Significant Incidents or Threats:

- COVID-19
- Severe thunderstorms possible – Southern/Central Plains to Mid-Atlantic and Southeast
- Flash flooding possible – Lower Mississippi Valley to Ohio Valley and Mid-Atlantic
- Heavy snow possible – Central Plains to Great Lakes

Declaration Activity:

- Approval: Major Disaster Declaration – Wyoming

COVID-19 Update



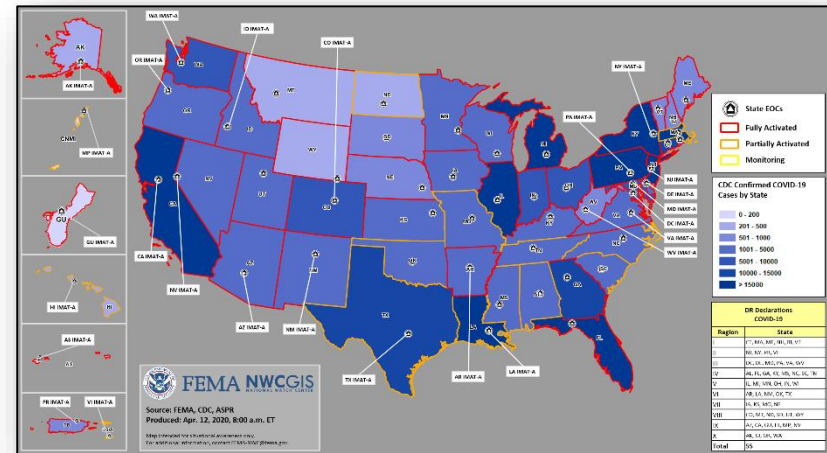
Situation: FEMA, HHS, and federal partners are working with state, local, tribe, and territorial governments to execute a whole-of-America response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The federal government is coordinating the deployment of PPE and ventilators from multiple sources including SNS, donations, and vendor procurements. These shipments are being sent nationwide with prioritization given to areas in greatest need.

State / Local Response:

- All State / Territory EOCs activated
- 42 states, D.C., 4 territories and 37 tribes issued shelter-in-place orders

FEMA / Federal Response: *(COVID-19 SLB, 5:00 p.m. ET, Apr 11)*

- NRCC: Level I in unified effort with HHS SOC; all RRCs activated
- IMAT-A teams deployed to 26 states; LNOs deployed to 37 states, territories, and tribes
- **55 (+1)** Major Disaster Declarations approved and **0 (-1)** Disaster Declarations in process
- **325** Individual Medical Area personnel (USN and USAF Reserves) deployed; **251** currently supporting 7 of 11 NYC hospitals; 18 en route to Philadelphia hospitals; 20 onboarding at Javits; 35 en route to NYC hospitals; 1 restriction of movement (non-COVID related)
- NYC: 4 Urban Augmentation Medical Task Forces (UAMTF) with 340 personnel to support JNYMS
- NJ: 1 UAMTF with 137 personnel deployed to augment ACS Edison, 1 will deploy to Atlantic City
- MI: ACS TCF Convention Center in Detroit began initial operations; 1 UAMTF with 85 personnel expected en route to Detroit; expected to begin treating patients April 12
- NYC: 3,519 National Guard activated; 169 confirmed positive for COVID-19; over 400 quarantined
- OH: Blood Center to work with hospitals in collecting plasma donations; anticipated testing of plasma transfusions for patients by end of April



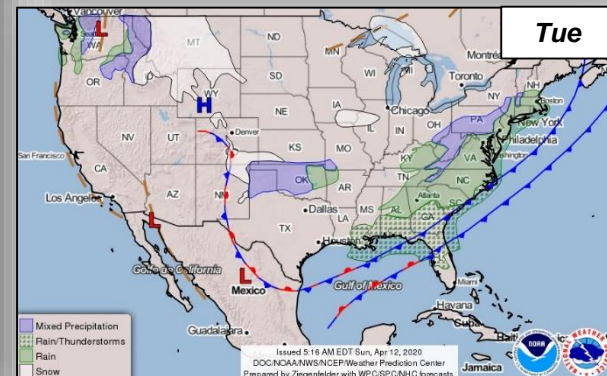
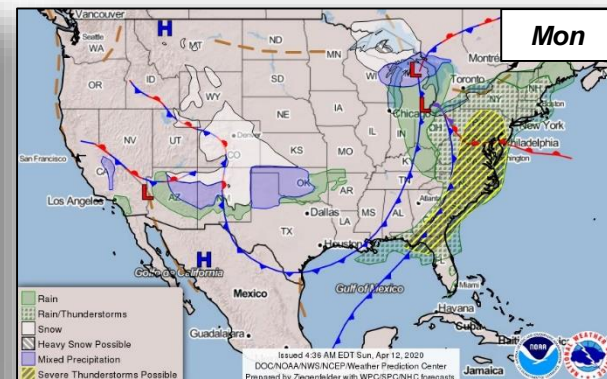
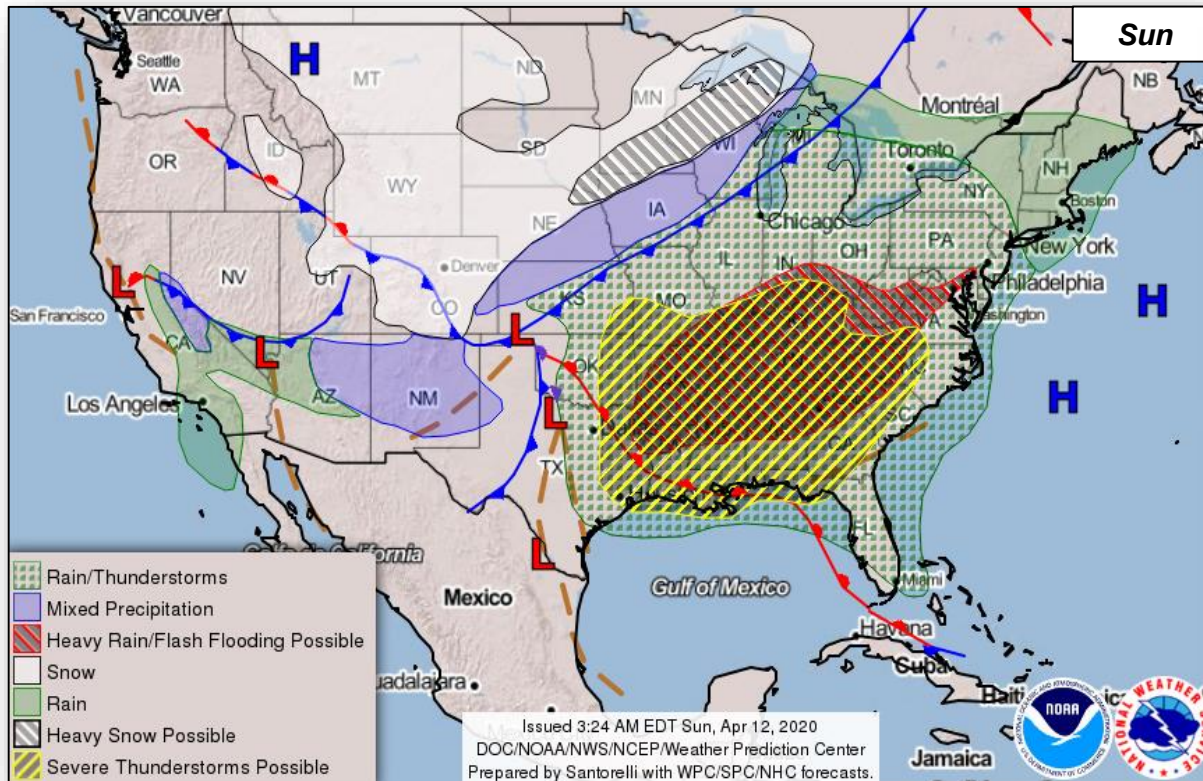

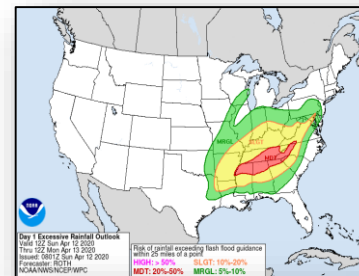

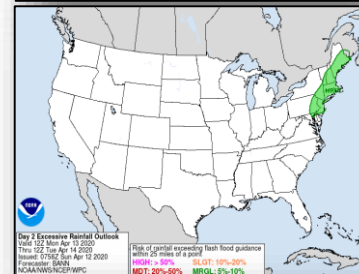
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



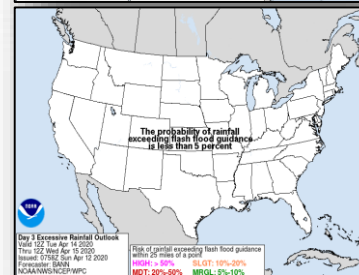

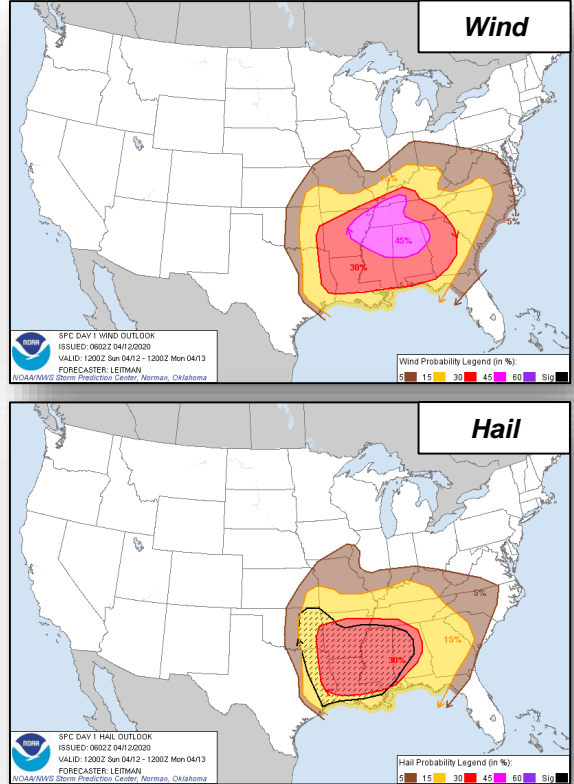
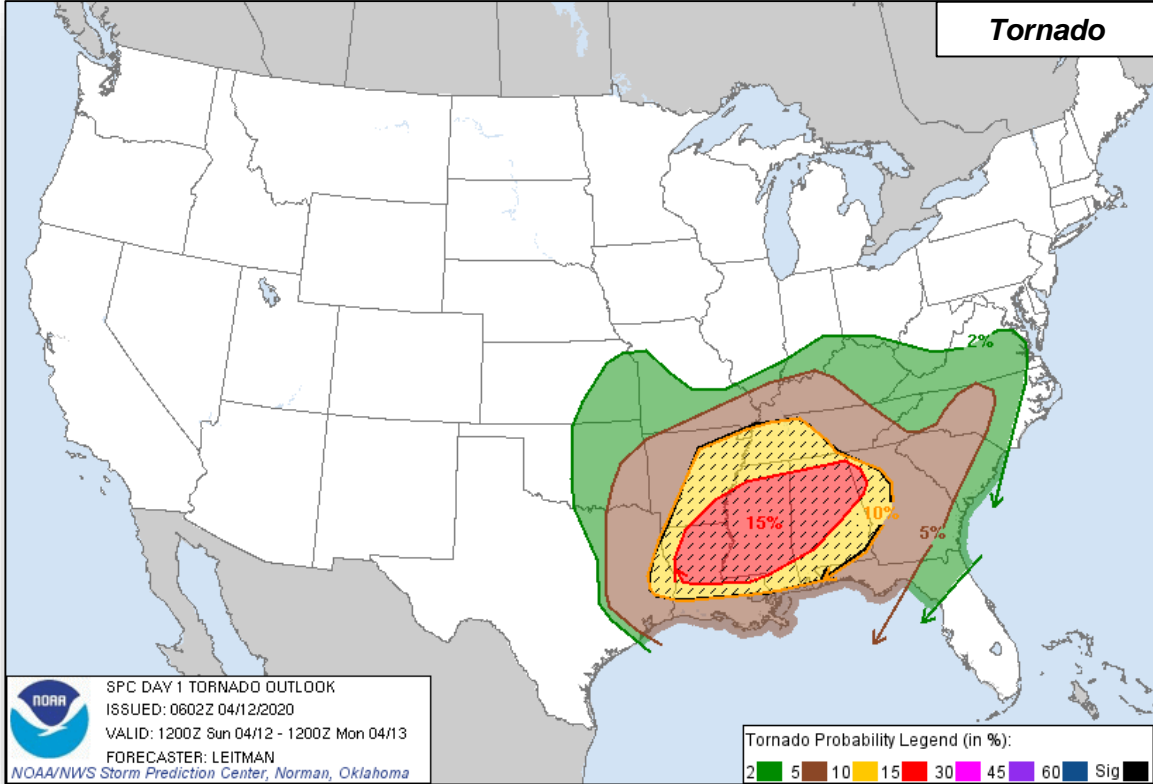

Severe Weather Outlook



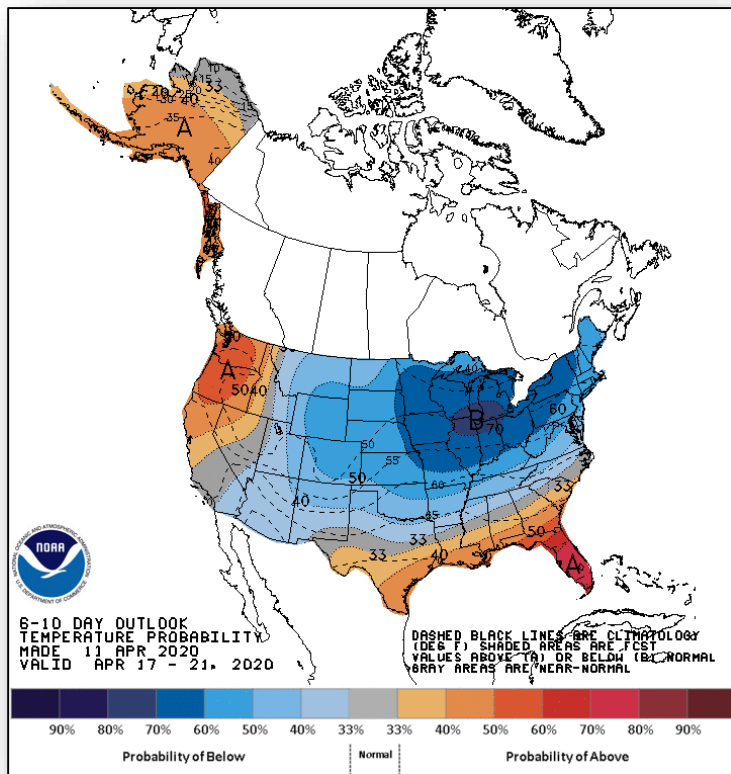
Severe Weather Outlook – Sunday Apr 12



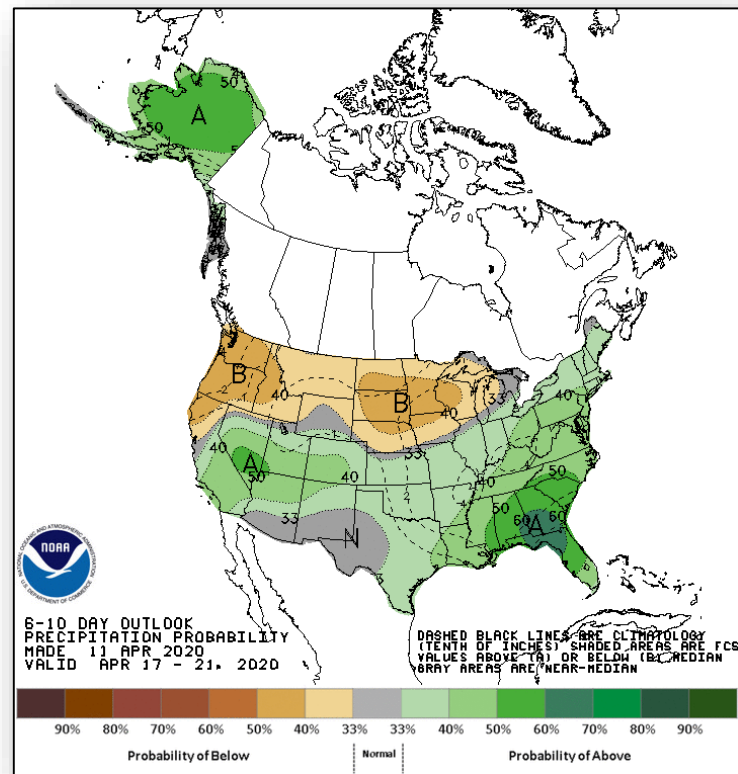
Long Range Outlooks – Apr 17-21

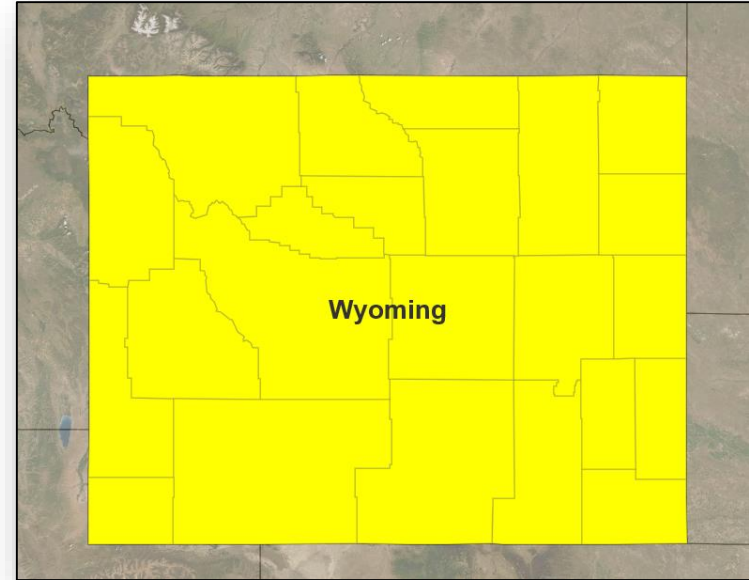
