## **Significant Incidents or Threats:**

- COVID-19
- Civil unrest and protests – Final
- Slight risk of severe weather possible – Northern/Central Plains
- Flash Flooding possible – Middle/Lower Mississippi Valley
- Critical fire weather – Portions of CA, AZ, NM, TX, CO, KS, & OK

## **Tropical Activity:**


- Atlantic:

- Emergency Declaration approved – Louisiana





## FORECAST TRACK





## 72 HOUR RAINFALL FORECAST







# Tropical Depression Cristobal



## Situation:

TD Cristobal made landfall at 6:00 p.m. ET along the coast of southeast LA; currently located 40 miles N of Baton Rouge, LA. The storm is moving NNW at 10 mph; max sustained winds 35 mph.. Gradual weakening will continue through Tuesday, however some strengthening is expected Tuesday night and Wednesday.

## Lifeline Impacts:

### Safety and Security

- LA: Mandatory evacuations for Jefferson, Terrebonne, and Lafourche parishes
- Food, Water, and Shelter
- LA: 2 shelters open with 0 occupant; MS: 3 shelters with 0 occupants (*ARC midnight shelter count*)

### Transportation


- Numerous Ports in LA are closed

## State/Local Preparations:

- TX EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19)
- LA EOC at Partial Activation (Cristobal and COVID-19); Governor declared SOE

## FEMA/Federal Preparations:

- NRCC at Level I (COVID-19)
- Region IV: RRCC at Level II (COVID-19)
  - IMAT-1 deployed to MS EOC
- Region VI: RRCC at Level II (Cristobal and COVID-19)
  - IMAT-1 deployed to TX EOC; IMAT-2 deployed to LA EOC
  - Two LNOs deployed to New Orleans
  - LA: Emergency Declaration approved on June 7
  - MERS assets deployed to LA EOC and Shreveport, LA
- ISB established in Roseland, LA; SMT deployed
- IOF established at LA GOHSEP
- USACE managing Mississippi river flow



# Civil Unrest and Protests – *Final*



**Situation:** Protests, civil disturbances and marches continue in numerous cities around the nation. Several major cities remain under curfew orders.

## **State / Local Response:**

- State EOCs activated for civil unrest (in addition to COVID-19 activation) [2 \(-7\)](#): PA & WA

## **FEMA Response:**

- [Region II, III and V RWC's returned to primary locations](#)
- Region III and V RRCCs working remotely; NRCC and RRCCs are activated (COVID-19)
- NWC and RWCs at Steady State, continue to monitor

# COVID-19 Update



**Situation:** FEMA and HHS continue leading the multiagency COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. 39,668 FEMA, DoD, HHS, VA, and CDC personnel deployed / activated; 2,729 FEMA employees deployed. Nationwide testing: 20,384,850 cumulative as of June 6.

## Lifelines Impacts:

### Health and Medical – Public Health


- To date, FEMA has shipped over 17.9 million swabs and **12.9 (+0.7)** million media across all states territories, and other federal partners
- RI:** Dept. of Health has partnered with the CDC to conduct serology testing for first responders and medical professions with the intention of starting within the next two weeks (*FEMA Region I Updated, June 5, 5:24 p.m. ET*)

### Food, Water and Shelter

- Mashpee Wampanoag Tribe** is operating three (3) non-congregate shelters; currently housing 34 homeless tribal members (29 adults and 5 minors)





- NWC and all RWCs and MOCs at Steady State, continue to monitor












