- Critical Fire Weather/Red Flag Warnings Southern CA


Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1: Low (30%)
- Eastern Pacific: Tropical Depression Raymond; Tropical Depression Twenty-One-E
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests


Eastern Pacific

Tropical Depression Raymond (Advisory #10 as of 4:00 a.m. EST)

- 390 miles SSW of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving N at 9 mph
- Maximum winds 55 mph
- Expected to become a remnant low Sunday night or early Monday

Tropical Depression Twenty-One-E (Advisory #5 as of 4:00 a.m. EST)

- About 535 miles S of Zihuatanejo, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 8 mph
- Maximum winds 45 mph
- Expected to dissipate in next few days










Severe Weather Outlook












6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability


