# National Current Operations & Monitoring



## **Significant Incidents or Threats:**

- Heavy rain/flash flooding possible Middle / Lower Mississippi & Tennessee valleys
- Critical Fire Weather Central Great Basin
- COVID-19

## **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Eastern Pacific:
  - Disturbance 1 Low (20%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests


### Disturbance 1 (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)



<u>Situation:</u> FEMA and HHS continue to lead the COVID-19 Response / Recovery efforts. 32,362 (+4,080) Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,430 (-57) FEMA employees deployed. Nationwide Testing: 33,601,847 (+1,304,159) cumulative (as of June 30).

o Worldwide: 10,021,401 (+178,328)


Deaths caused by COVID-19


