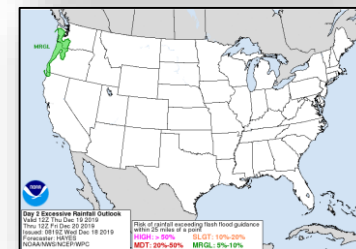
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



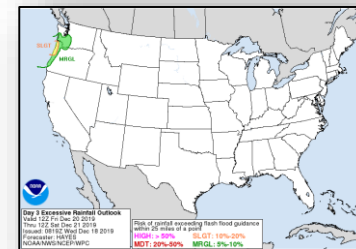
