### National Current Operations & Monitoring



#### **Significant Incidents or Threats:**

- Anglin Fire
- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible Northern Rockies, Northern/Southern Plains
- Critical/Elevated Fire Weather WA & OR
- Isolated Dry Thunderstorms Northern Intermountain to the Central Great Basin
- COVID-19

#### **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic:
  - Disturbance 1 (Invest 92L): High (90%)
- Eastern Pacific:
  - Disturbance 1: Low (10%)
- Central Pacific: Tropical Storm Douglas
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests



#### **Current Situation:**

- Fire began July 27; burning federal, state and private land
- Threatening homes in and around the town of Tonasket, WA (pop 1,032), power lines, publicly owned roads, a bridge, agricultural equipment, state facilities, and ecological resources in the area
- County is coordinating with the American Red Cross to provide shelter in hotels

#### **Response:**

- FMAG approved July 28
- WA EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- NWC & Region X / Bothell MOC continue to monitor




### Tropical Outlook – Atlantic

#### Disturbance 1 (Invest 92L) (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located 500 miles E of the Windward Islands
- Moving WNW at 15-20 mph
- Environmental conditions expected to become somewhat more conducive for development; a tropical depression or tropical storm likely to form during the next couple of days
- Locally heavy rain and gusty winds likely across portions of the Leeward Islands on Wednesday and will spread westward to the Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico Wednesday night and Thursday
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (80%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)





### Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



#### **Disturbance 1** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- A couple hundred miles off the coast of southwestern Mexico
- Strong upper-level winds expected to inhibit significant development as the system moves slowly NW parallel to, but just offshore of the SW coast of Mexico during the next couple of days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (10%)



### Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific (Final)



#### **Tropical Cyclone Douglas** (Advisory #32 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)


- 460 miles WNW of Honolulu, HI
- Moving WNW at 14 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 60 mph
- Weakening forecast over the next couple of days; expected to dissipate by Thursday
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend 125 miles

#### Watches/Warnings:

- All Hurricane Watches and Warnings have been cancelled
- A Tropical Strom Watch in effect for portions of the Papahanaumokuakea Marine National Monument from Nihoa to French Frigate Shoals to Maro Reef and Lisianski

#### Impacts:

- Rainfall will affect portions of the Papahanaumokuakea Marine National Monument over the next couple of days
- Large swells producing large breaking waves will impact the Papahanaumokuakea Marine National Monument the next couple of days; inundation possible for some low lying atolls



### Disturbance 1 (92L) – Preparation/Response



#### Situation:


Shower activity associated with a low pressure area located 500 miles east of the Windward Islands is gradually increasing in organization. Regardless of development, local heavy rains and gusty wind likely across portions of the Leeward Islands and spreading westward to the Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico Wednesday night and Thursday.

#### **Potential Impacts:**

- · Heavy rainfall, strong winds and local flooding
- Landslides

#### Response:

- PR EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19)
- USVI EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19)
- Region II RRCC at Level III; IMAT deployed to USVI
- Region I IMAT deployed to PR
- National ISB team and select SMT personnel deployed to USVI & PR
- Maynard MERS deploying to USVI & PR
- NRCC remains activated to Level I (COVID-19)



### COVID-19 Update



**Situation:** Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 20 (+10) states, with 6 (-20) states in a plateau status, and 30 (+10) states on a downward trajectory. 28,446 (-656) Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,188 (-31) FEMA employees deployed.

Nationwide Testing: 53,718,026 (+775, 881) cumulative (as of July 27)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (CDC COVID-19 Response Update as of July 27)

o Worldwide: 15,785,641 (+200,625)



#### Response:


- NRCC at Level I

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring



### National Weather Forecast








### Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall


