20	SEC. 6. TASK FORCE FOR ASSESSMENT OF CAUSES OF MEN-
21	TAL STRESS AND BEST PRACTICES FOR RE-
22	SPONSE.
23	(a) In General.—The Secretary shall convene a
24	task force of agricultural and rural stakeholders at the
25	national, State, and local levels—

1	(1) to assess the causes of mental stress in
2	farmers and ranchers; and
3	(2) to identify best practices for responding to
4	that mental stress.
5	(b) Submission of Report.—Not later than 1 year
6	after the date of enactment of this Act, the task force con-
7	vened under subsection (a) shall submit to the Secretary
8	a report containing the assessment and best practices
9	under paragraphs (1) and (2), respectively, of subsection
10	(a).
11	(c) Collaboration.—In carrying out this section,
12	the task force convened under subsection (a) shall collabo-
13	rate with nongovernmental organizations and State and
14	local agencies.
