Significant Incidents or Threats:


- Heavy rain and flash flooding possible Central Plains to the Mid-Atlantic
- Elevated Fire Weather / Isolated / Scattered Dry Thunderstorms Northwest
- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:


- Atlantic:
 - Tropical Storm Isaias
 - Disturbance 1: Low (20%)
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1: Low (20%)
- Central Pacific: No tropical cyclones are expected during the next 5 days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests


Tropical Storm Isaias SATELLITE LOOP




Tropical Storm Isaias FORECAST TRACK

Tropical Storm Isaias – Response



Situation:

The center of Isaias will move over Hispaniola late today and near the Southeastern Bahamas by early Friday. Little change in strength is anticipated until landfall in Dominican Republic later today, with re-strengthening forecast on Friday and Saturday

Impacts:

- PR: significant rainfall & wind; some road & vegetation flooding, all Lifelines are Green
- PR: wide spread power outage; re-establishing will begin today
- DRC #4 in the Municipality of Ponce and DRC #17 in the Municipality of Guanica will be temporarily closed today
- · Port closures: USVI & PR for inbound traffic
- USVI: All Lifelines are Green; no unmet needs


Response:

FEMA REGION I:

- IMAT deployed to PR; MERS deployed to USVI & PR <u>FEMA REGION II:</u>
- RRCC at Level II; IMAT deployed to USVI
- PR EOC at Full Activation (COVID-19); USVI EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19) FEMA REGION IV:
- IMAT-2 deployed to FL

FEMA HQ:

- National ISB team and select SMT personnel deployed to USVI & PR
- USACE deployed personnel to USVI & PR
- One DCE for PR and one DCE for USVI are deployed
- US&R on standby; 2hrs alert
- USVI and PR Emergency Declarations Approved July 29th
- NRCC remains activated to Level I (COVID-19)



COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 15 (-8) states, with 12 (+8) states in a plateau status, and 29 states on a downward trajectory. 28,379 Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,149 (-11) FEMA employees deployed.


Nationwide Testing: 57,271,142 (+1,895,946) cumulative (as of July 29)


- NRCC at Level I


National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Fire Weather Outlook






