National Current Operation



Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Earthquake North Carolina
- Tropical Cyclone Isaias Response Final
- Severe thunderstorms possible Central Plains and Middle Mississippi Valley
- Heavy Rain and Flash Flooding possible Middle Mississippi and Ohio Valleys
- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1: Medium (60%)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Tropical Storm Elida
 - Disturbance 1: Medium (60%)
 - Disturbance 2: Medium (60%)
- Central Pacific: Disturbance 1: Medium (60%)
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Earthquake – Sparta, NC




Earthquake - Sparta, NC

- At 8:07 a.m. ET on August 9, a magnitude 5.1 earthquake occurred 2 miles SE of Sparta, NC, (pop. 1,170) at a depth of 2 miles; felt as a MMI of VII
- Yellow PAGER was issued for economic losses, indicating that some damage is possible but the impact should be localized
- Green PAGER was issued for fatalities, indicating a low likelihood of casualties
- Region IV received reports of minor damage (cracked sheet rock and patio concrete) in Alleghany and Wilkes counties, NC
- · No fatalities or injuries reported

Response:

- NC and VA EOCs at Partial Activation (COVID-19)
- Region IV RRCC is rostered
- NWC, Regions III and IV RWCs are monitoring
- · No requests for FEMA assistance



Tropical Cyclone Isaias – Response – Final



<u>Situation:</u> Widespread power outages continue due to Isaias; restoration on-going.

Lifeline Impacts:

Food, Water, Shelter

- · CT: 33 public drinking water systems on generator power
- NJ: 41 water systems without power
- · All shelters closed in NJ and NY

Health and Medical

- CT: 8 (-69) nursing homes/skilled care facilities on generator power
- NYC: All nursing home power has been restored

Energy (Eagle-I as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

Customers without power


CT: 97k (-222K) (peak 636k) (6%); NJ: 7k (-38k) (peak 568k) (<1%)
 NY: 75k (-237k) (peak 579k) (1%)

State / Local Response:

- CT & NH EOCs at Full Activation (Isaias & COVID-19); States of Emergency declared
- NJ EOC at Partial Activation (Isaias & COVID-19); State of Emergency declared
- NY EOC at Partial Activation (COVID-19); States of Emergency declared

Federal Response:

- Region I: RRCC at Level III (Isaias & COVID-19)
 - IMAT & FCO deployed to CT EOC
- Region II: RRCC Level II (COVID-19)
- FEMA HQ: NRCC at Level I (COVID-19)
 - Emergency Declaration FEMA-3535-EM-CT approved




Tropical Outlook – Atlantic

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Tropical wave located several hundred miles WSW of Cabo Verde Islands
- Conditions favorable for additional development
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Medium (60%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (60%)





Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific

Tropical Cyclone Elida (Advisory 6 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 145 miles ESE of Socorro Island, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 15 mph
- Maximum sustained winds near 65 mph
- Strengthening is forecast, and is expected to become a hurricane later today
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend up to 60 miles from the center

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- Expected to form over the western portion of the eastern Pacific basin in a few days
- Conditions conducive for gradual development
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (60%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Expected to form offshore of the SW coast of Mexico by the middle of next week
- Some development is possible
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (60%)








Tropical Outlook – Central Pacific



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,400 miles SE of Hilo, HI
- Conditions conducive for gradual development
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (60%)



COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 3 states, with 4 states in a plateau status, and 49 states on a downward trajectory. 26,073 Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,091 FEMA employees deployed.

Nationwide Testing: 64,920,920 cumulative as of Aug 6

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (CDC COVID-19 update as of Aug 8)
Confirmed Cases of COVID-19

United States: 4,974,959 (+54,590)Worldwide: 19,187,943 (+284,441)


Deaths caused by COVID-19

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring





National Weather Forecast






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Long Range Outlooks – Aug 15-19


