### National Current Operations & Monitoring



#### **Significant Incidents or Threats:**

- Severe storms Northern Plains to Upper Midwest
- COVID-19

#### **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1 Low (20%)
- Central Pacific No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days

### COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> FEMA and HHS continue leading the multiagency COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. 37,399 FEMA, DoD, HHS, VA, and CDC personnel deployed / activated; 2,514 (-38) FEMA employees deployed. Nationwide testing: 23,765,801 (+297,820) cumulative as of June 17

#### Food, Water, Shelter


 The USDA Farmers to Families Food Box Program has been extended to August 30, 2020 and will be expanded to serve additional areas (FEMA SLB COVID-19, June 17)

#### Communications

 Commerce Department reported widespread rebounds in sales in multiple sectors during May, concentrated in clothing, furniture, electronics and motor (FEMA SLB COVID-19, June 17)

#### Response:

- NRCC at Level I; Region I and II RRCCs at Level II; Region III, IV, V, VI, VIII, and X RRCCs at Level III; Region VII and IX RRCCs are rostered, COVID-19 response being worked from the Virtual JFOs
- NWC and all RWCs and MOCs at Steady State, continue to monitor




- Expected to form well S or SW of the southern coast of Mexico in a few of days








### Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall


