National Current Operations & Monitoring



Significant Incidents or Threats:

- COVID-19
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible Southern Plains/Lower Mississippi Valley
- Wildfire FL

COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> FEMA, HHS, and federal partners are working with SLTT governments to execute a Whole-of-America response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Among the 8 states not presently experiencing a decrease in confirmed cases, 3 have no stay-at-home orders in place, 3 have stay-at-home advisories, and 2 have state-wide stay-at-home orders in place. Nationwide testing: 10,425,877 (+887,156) cumulative as of May 15

Community Based Testing Sites:

- 187,912 (+3,987) samples collected at CBTS locations since Mar 20
- 233,144 (+13,074) tests processed by Private-Partnership Testing Sites since Apr 5

Public Health:

CISA is developing two products for schools (K-12) regarding the use of distance learning and video conferencing tools


Other Domestic Lifelines

Food, Water, Shelter:

- U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) approved WY for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) online program; WY is 24th state approved; A total of 12 states currently have operational online programs: NY, KY, NC, AL, FL, IA, NE, AZ, CA, ID, OR, and WA
- USDA extended the waivers for three nationwide child nutrition programs (Congregate Feeding, Parent Pickup, and Meal Times) to Aug 31

Response:

- FEMA NRCC activated to Level I; all FEMA RRCCs activated
- FEMA IMAT-A teams deployed to 27 states/territories; LNOs deployed to 37 states/territories
- 57 Major Disaster Declarations approved; All State / Territory EOCs activated
- 49,386 (-129) FEMA, DoD, HHS, VA, and CDC personnel deployed / activated; 3,154 (-6) FEMA employees deployed





Disturbance 1 (Invest 90L) (As of 2:00 a.m. ET)


- Located near SE coast of Florida
- Gradual development expected, likely to become a tropical or subtropical depression or storm later today
- Heavy rainfall and gusty winds across portions of SE Florida
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (80%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (80%)




Precipitation


