COVID-19 Update



Situation: FEMA, HHS, and federal partners are working with our state, local, tribal, and territorial governments to execute a whole-of-America response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The President released Guidelines for Opening American Up Again and the Federal Government is continuing to work with governors across the country to ensure they have the equipment, supplies, and testing resources they need to reopen safely and responsibly. The HHS Secretary issued a renewal of the January 31 COVID-19 Public Health Emergency Declaration for 90 days.

- FEMA NRCC remains at Level I in unified effort with HHS SOC; all FEMA RRCCs activated
- FEMA IMAT-A teams deployed to 27 states/territories; LNOs deployed to 37 states/territories
- 56 major disaster declarations approved; All State / Territory EOCs activated
- 47,211 FEMA, DOD, HHS, VA and CDC personnel deployed/activated in support of COVID-19 response
 - o 3,153 (+5) FEMA Employees deployed in support of COVID-19 response
- Testing: 5,883,403 (+253,991) cumulative as of Apr 29

Operational Task Forces

Community Based Testing Sites (CBTS)

- · Continuing development of COVID Responder to further support supply chain for all test sites
- Messaging on CBTS 2.0 pending White House approval

Supply Chain Stabilization

- Three flights carrying 2.4M FEMA procured N95s arrived in New York City, NY, Chicago, IL, and Washington, D.C.; this will bring the total received masks to 27.1M of the 55M currently scheduled for shipment
- Briefed White House representatives and leadership from SCTF, Joint Acquisition Task Force (JAFT), and HHS on 90 day
 Comprehensive Demand Estimates for five key PPE items (gloves, face mask, face shield/goggles, N95, and gowns); in
 support of JAFT / HHS acquisition efforts, SCTF will model projections over the next 12 months that includes additional SNS
 supplies

Community Mitigation Measures

Met with EPA on sewage surveillance activities and release of Cleaning and Disinfection Guidance on April 29

Data and Analysis

 Integrating lab data from the Indian Health Service (IHS); data will be available on HHS Protect for analysis and visualization; expected April 30






National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall





Hazards Outlook – May 2-6









