National Current Operations & Monitoring



Significant Incidents or Threats:

- COVID-19
- Severe Weather Central Plains to the Great Lakes

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: No activity affecting U.S. interests
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Tropical Depression Boris
 - Disturbance 1 Low (30%)
 - Disturbance 2 Medium (40%)
 - Central Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Tropical Depression Boris (Advisory 8 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- About 1,235 miles ESE of Hilo, Hawaii
- Moving WNW at 8 mph
- Maximum sustained winds of 35 mph
- No costal watches or warning in effect


Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- A few hundred miles SW of the coast of Mexico
- Conditions forecast to be only marginally conducive for development Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (30%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 2:00 p.m. ET)

- Large area of disturbed weather is location south of the Gulf of Tehuantepec
- Gradual development over the next few days is possible
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (40%)





COVID-19 Update




<u>Situation:</u> FEMA and HHS continue to lead the COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. 36,442 (+155) Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,518 (+17) FEMA employees deployed. Nationwide Testing: 30,110,061 (+770,304) cumulative (as of June 25).

Cases of COVID-19 continue to increase throughout the world

- Confirmed Cases of COVID-19
 - United States: 2,374,282 (+37,667)
 - o Worldwide: 9,129,146 (+135,487)
- Deaths caused by COVID-19
 - United States: 121,809 (+692)
 - Worldwide: 473,797 (+4,210)


Response:

- NRCC at Level I; Region I and II RRCCs at Level II; Region III, IV, V, VI and X RRCCs at Level III; Region VII, VIII and IX RRCCs are rostered; Region VII COVID-19 response being worked from the Virtual JFO
- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs at Steady State; monitoring




National Weather Forecast






Fire Weather Outlook


