## National Current Operations and Monitoring FEMA

#### **Significant Incidents or Threats:**

- Severe Thunderstorms, Heavy Rain & Flash Flooding possible Upper Mississippi Valley
- Tropical Cyclone Laura Response / Recovery
- Wildfires
- COVID-19

#### **Tropical Activity:**

- Atlantic:
  - Tropical Depression Omar
  - Disturbance 1: Low (10%)
  - Disturbance 2: High (90%)
  - Disturbance 3: High (70%)
- Eastern Pacific:
  - Disturbance 1: High (70%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

- Request: Major Disaster Declaration New York
- Request: Major Disaster Declaration Maryland

### Tropical Outlook – Atlantic

#### Tropical Depression Omar (Advisory #19 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 515 miles NE of Bermuda
- Moving NNE at 7 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 55 mph
- Likely to dissipate late Sunday or Monday

#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Midway between the coast of Africa and Windward Islands
- Significant development not expected
- 48-hour Formation chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day Formation chance: Low (10%)


#### Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Over the eastern tropical Atlantic
- Tropical depression likely to form late this weekend
- 48-hour Formation chance: Medium (50%)
- 5-day Formation chance: High (90%)

#### Disturbance 3 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- · Forecast to move off the west coast of Africa by tomorrow
- Gradual development is expected; tropical depression likely to form by the middle of next week
- 48-hour Formation chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day Formation chance: High (70%)






### Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific




#### Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 150 miles S of Acapulco, Mexico
- Conditions do not appear favorable for further development
- 48-hour Formation chance: High (70%)
- 5-day Formation chance: High (70%)

### COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 21 states/territories, with 11 (+3) states/territories in a plateau status, and 24 (-3) states/territories on a downward trajectory. 17,577 (-2,951) Federal employees deployed / activated; 1,728 (+5) FEMA employees deployed.


Nationwide Testing: 89,362,165 (+1,074,798) cumulative (as of Sep 4)

  - United States: 6,132,074 (+44,671)
  - o Worldwide: 26,171,112 (+328,460)
- Deaths caused by COVID-19
  - United States: 186,173 (+1,081)
  - Worldwide: 865,154 (+6,525)

#### Response:

- NRCC conducting COVID Response Operations
- Regions I, II, III, V, VI, & X RRCCs at Level III
- Regions IV, VII, VIII, & IX RRCCs are rostered
- Regions VII, VIII & IX COVID-19 working from the Virtual JFO
- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring

### Tropical Cyclone Laura – Response / Recovery





<u>Situation</u>: Restoration of power and water/wastewater infrastructure, sheltering, support to healthcare facilities, and debris removal remain critical priorities.

#### Food, Water, Shelter:

#### LA:

- 11,827 (-127) occupants in congregate and non-congregate shelters
- 62 public water system outages affecting 49k customers; 136 systems under boil water advisories affecting 488k customers
- Wastewater: 83 of 113 systems operational, 11 partly operating 5 inoperable, 14 unknown status

#### TX:

- 9,541(-456) occupants in non-congregate shelters
- 83 of 164 public water systems operational, 46 (-12) on generators serving pop of, 23 inoperable (pop. 5k); 43 boil water notices (pop. 88k)
- Wastewater: 55 of 58 systems operational; 1 partially operational, 2 inoperable Health and Medical:

#### LA:

- Fatalities: 22 (+2) confirmed (4 from falling trees, 1 drowned, 9 from carbon monoxide poisoning, 6 (+2) heat illness, 1 fall, 1 storm cleanup related (FEMA RVI as of 10:45 p.m. ET, Sep 4)
- 13 hospitals evacuated, 11 on generators; 11 nursing homes evacuated, 7 on generators
- · COVID-19 testing sites resuming across the state

#### Energy: (EAGLE-I as of 5:00 a.m. ET, Sep 5)

- Customers without power: LA: 168k (-14k); TX: 5.6k (-800)
- USACE: 84 generators assigned; 80 (+9) temporary emergency power assessments complete (42 water/wastewater facilities); 19 pre-installation inspections complete
















### Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall












### Fire Weather Outlook








