## National Current Operations & Monitoring



#### **Significant Incidents or Threats:**

- Severe thunderstorms possible Central/Southern Plains; Middle Mississippi Valley
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible Southern Plains; Central Plains to Middle/Upper Mississippi Valley and Great Lakes
- COVID-19

#### **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Eastern Pacific:
  - Disturbance 1: Low (20%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

#### **Disturbance 1** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Several hundred miles SSW of the coast of southwestern Mexico
- Forecast to form in a few days
- Moving WNW or NW
- Slight development possible over the weekend or early next week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

#### COVID-19 Update



**Situation:** Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 26 (-2) states, with 6 (+5) state in a plateau status. 30,229 (-105) Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,233 (-35) FEMA employees deployed.

Nationwide Testing: 41,761,392 (+973,535) cumulative as of July 14.





- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring






#### National Weather Forecast











#### Severe Weather Outlook








#### Hazards Outlook – Jul 17-21









