National Current Operations & Monitoring



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Significant Incidents or Threats:

- COVID-19
- Civil unrest and protests
- Severe thunderstorms possible – Central Plains to the Great Lakes

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic – Tropical Depression Three
- Eastern/Central Pacific – No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days

Declaration Activity: None

Civil Unrest and Protests



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Situation: Protests, civil disturbances and marches are occurring in numerous cities around the nation. The demonstrations were sparked by the May 25 death of George Floyd in police custody in Minneapolis, MN.

Impacts:


- Numerous roadways impacted in the immediate area of civil disturbances
- Media reports that at least (40) cities have implemented curfews

State/Local Response:

- State of emergency:
 - States (6): VA, GA, MN, TX, MO, AZ
- State EOCs activated for civil unrest (in addition to COVID-19 activation):
 - States (10): Full: MN, WI, UT, WA Partial: NE, OK, MO, AZ; CA Monitoring: PA
 - National Guard activated (32): MA, NY, DC, MD, VA, PA, FL, GA, TN, AL, KY, NC, SC, IL, IN, OH, MI, MN, WI, AR, OK, TX, MO, NE, CO, ND, SD, UT, CA, NV, AZ, WA
- PA requested EMAC from VA, DE, and NJ for mutual aid to support Philadelphia Police Dept.

FEMA Response:

- Region's II and III: RWC working from alternate location through June 3
- Region V: RWC working from alternate location through June 2
- Region VIII: JFO in Sioux Falls, SD activated COOP plans due to a breach of Empire mall; working from lodging UFN
- RRCC: Regions III, V, and VII working remotely
- FEMA NRCC and RRCCs are activated (COVID-19)
- NWC and RWCs at Steady State and continue to monitor





- 125 miles W of Campeche, Mexico
- Moving W at 3 mph
- Max sustained winds 35 mph
- Slow strengthening expected during the next couple of days; forecast to become a tropical storm later today

COVID-19 Update



Situation: FEMA and HHS continue leading the multiagency COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. 46,606 FEMA, DoD, HHS, VA, and CDC personnel deployed / activated; **2,898 (-51)** FEMA employees deployed. Nationwide testing: 16,794,182 cumulative as of May 31.

Lifelines Impacts:

Health & Medical


- **NY:** NYS is focusing on testing in NYC hotspots; opening new testing facilities in Bronx (6), Brooklyn (3), and Queens (1)
- **NV:** Stood up CBTS in Nye County on May 30, in Elko County on May 27-30, and in Pershing County on May 29-30 to test all providers at critical care facilities

Food, Water, Shelter

- **PA** Department of Human Services briefed on June 1 that they are having food supply/distribution issues with current protests taking place in several locations
- **TN:** 38 of 119 employees at a strawberry and tomato farm in Unicoi County tested positive for SARS-CoV-2; company tested all employees after one fell ill




- NRCC Level I; Region IX RRCC Level I; Region III, V, **VI** and VIII RRCCs at Level III; Region VII RRCC is rostered but the Region continues to support COVID-19 response from the JFO in Kansas City, MO; all remaining RRCCs at Level II
- 28 FEMA IMAT-A teams deployed (24 actual/ 4 virtual) to states/territories/tribal nations; LNOs deployed to 37 (21 actual / 16 virtual) states/territories/tribal nations
- 57 Major Disaster Declarations approved; All State / Territory EOCs activated




National Weather Forecast



Precipitation Forecast




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

Heavy Rain Outlook Thurs-Mon



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






Total Households in FEMA Direct Housing per State


