National Current Operation



Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Tropical Cyclone Isaias Response
- Severe thunderstorms possible – Northern and Central Plains
- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1: Low (10%)
- Eastern Pacific: Disturbance 1: High (90%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones are expected during the next 5 days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Declaration Activity: None



Tropical Cyclone Isaias – Response

Situation: Widespread power outages continue due to Isaias; restoration on-going.

Lifeline Impacts:

Food, Water, Shelter

- CT: 37 public drinking water systems on generator power
- NJ: 2 (-1) boil water advisories; 42 (-14) water systems without power Shelters: NJ – 47 (+11) individuals in hotels; NY – 95 (+63) individuals in hotels

Health and Medical

- CT: 77 nursing homes/skilled care facilities on generator power (1/3 of state total)
- NYC: 3 (-3) nursing homes on generator power
- NJ: 26 residents from Oaks of Denville Assisted Living Facility were evacuated; power outage

Energy (Eagle-1 as of 9:00 a.m. ET)

Customers without power

- CT: 318k (-114k) (peak 636k) (20%); NJ: 149k (-146k) (peak 568k) (4%); NY: 312K (-88k) (peak 579k) (4%)

Transportation


- NY: Metro North operating weekend service schedule; Long Island Railroad service restored with residual delays

State / Local Response:

- CT, NH, & NJ EOCs at Full Activation (Isaias & COVID-19); States of Emergency declared
- DE, NY, VA, & NC EOCs at Partial Activation (Isaias & COVID-19); States of Emergency declared

Federal Response:


- Region I: RRCC at Level III (Isaias & COVID-19)
 - IMAT & FCO deployed to CT EOC
- Region II: RRCC at Level II (Isaias & COVID-19) LNO deployed to NJ

 - 2 MCOVs on station at JBMDL to support ISB operations
- FEMA HQ: NRCC at Level I (COVID-19)
 - Emergency Declaration FEMA-3535-EM-CT approved








Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located a few hundred miles SW of the Gulf of Tehuantepec
- Tropical depression is likely to form in the next couple days as it moves WNW
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (70%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)




Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)
