# National Current Operations & Monitoring

## Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Severe Thunderstorms possible – Southern Plains
- Heavy Rain/Flash Flooding possible – Southern and Central Plains
- COVID-19

## Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1 – Low (20%)
- Central Pacific – No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days

**Declaration Activity:** None

# COVID-19 Update



**Situation:** FEMA and HHS continue leading the multiagency COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. **36,863** FEMA, DoD, HHS, VA, and CDC personnel deployed / activated; **2,533 (+19)** FEMA employees deployed. Nationwide testing: **25,059,335 (+1,293,534)** cumulative as of June 18


## Lifelines Impacts:

### Health and Medical

- **AZ:** Experiencing highest case rate in the U.S.; public health experts link the surge to easing of the stay-at-home order and lifting of business lockdown on May 15; Governor announced that local governments will be allowed to set their own rules on use of face masks
- **CA:** Increase in L.A. County positive COVID-19 cases; 50% of restaurants visited were not following social distancing protocols
- **TX:** Mayors of several cities requested that Governor allow counties to mandate masks
- **HI:** State earmarked \$12 million in federal funds for vulnerable and low-income persons at Kona Community Hospital (Hawaii) and Straub Medical Center (Oahu)

### Food, Water, Shelter

- **MA:** Non-Profits project that food insecurity continues to rise
- **PA:** \$40 million in CARES Act funding available; \$20 million to dairy farmers for relief payments and reimbursement for donation of excess dairy product to the state charitable food system; \$15 million for purchase and distribution of food to low-income individuals; \$5 million for reimbursement for donations by other agricultural participants to the state's charitable food system




## Response:

- NRCC at Level I; Region I and II RRCCs at Level II; Region III, IV, V, VI and X RRCCs at Level III; Region VII, VIII and IX RRCCs are rostered, COVID-19 response being worked from the Virtual JFOs
- NWC and all RWCs and MOCs at Steady State, continue to monitor

**Eastern Pacific**





- Environmental conditions could support some slow development through early next week while it moves W, offshore of the coast Mexico

- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)



# National Weather Forecast
