COVID-19 Update

FEMA

<u>Situation:</u> FEMA and HHS continue to work requirements supporting state, tribal, and territorial requests.


- All 50 states, the District of Columbia, 5 territories, and 20(+2) tribal nations are working directly with FEMA under the nationwide emergency declaration (COVID-19 SLB, as of 5:00 p.m. ET Apr 1)
- FEMA is working with HHS to allocate and deliver key resources from the Strategic National Stockpile, and coordinating with USACE on the build-out of alternate care sites with significant expansion capability
- FEMA continues to work with industry partners on producing, allocating, and distributing PPE and ventilators as quickly as possible
- FEMA Regional Administrators, governors, tribal leaders, state emergency managers, and state public health officials continue to fight the COVID-19 pandemic

State / Local Response:

- All State / Territory EOCs activated
- 31 (+1) states and 12 tribes have issued shelter-in-place orders (COVID-19 SLB, as of 5:00 p.m. ET Apr 2)
- 4 additional Major Disaster Declaration Requests submitted (MS, NM, OK, SD)
- National Guard Bureau (COVID-19 SLB, as of 5:00 p.m. ET Apr 1)
 - o Title 32 Status Approved 14
 - Title 32 Status Requested 27

FEMA / Federal Response:

- · NRCC: Level I in unified effort with HHS SOC; All RRCCs activated
- IMAT-A teams deployed to 26 states; 37 LNOs deployed to state, territories, and tribes
- Casualty Management Task Force (CMTF) activated within the NRCC, consisting of subject matter experts from HHS, FEMA, DOD, ESF14, and ESF-15
- USNS Comfort arrived in NYC: 2 beds filled; USNS Mercy hospital ship is in Port of Long Beach, CA: 12 beds filled (HHS/FEMA COVID-19 SLB, as of 5:00 p.m. ET Apr 2)
- 35 (+3) Major Disaster Declarations approved and 14 (+1) Major Disaster Declarations in process
- · Eight task forces, jointly led by HHS and FEMA, continue work on assigned focus areas
- DoD deployed two Navy Expeditionary Medical facilities; one each to TX and LA (USNORTHCOM, as of 2:59 p.m. ET Mar 30)






National Weather Forecast










Hazards Outlook – Apr 5-9









