COVID-19 Update



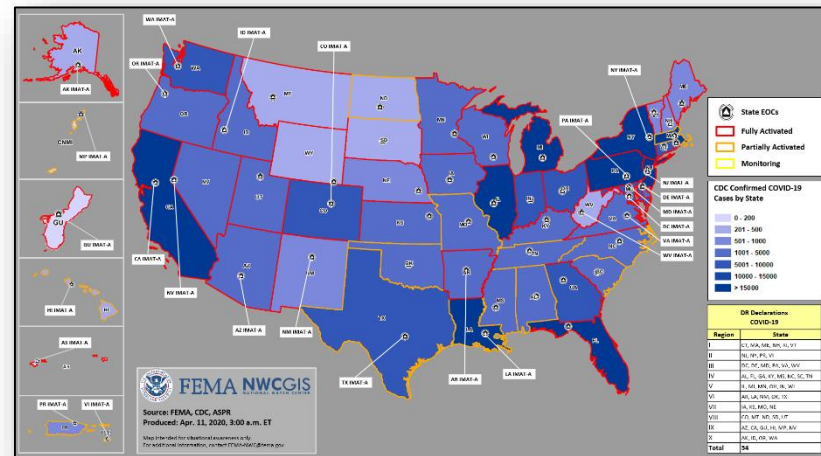
Situation: FEMA, HHS, and federal partners are working with state, local, tribe, and territorial governments to execute a whole-of-America response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The federal government is coordinating the deployment of PPE and ventilators from multiple sources including SNS, donations, and vendor procurements. These shipments are being sent nationwide with prioritization given to areas in greatest need.

State / Local Response: (COVID-19 SLB, 12:00 p.m. ET Apr 10)

- All State / Territory EOCs activated
- 42 states, D.C., 4 territories and 36 (+5) tribes issued shelter-in-place orders
- National Guard Bureau
 - Title 32 Status approved: 38
 - Title 32 Status requested: 11

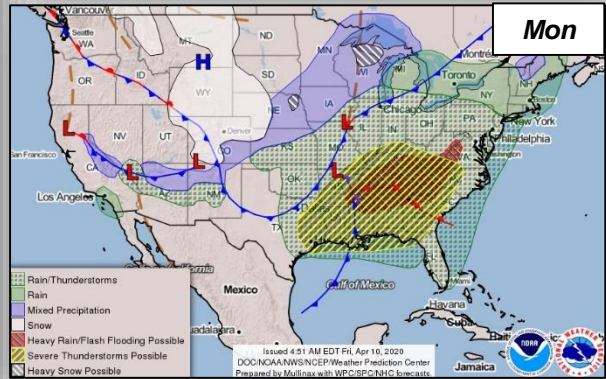
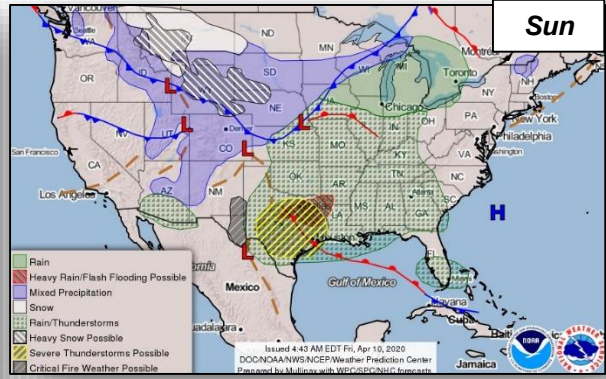
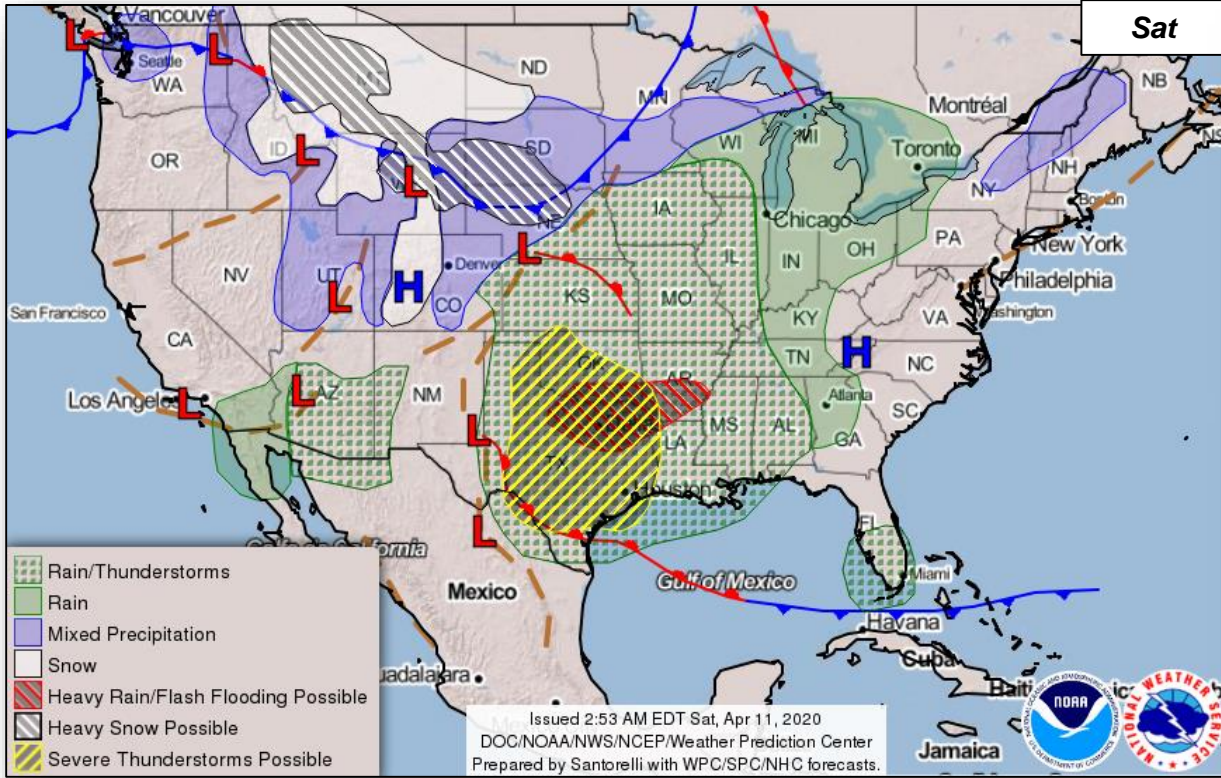
- NRCC: Level I in unified effort with HHS SOC; all RRCCs activated
- IMAT-A teams deployed to 26 states; 37 LNOs deployed: states, territories, and tribes
- 54 (+2) Major Disaster Declarations approved and 1 (-2) Disaster Declarations in process
- Second distribution of Hydroxychloroquine tablets shipped April 9: 1M to Veterans Affairs; 1M to DoD; 100K to Detroit; and 8M to St. Louis; Philadelphia; Pittsburg; Baltimore; Washington D.C.; Milwaukee; Miami; Houston; Indianapolis; and Baton Rouge (SC TF Update, April 10, 2020, 10:38 a.m. ET)
- 26 Airbridge flights complete; Airbridge flight #24 landed in NYC April 8; cargo: 7,770,000 gloves; #25 landed in Chicago April 9; cargo: 21, 555,000 gloves; #26 landed in Dallas April 9; cargo: 25,350,000 gloves; 54 remaining flights scheduled (SC TF Update, April 10, 2020, 10:38 a.m. ET)
- TX: 225 medical personnel Expeditionary Medical Facility deployed to support Kay Bailey Hutchinson Convention Center, Dallas, TX; Operations expected to begin April 12 (DoD Update, April 10, 2020, 1:27 p.m. ET)
- NJ: Two UAMTFs arrived to augment ACS Edison April 9; UAMTF for Atlantic City awaiting deployment (DoD Update, April 10, 2020, 1:27 p.m. ET)

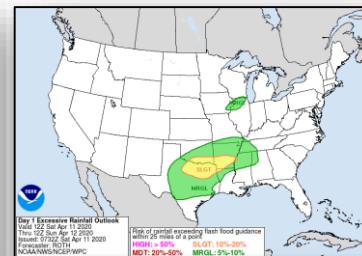
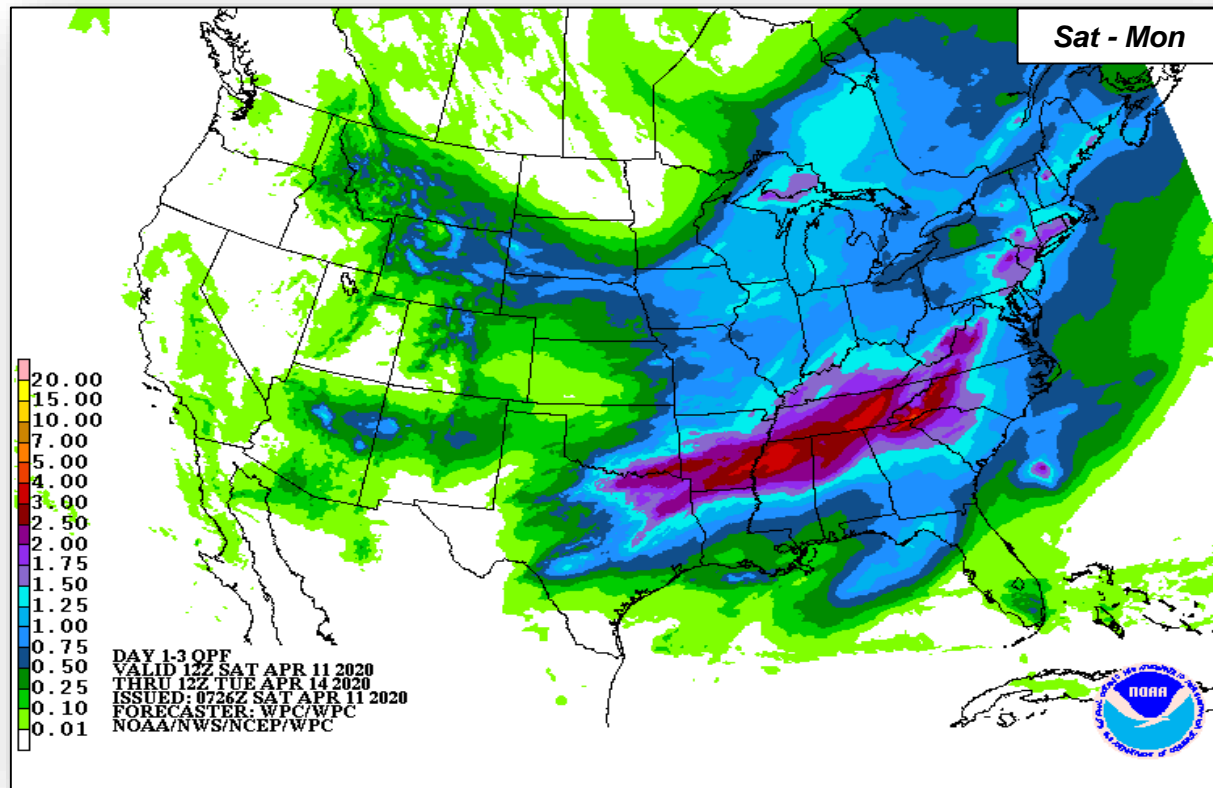
National Weather Forecast



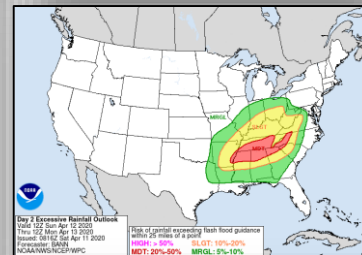
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



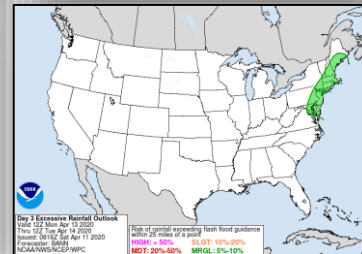

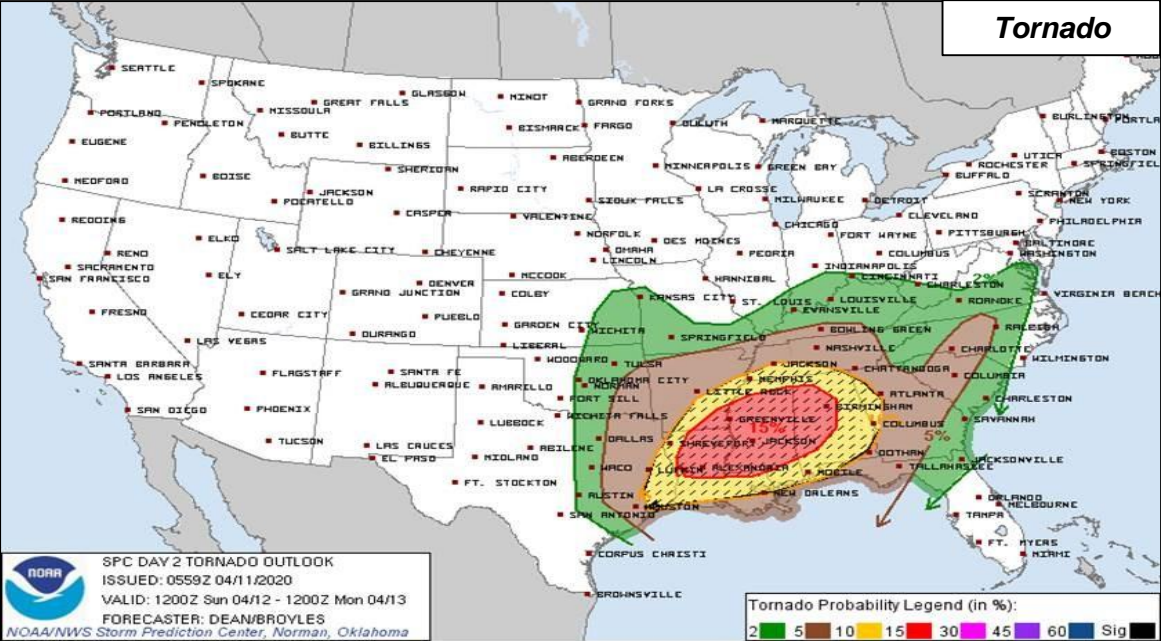
Severe Weather Outlook



Severe Weather Outlook Sunday Apr 12

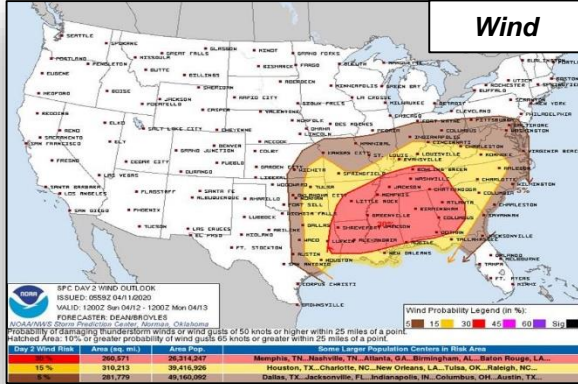

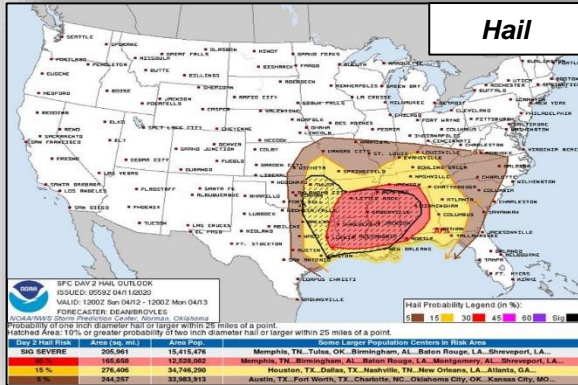

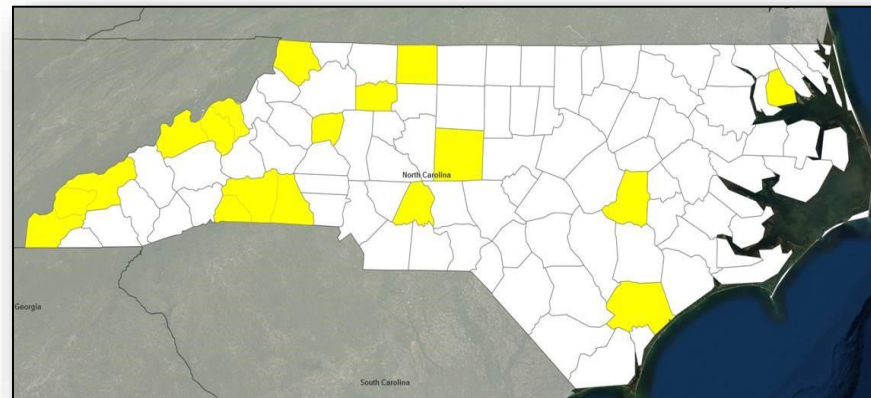
