COVID-19 Update



Situation: FEMA, HHS, and federal partners are working with state, local, tribe, and territorial governments to execute a whole-of-America response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The federal government is coordinating the deployment of PPE and ventilators from multiple sources including SNS, donations, and vendor procurements.

- FEMA NRCC remains at Level I in unified effort with HHS SOC; all FEMA RRCCs activated
- FEMA IMAT-A teams deployed to 27 states/territories; LNOs deployed to 37 states/territories
- 55 major disaster declarations approved; one major disaster declaration in process (AS)
- All State / Territory EOCs activated
- 33,706 FEMA, DOD, HHS, and CDC personnel deployed/activated in support of COVID-19

Health and Medical Lifeline:

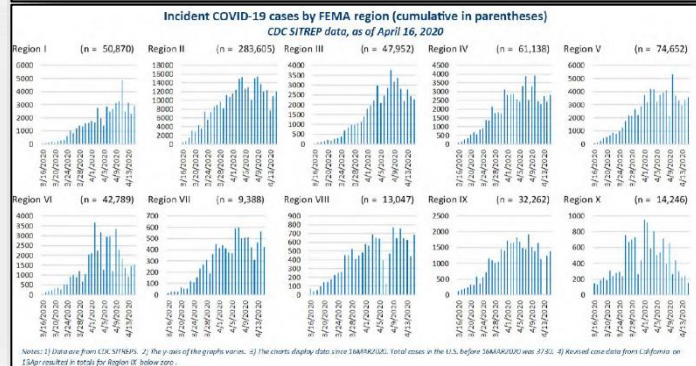
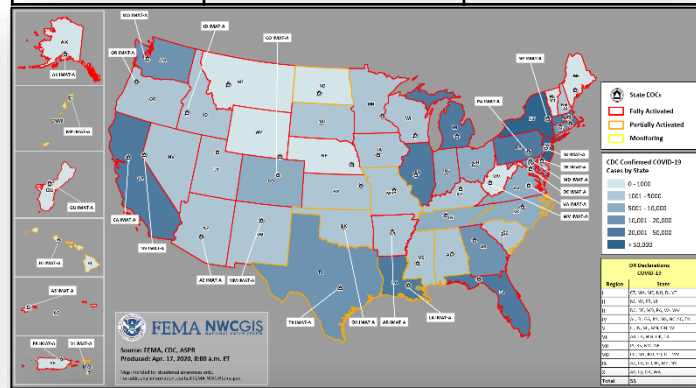
- **Testing:** NYC will begin antibody testing this week, prioritizing essential workers; State requested FDA to expedite approval of finger prick antibody test; expect capability to test up to 100k (target) individuals per day
- **Medical Supplies:** 600 ventilators to be delivered by June 1 to the Strategic National Stockpile; contract is for 30k ventilators by August 31

Operational Task Forces:

- **Medical Counter-Measure (MCM) Development:** new contract awarded to conduct a safety and efficiency trial to test hydroxychloroquine and intravenous famotidine for hospitalized COVID-19 patients
- **Lab Diagnostics:** working with private industry to optimize hospital testing data in the new online system (HHS Protect Now); system planned to be the single source for testing data by April 18
- **Supply Chain Stabilization:** 9M of 10M DoD supplied masks arrived at end point destinations

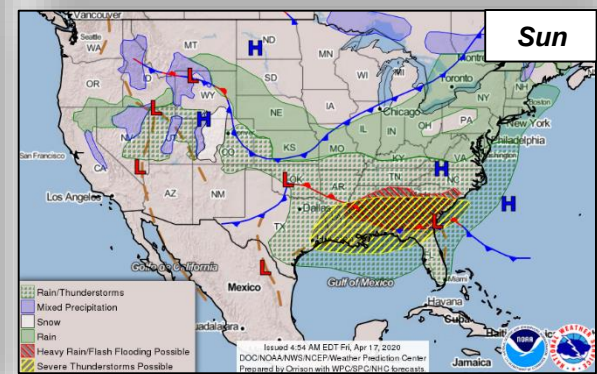
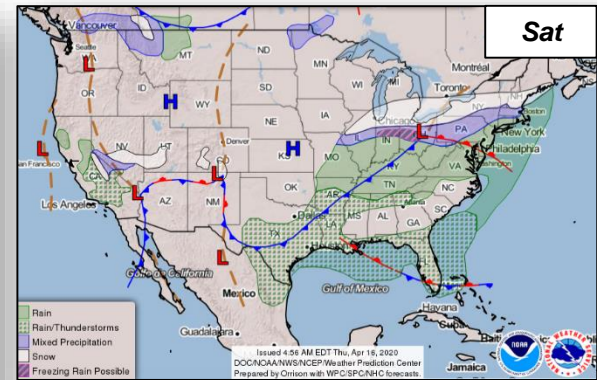
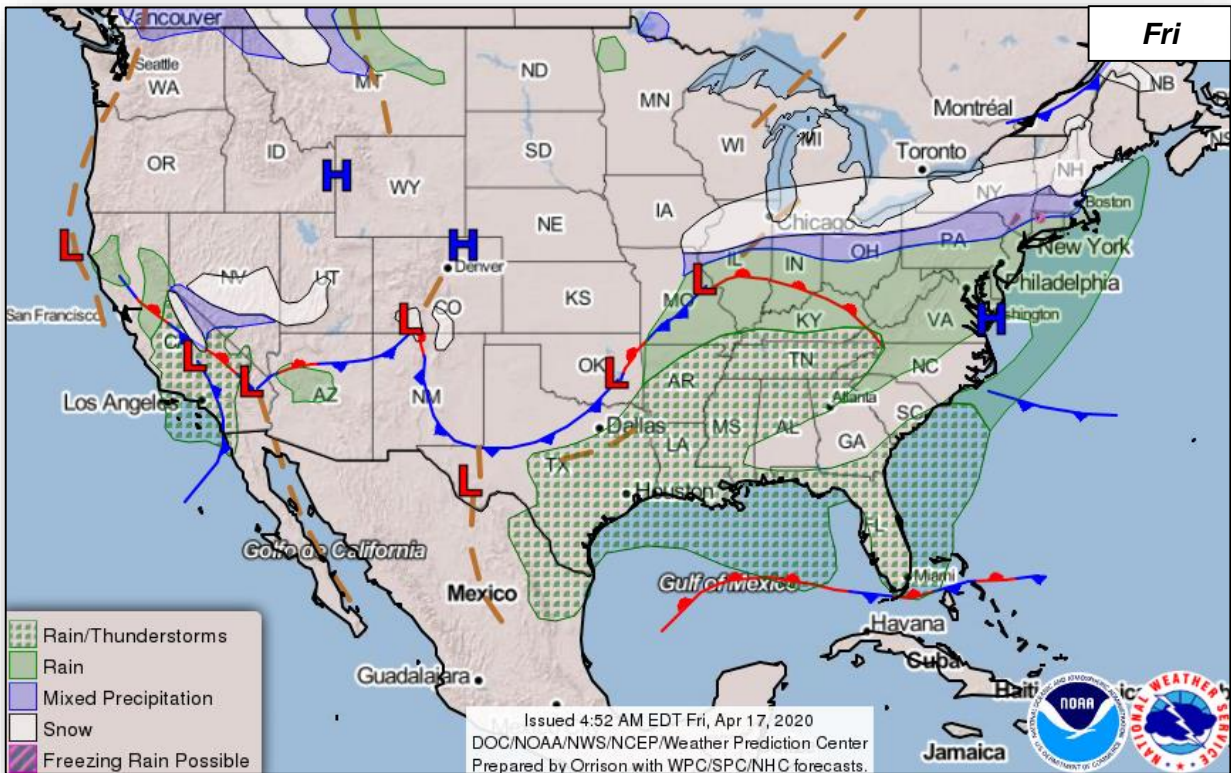

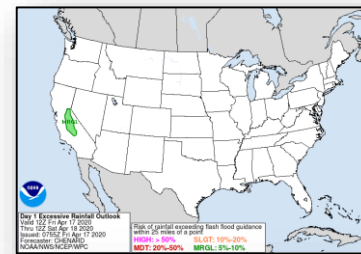
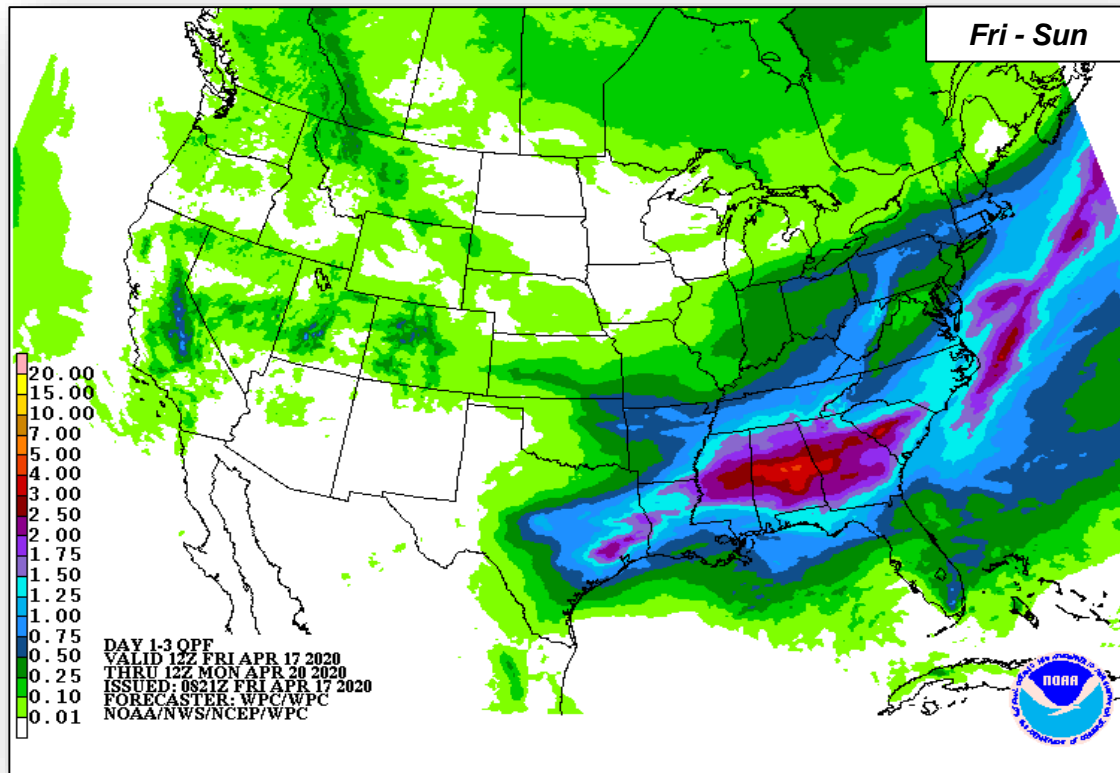
National Weather Forecast



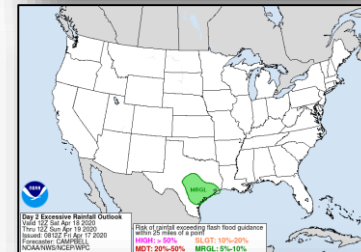
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



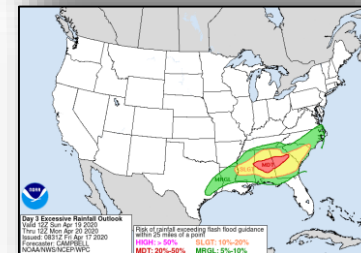

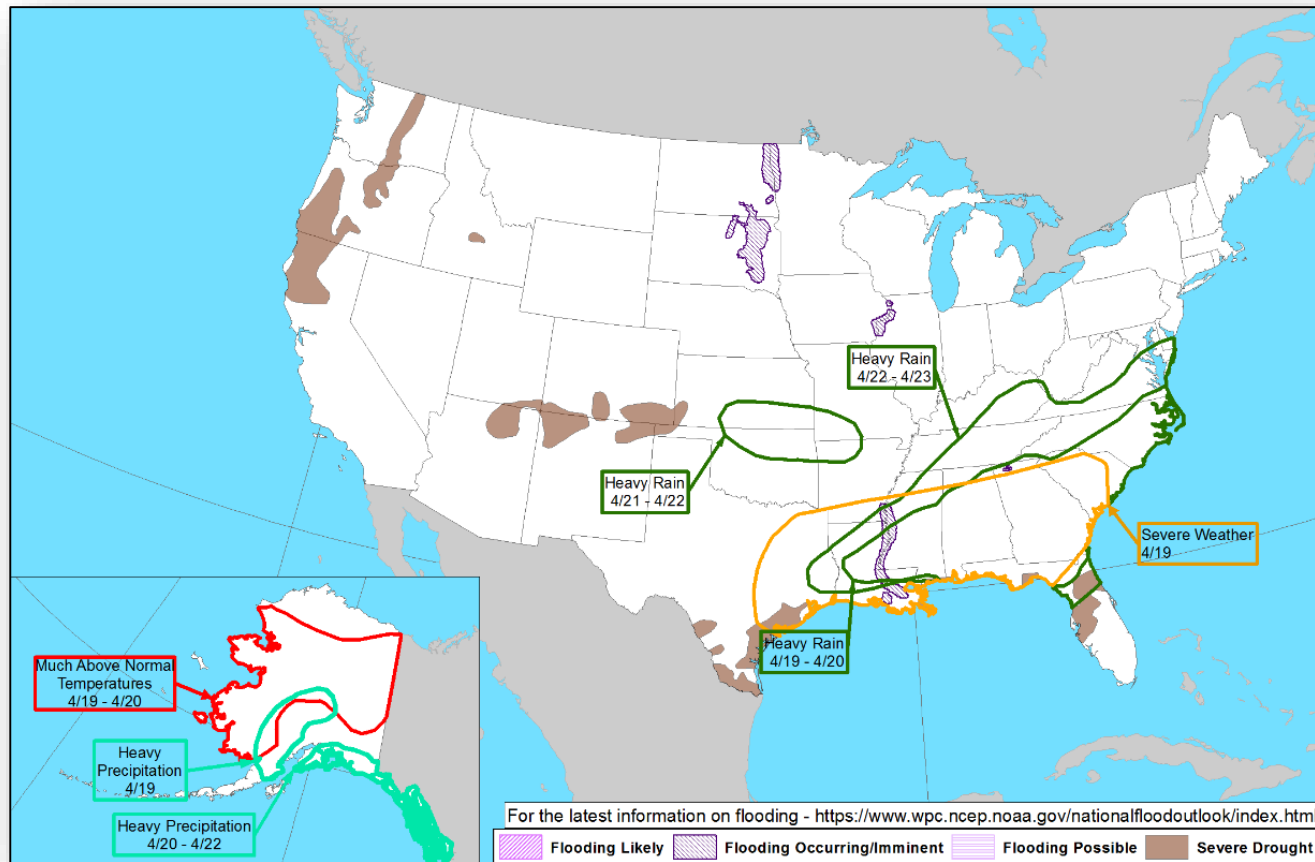
Severe Weather Outlook
