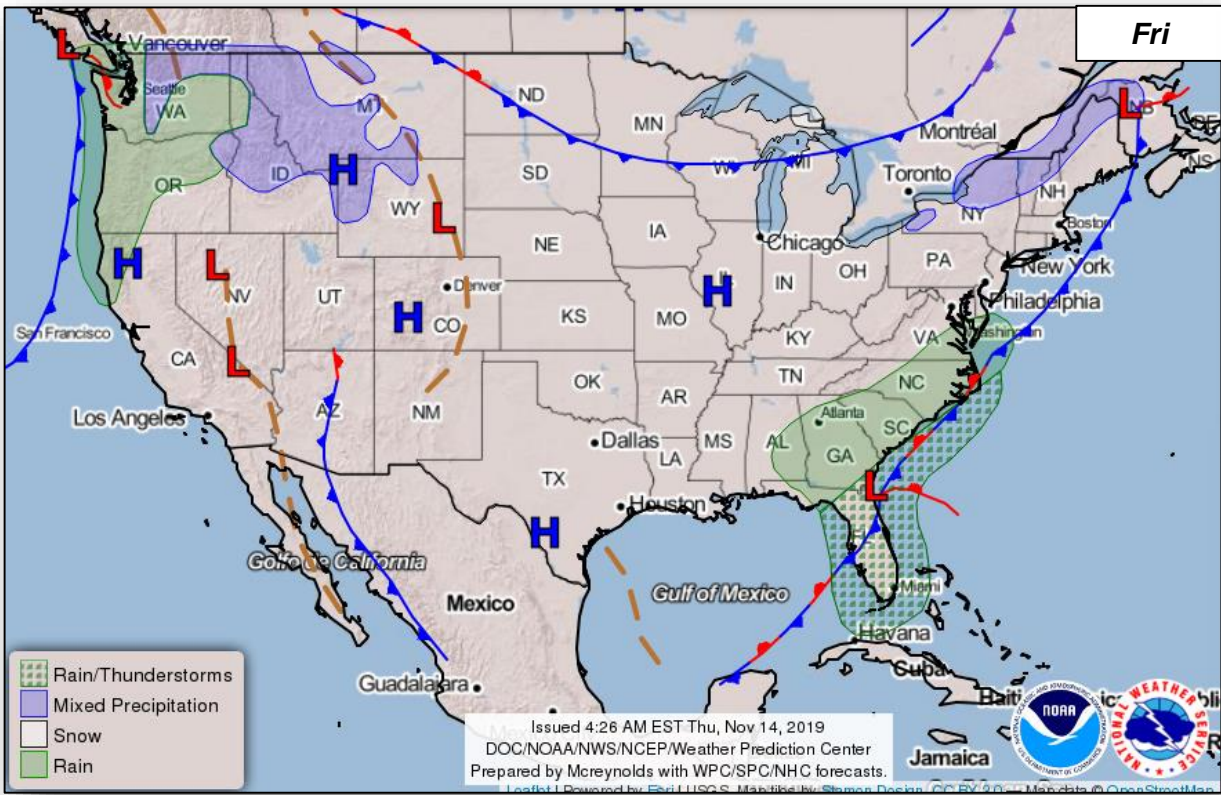

- Formation chance next 5 days: Low (30%)

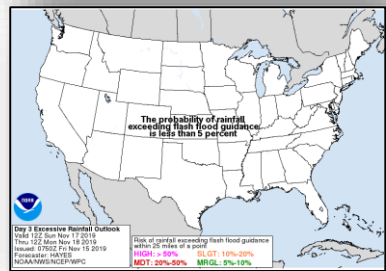
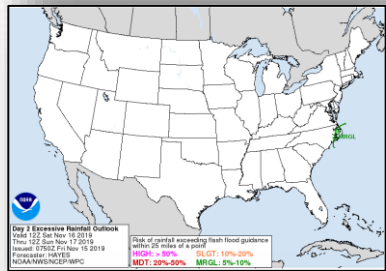
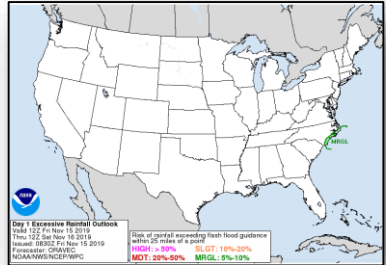
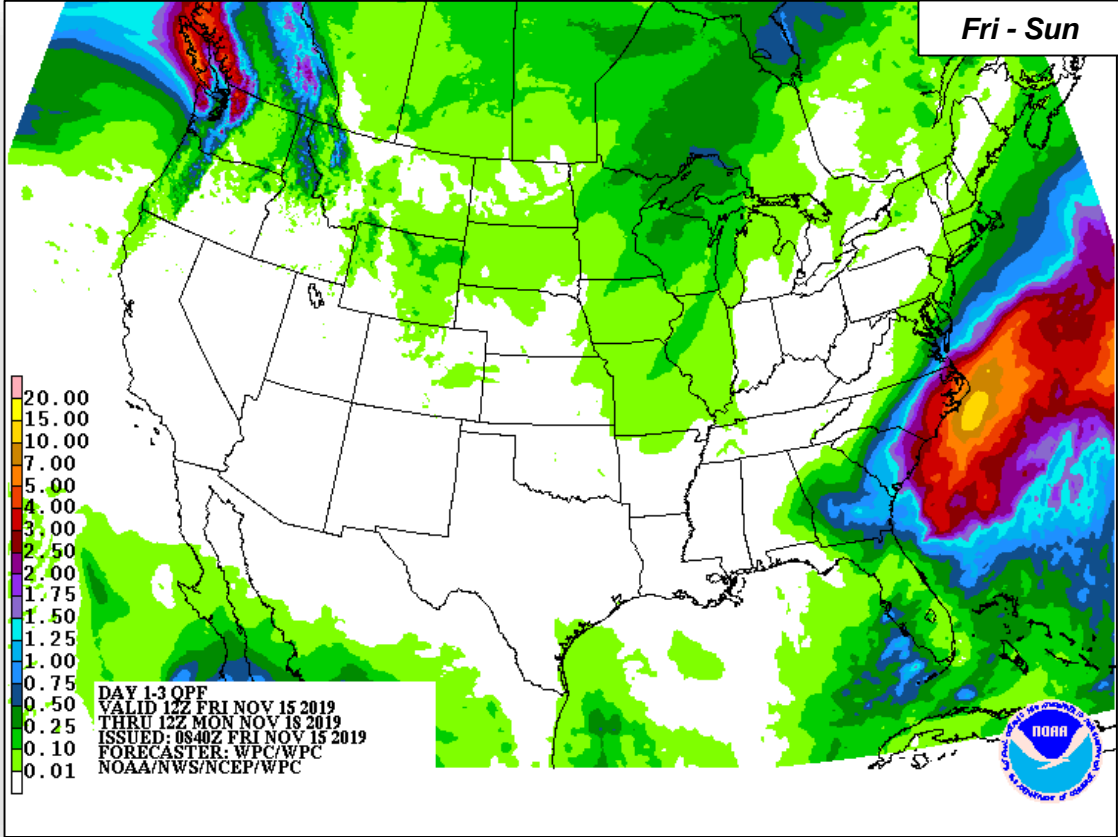

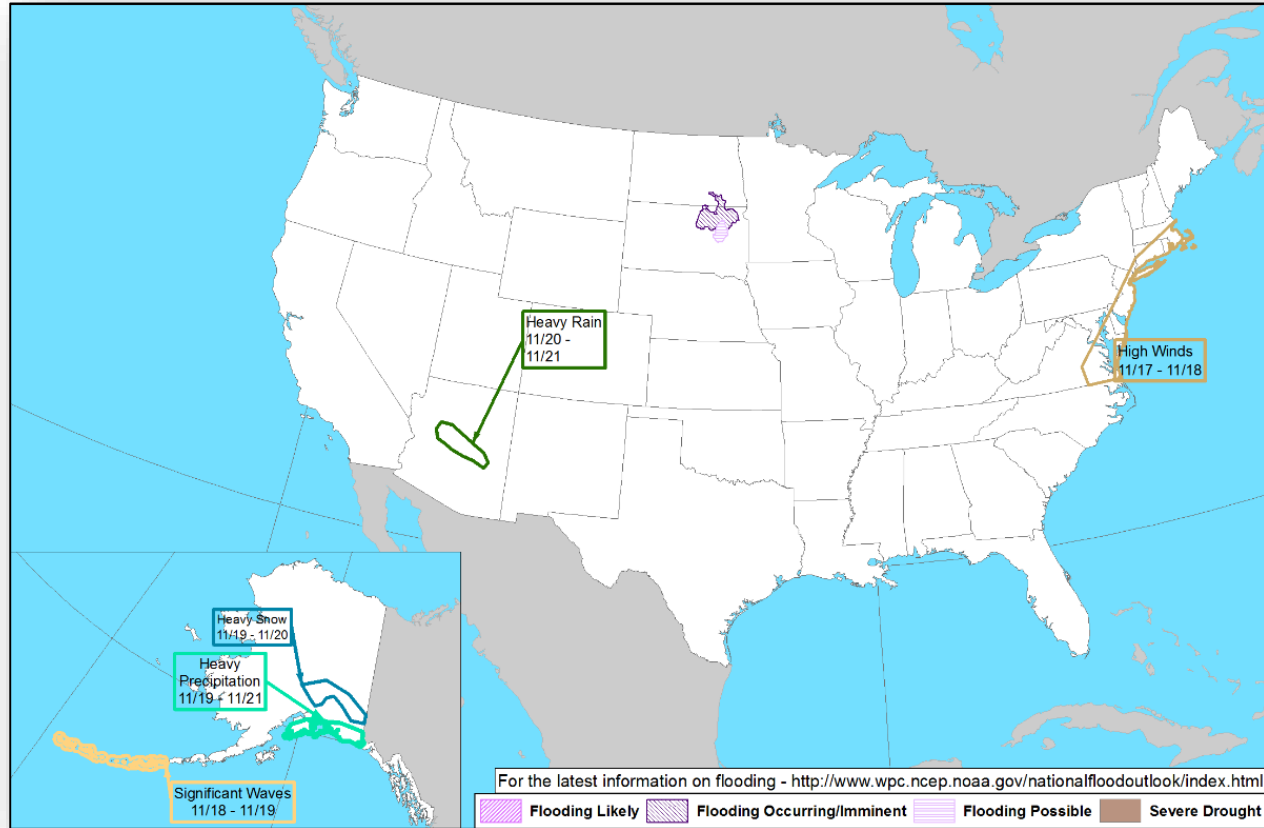
