National Current Operations and Monitoring FEMA

Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Tropical Cyclone Laura Response / Recovery
- Severe Weather possible Southern Plains and Middle/Lower Mississippi valleys
- Heavy Rain and Flash Flooding possible Southern Plains, Middle/Lower Mississippi valleys, and Mid-Atlantic
- Critical Fire Weather Western U.S
- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
 - Disturbance 1: High (80%)
 - Disturbance 2: High (70%)
 - Disturbance 3: Low (30%)
 - o Disturbance 4: Low (10%)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Disturbance 1: Low (30%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- · Over the central Caribbean
- A tropical depression likely to form over the next couple of days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (70%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (80%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)


- 150 miles SSW of Wilmington, NC
- A tropical depression likely to form with in a day or so
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (70%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (70%)

Disturbance 3 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Expected to emerge off the coast of Africa in a couple of days
- Gradual development possible through the end of the week
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)

Disturbance 4 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Several hundred miles SW of the Cabo Verde Islands
- Further development is not expected
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (near 0%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (10%)




Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Several hundred miles SSW of the SW coast of Mexico
- Gradual development possible during the next couple of days
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (30%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (30%)

Tropical Cyclone Laura – Response / Recovery



Situation:

Damage assessments, search and rescue operations, power restoration, and support to medical facilities continue throughout impacted areas.

<u>Lifeline Impacts:</u> (FEMA NRCC SLB, as of 6:00 p.m. ET, Aug 30) Safety and Security

- LA: Evacuation orders remain in effect for 4 (-1) parishes
- CAP conducting aerial assessments; 8 (+3) missions complete

Food, Water, Shelter

LA:

- 8,227 (+1,469) occupants in congregate and non-congregate shelters
- 191k residents in 25 parishes without working public water systems
 - 86 of 1,301 drinking water facilities inoperable, affecting 146k customers
 - 42 water systems without power or on generators
 - 389k customers under boil-water advisories
- Food: 21 of the 36 planned PODs are operational

TX:


- 11,225 (+310) occupants in non-congregate shelters
- 15 of 19 PODs operational
- 35 of 164 drinking water facilities inoperable, affecting 12k customers

Health and Medical (HHS Senior Leader Brief as of Aug 29)

- Fatalities: LA: 12 confirmed; TX: 4 unconfirmed (media)
- LA: 15 (-2) hospitals evacuated;13 on generator power & 11 nursing homes evacuated; 29 on generator power
- TX: 8 hospitals & 37 (-27) nursing home/assisted living facilities evacuated; 6 hospitals on generator power

Energy (Eagle I as of 7:30 a.m. ET)

- Customers without power: TX: 58k; LA: 305k
- LA: 60 of 90 FEMA generators have arrived



Transportation

- National Guard units cleared 570 miles of roadway
- LA Ports: Houma, Lake Charles, Port Fourchon open w/ restrictions
- TX Ports: Freeport; Houston, Galveston, Beaumont, Orange, Port Arthur Texas City open w/restrictions; Sabine closed; assessments ongoing
- LA: Chennault International Airport closed until Sept 2


- LA & TX EOCs at Partial Activation; State of Emergency declared
- TX: Governor mobilized National Guard
- TX & LA declared Public Health Emergencies

Federal Preparations / Response:

- NRCC at Level I, 24/7
- N-IMAT Gold demobilized from Lake Charles, LA; reconstituting
- National IMAT Red deployed to Baton Rouge, LA
- Region I IMAT deployed to Lake Charles, LA to replace N-IMAT Gold
- · Region V IMAT deployed to Little Rock, AR
- Region VI RRCC at Level II with select ESFs
 - IMAT-1 deployed to Austin; IMAT-2 deployed to Baton Rouge
- Logistics HQ: SMT Atlanta deployed to Camp Beauregard, LA, SMT Fort Worth deployed to Roseland, LA, National ISB Team deployed to Craig Field, AL
- MERS deployed to Baton Rouge, Pineville, and Lake Charles, LA
- US&R deployed to LA: TN-TF1, IN-TF-1, CO-TF1, OH-TF1 & Blue IST
- DMAT: 1 operational (Lake Charles), 2 requested
- 1 CDC LNO deploying to the area
- HSS will coordinate medical evacuation support of ill/injured patients from staging areas (Source: HHS SOC, 30 Aug, as of 3:38 p.m. ET)
- USACE deployed teams to LA & TX

- Major Disaster Declaration FEMA-4559-DR-EM approved Aug 28



COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 5 states/territories, with 8 states/territories in a plateau status, and 42 states/territories on a downward trajectory. 21,704 Federal employees deployed / activated; 1,954 FEMA employees deployed.


Nationwide Testing: 81,776,753 cumulative as of Aug 28

 - Worldwide: 832,587 (+5,928)


Response:

Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall












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
