# National Current Operations & Monitoring

## Significant Incidents or Threats:

- COVID-19
- Severe thunderstorms possible – Ohio Valley to Mid-Atlantic, Great Lakes, and Northeast
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible – Southeast to Mid-Atlantic

## Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic – Disturbance 1 – Medium (50%)
- Eastern Pacific – Disturbance 1 – High (70%)
- Central Pacific – No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days

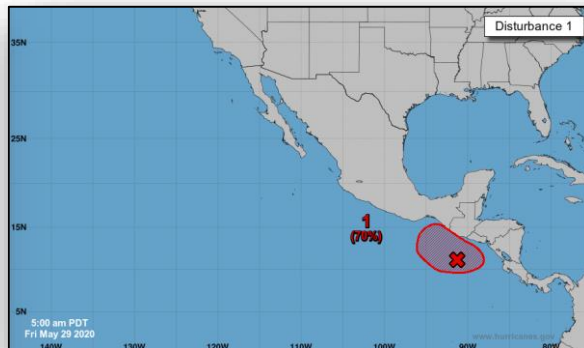

# Tropical Outlook – Five Day



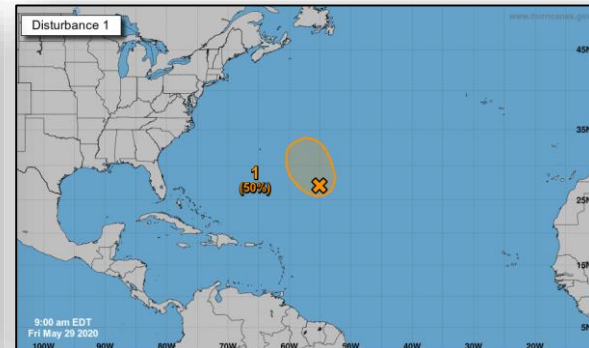
**Central Pacific**



**Eastern Pacific**

**Disturbance 1** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located a **couple of hundred miles** S of the coasts of Central American and southern Mexico
- Conditions appear conducive for gradual development and a **tropical depression could form this weekend**
- Expected to move slowly N toward Central America and southern Mexico during the next **couple of days**
- Formation chance through 48 hours: **Medium (50%)**
- Formation chance through 5 days: **High (70%)**



**Atlantic**

**Disturbance 1** (as of 9:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles ESE of Bermuda
- Additional development is possible, and a **subtropical depression could form tonight or on Saturday** as it moves N
- Formation chance through 48 hours: **Medium (50%)**
- Formation chance through 5 days: **Medium (50%)**

# COVID-19 Update



**Situation:** FEMA and HHS continue leading the multiagency COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. 46,615 FEMA, DoD, HHS, VA, and CDC personnel deployed / activated; 2,961 FEMA employees deployed. Federal, state, tribal, and territorial partners continue to focus on expanded access to testing as COVID-19 infection remains prevalent throughout the country. Nationwide testing: 15,766,114 (+582,226) cumulative as of May 28.

### Health & Medical

Public Health – Personal Protective Equipment

- MI: Major vehicle manufacturer will produce 12k filtering facepiece respirators per day for the next six months to fill the state's PPE needs

### Food, Water, Shelter

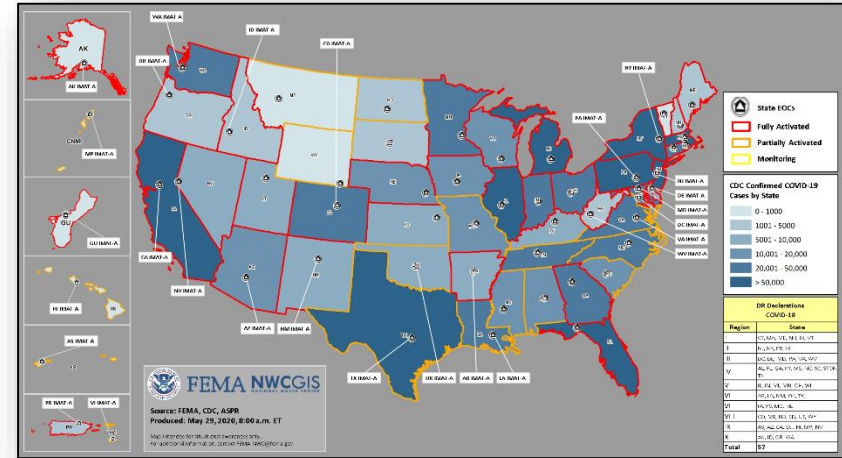
- ESF-6 Mass Care Unit is identifying requirements for partition barriers to be utilized in congregate shelter environment

### Transportation

- AS: Governor requested an extension of the suspension of flights between Honolulu and Pago Pago until June 30

## Response

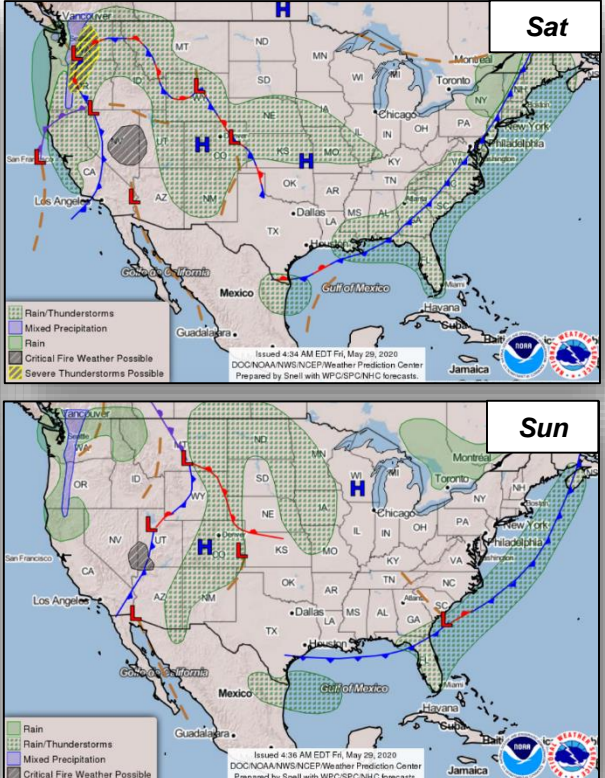
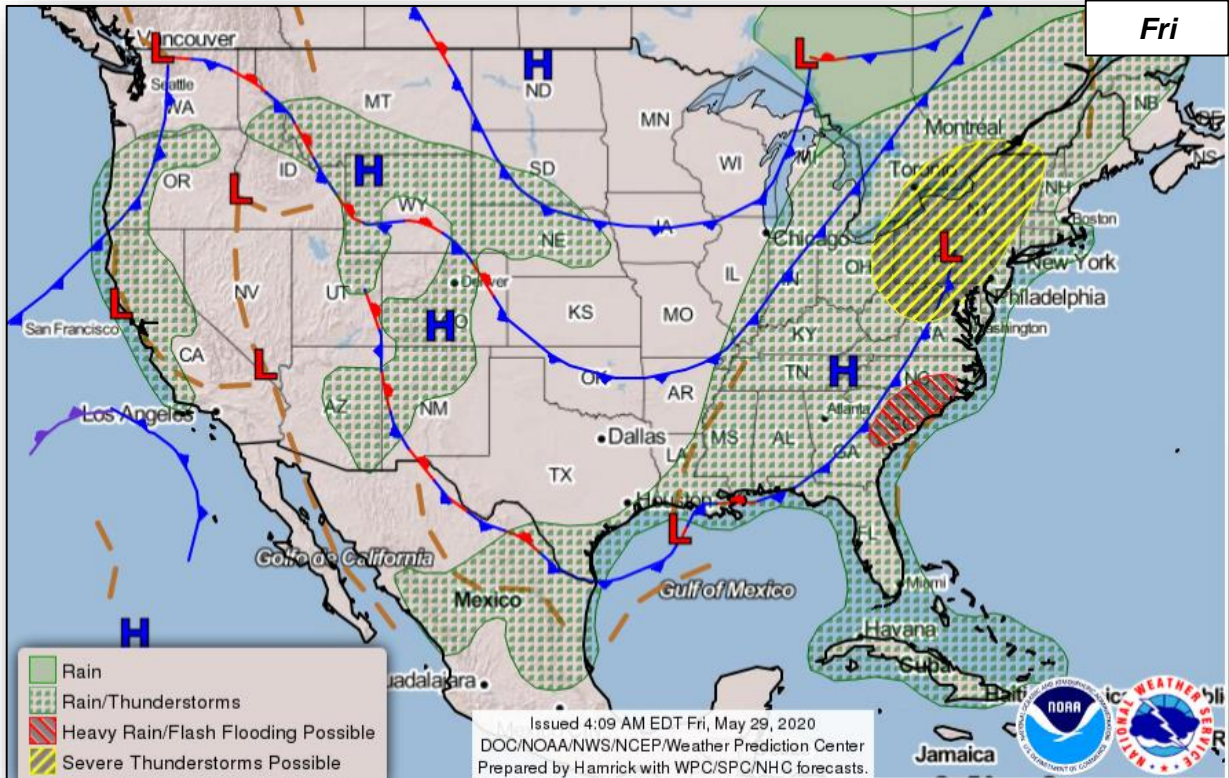
- NRCC Level I; Region IX RRCC Level I; Region III RRCC at Level III; Region VII RRCC is rostered but the Region continues to support COVID-19 response from the JFO in Kansas City, MO; all remaining RRCCs at Level II
- 28 FEMA IMAT-A teams deployed (24 actual/ 4 virtual) to states/territories/tribal nations; LNOs deployed to 37 (21 actual / 16 virtual) states/territories/tribal nations
- 57 Major Disaster Declarations approved; All State / Territory EOCs activated

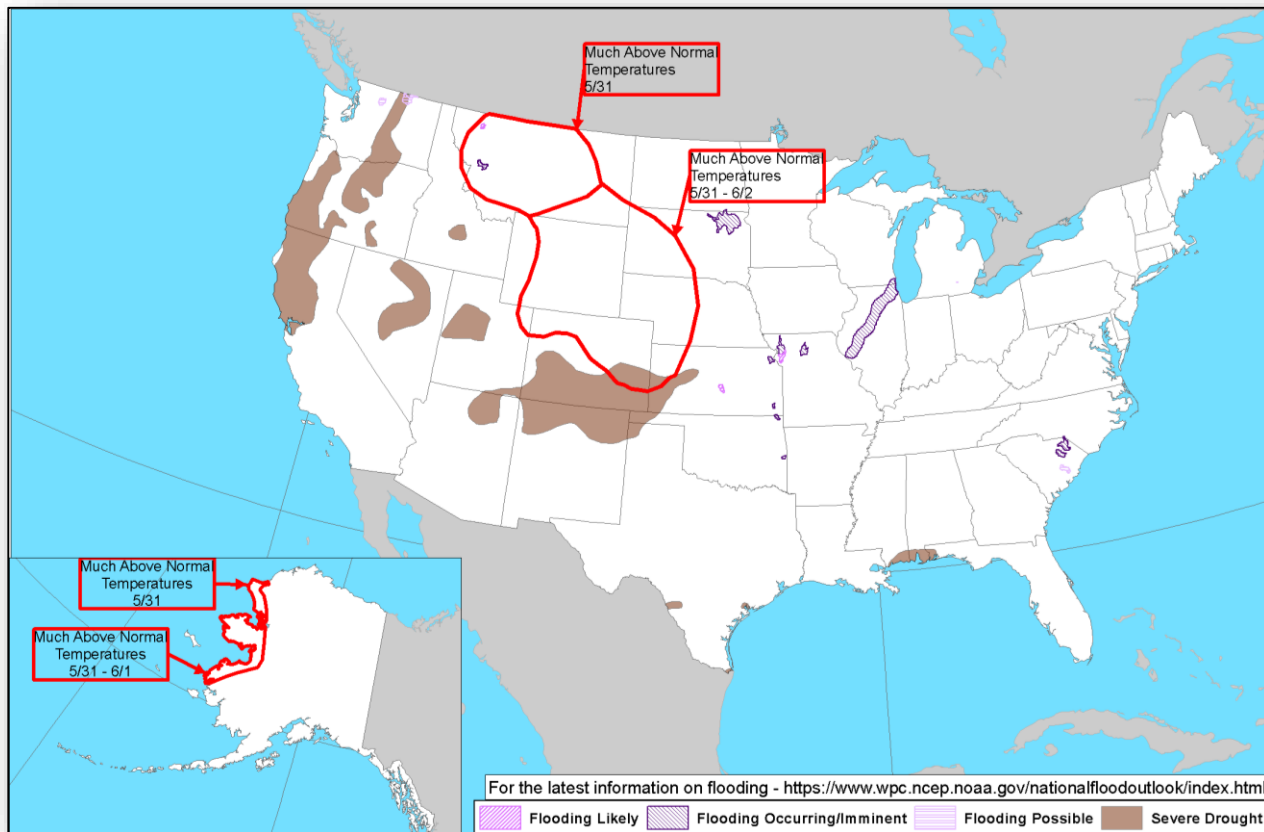
# Severe Weather Outlook

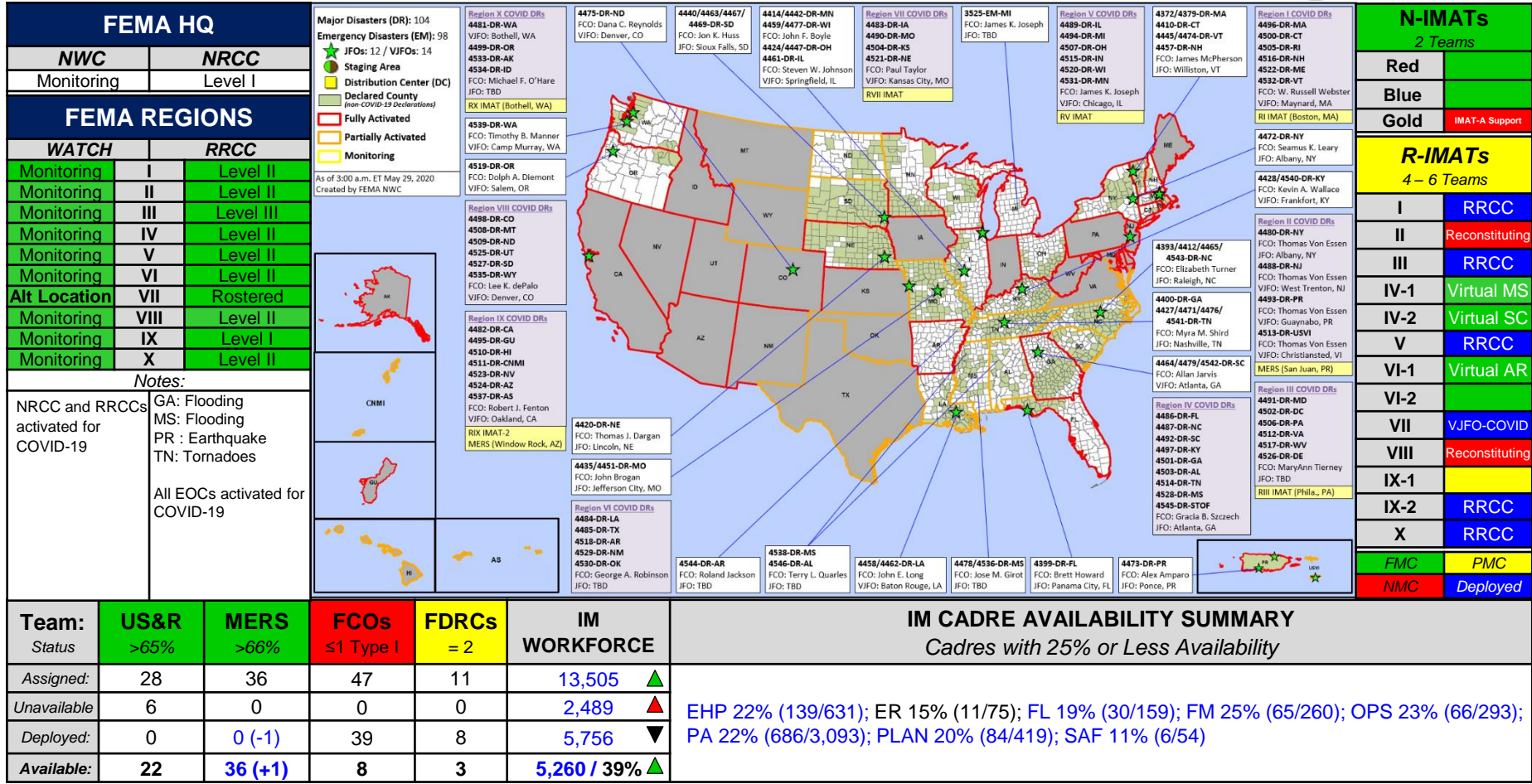
