National Current Operations & Monitoring



Significant Incidents or Threats:

- COVID-19
- Critical/Isolated Dry Fire Weather Central Basin & Southwest into the Central & Southern Plains
- Severe Weather Central Plains to the Great Lakes


Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next five days
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Disturbance 1 Low (10%)
 - Disturbance 2 Low (30%)
- Central Pacific: Tropical Depression Boris

Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located a few hundred miles WSW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Conditions have become less conducive and development is unlikely as it moves WNW at 10 mph away from the coast of Mexico during the next couple of days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (10%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles S of the coast of southern Mexico
- Some development is possible and a tropical depression could form early next week while it moves WNW at 15 mph parallel to the coast of Mexico
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)




Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific



Tropical Depression Boris (Advisory 12 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 1,090 miles ESE of Hilo, HI
- Moving W at 7 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- Weakening is forecast during the next couple of days and Boris is forecast to degenerate into a remnant low by Sunday



COVID-19 Update




Situation: FEMA and HHS continue to lead the COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. 36,442 (+155) Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,518 (+17) FEMA employees deployed. Nationwide Testing: 30,110,061 (+770,304) cumulative (as of June 25).

Cases of COVID-19 continue to increase throughout the world

- Confirmed Cases of COVID-19
 - United States: 2,414,870 (+40,588)
 - o Worldwide: 9,296,202 (+167,056 new)
- Deaths caused by COVID-19
 - United States: 124,325 (+2,516)
 - Worldwide: 479,133 (+5,336 new)


Response:

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs at Steady State; monitoring




National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Severe Weather Outlook









Fire Weather Outlook




