

- **Declaration Activity:** None













## PEAK STORM SURGE FORECAST







## **Lifeline Impacts:**

### **Safety and Security**

- NC: Voluntary and mandatory evacuations in effect for 4 counties
- NC: US&R and Swiftwater Rescue teams standing by

### **Food, Water, & Shelter**

- NC: 19 shelters open with 40 occupants across 11 counties (ARC Report as of 5:48 a.m. ET)

### **Health and Medical**

- DC & MD: Government run COVID-19 testing sites closed today
- NC: 30 bed State Medical Support Shelter open

### **Energy (DOE Eagle-I)**

- PR: 15K customers w/o power; effecting water supply for 23K; restoration ongoing
- SC: 3.5K customers w/o power;
- VA: 50.4K customers w/o power
- NC: 350K customers w/o power (mostly w/in 6 coastal counties, most significantly in New Hanover county – 92.6K outages). Line crews are staged to begin repairs.

### **Transportation**

- NC: Ferry Division and all rail services suspended

# COVID-19 Update



**Situation:** Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across **11(+2)** states, with **9 (+4)** states in a plateau status, and **36 states on a downward trajectory**.  
**28,220 (+412)** Federal employees deployed / activated; **2,138 (-21)** FEMA employees deployed.

**Nationwide Testing:** **59,066,987 (+995,297)** cumulative as of August 3



# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall







Includes General Flash and River Flood Hazards



## Flood Hazard Messages (associated with Tropical Storm Isaias)

- Isaias will bring heavy rainfall to the Mid-Atlantic and Northeast through Tuesday night.
- Potentially life-threatening urban flooding is possible in D.C., Baltimore, and elsewhere along and just west of the I-95 corridor today. Widespread minor to moderate stream and river flooding is expected across portions of the Mid-Atlantic.
- In the Northeast and western New England, flash and urban flooding, and rapid rises on small streams is expected through tonight. Quick-responding streams and rivers are susceptible to minor and isolated moderate flooding.
- Interests in the mid-Atlantic and Northeast should monitor the progress of Tropical Storm Isaias and ensure they have their flood plan in place.





## Public Assistance Obligated per Category 7/20/2020 through 8/3/2020








States with Currently Occupied Units
