# **National Current Operation**



#### **Significant Incidents or Threats:**

- Derecho Midwest
- Severe thunderstorms possible Northern and Central Plains
- COVID-19

#### **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic: Disturbance 1: High (90%)
- Eastern Pacific:
  - Tropical Cyclone Elida (CAT 1)
  - Disturbance 1: High (70%)
  - Disturbance 2: High (70%)
  - Disturbance 3: Medium (40%)
- Central Pacific: See Disturbance 1 in the Eastern Pacific Basin
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

#### **Declaration Activity: None**

### Derecho – Midwest

<u>Situation:</u> In the afternoon and evening on August 10, severe thunderstorms with long track damaging winds (derecho) impacted the Midwest, causing widespread power outages across FEMA Regions V and VII.

#### **Lifeline Impacts:**

#### Safety and Security

- Downed trees and powerlines, and unspecified structural and agricultural damage; damage is being assessed
- No evacuations
- Injuries: IA 4: IL 5 unconfirmed

#### Food, Water, Shelter

• IA: Local sheltering efforts - number unknown

#### **Energy**

- Customers without power (as of 6:30 a.m. ET, DOE Eagle-I)
  - Region V: IL: 533k (9%) (peak 757k); IN: 100k (3%) (peak 147k); MI: 32k (1%) (peak 51k); WI: 6k (0.2%) (peak 42k); OH: 3k (0.01%) (peak 12k)
  - Region VII: IA: 406k (28%) (peak 491k); MO: 33k (1%) (peak 87k); NE: 6k (1%) (peak 57k)
- Duane Arnold Energy Center in Palo, IA lost offsite power due to high winds; back-up generators are running

#### <u>Communications</u>

IA: some damage to emergency communications systems – extent unknown


#### <u>Transportation</u>

 IA: Several U.S. highways closed due to downed powerlines in central and eastern IA; alternate routes available; no major interstates currently blocked

#### Federal Response:

- Region V RRCC at Level III (COVID-19); RWC is monitoring
- · Region VII RWC is monitoring
- FEMA NWC is monitoring
- No requests for FEMA assistance





#### State / Local Response:


- Region V
  - IL EOC: Normal Operations
  - IN, MI EOCs: Partial Activation (COVID-19)
  - MN, OH, WI EOCs: Full Activation (COVID-19)
- Region VII
  - MO EOC: Partial Activation (COVID-19)
  - NE, KS, IA EOCs: Full Activation (COVID-19)
  - IA Governor declared a state of emergency

# Tropical Outlook – Atlantic

#### **Disturbance 1** (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 800 miles WSW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Moving W to WNW at 15 mph
- Tropical depression is likely to form during the next day or so
- Conditions are forecast to become less conducive for development by the end of the week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (90%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (90%)





# Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



#### Tropical Cyclone Elida (CAT 1) (Advisory #10 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 250 miles SW of the southern tip of Baja California, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 14 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 90 mph
- Weakening is likely to begin by late afternoon and continue into Thursday
- Hurricane force winds extend 15 miles; tropical storm force winds extend 70 miles



# Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- 1,500 miles SW of the southern tip of the Baja California peninsula, Mexico
- Expected to move slowly west
- Tropical depression is likely to form late this week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (30%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (70%)

#### Disturbance 12(as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Forecast to develop well south or southwest of the southwestern coast of Mexico in a couple of days
- Moving WNW
- Likely to become a tropical depression by late this week or over the weekend
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (10%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (70%)

#### Disturbance 3 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Expected to form in a few days over the far eastern portion of the basin to the south of the coast of Central America
- Moving WNW
- · Tropical depression could form this weekend
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Medium (40%)



# COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 6 (+3) states, with 1 (-3) states in a plateau status, and 49 states on a downward trajectory. 25,931 (-142) Federal employees deployed / activated; 2,084 (-7) FEMA employees deployed.

Nationwide Testing: 65,756,307 (+835,387) cumulative as of Aug 10

Worldwide: 19,462,112 (+273,552)



- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring






