National Current Operations and Monitoring FEMA

Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Severe Thunderstorms, Heavy Rain & Flash Flooding possible Upper Mississippi Valley
- Critical Fire Weather ID, WY, UT, CO, SD, and NE
- Wildfires
- Tropical Cyclone Laura Response / Recovery
- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
 - Post-Tropical Cyclone Omar (FINAL)
 - Disturbance 1: High (90%)
 - Disturbance 2: High (80%)
 - Disturbance 3: Low (10%)
 - Disturbance 4: Low (20%)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Tropical Storm Julio
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

- FMAG Approved Bridger Foothills Fire, MT
- FMAG Approved 316 Fire, WY

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic

Post-Tropical Cyclone Omar (FINAL) (Advisory #21 as of 5:00 p.m. ET)

- 610 miles NE of Bermuda
- Moving N at 10 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 35 mph
- · Last public advisory issued by the National Hurricane Center for this system

Disturbance 1 (Invest 92L) (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- Midway between the west coast of Africa and the Leeward Islands
- Gradual development expected; tropical depression likely to form in the next day or so
- 48-hour Formation chance: High (90%)
- 5-day Formation chance: High (90%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- · Just off the coast of west Africa
- Gradual development expected; tropical depression likely to form by the middle of the week
- 48-hour Formation chance: Medium (50%)
- 5-day Formation chance: High (80%)

Disturbance 3 (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)


- · Over the central Caribbean Sea
- Development, if any, should be slow to occur during the next day or two
- 48-hour Formation chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day Formation chance: Low (10%)

Disturbance 4 (as of 2:00 a.m. ET)

- A couple hundred miles southeast of Bermuda
- Environmental conditions marginally conducive for development during the next several days
- 48-hour Formation chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day Formation chance: Low (10%)







Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



Tropical Storm Julio (Advisory #3 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 150 miles SW of Manzanillo, Mexico
- Moving WNW at 18 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 45 mph
- Tropical-storm-force winds extend up to 35 miles
- Some slight strengthening possible through tonight
- Weakening should begin tomorrow; forecast to dissipate within 72 hours

COVID-19 Update

<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 21 states/territories, with 11 states/territories in a plateau status, and 24 states/territories on a downward trajectory. 17,577 Federal employees deployed / activated; 1,728 FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Sep 4)

Nationwide Testing: 89,362,165 cumulative (as of Sep 4)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (CDC COVID-19 update as of Sep 5)

o United States: 6,181,474 (+49,400)

o Worldwide: 26,468,031 (+296, 032)



- NRCC conducting COVID Response Operations
- Regions I, II, III, V, VI, & X RRCCs at Level III
- · Regions IV, VII, VIII, & IX RRCCs are rostered
- Regions VII, VIII, & IX COVID-19 working from the Virtual JFO
- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring





Tropical Cyclone Laura – Response / Recovery





<u>Situation</u>: Restoration of power and water/wastewater infrastructure, sheltering, support to healthcare facilities, and debris removal remain critical priorities.

Food, Water, Shelter.

LA:

- 12,236 (+409) occupants in congregate and non-congregate shelters
- 58 (-4) public water system outages affecting 41k (-8k) customers; 113 (-23) systems under boil water advisories affecting 411k (-77k) customers
- Wastewater: 83 of 113 systems operational, 11 partly operating, 5 inoperable, 14 status unknown <u>Health and Medical</u>:

LA:

- Fatalities: 22 confirmed (4 from falling trees, 1 drowned, 9 from carbon monoxide poisoning, 6 heat illness, 1 fall, 1 storm cleanup related (FEMA RVI as of 10:45 p.m. ET, Sep 4)
- 11 (-2) hospitals evacuated, 6 (-5) on generators; 8 (-3) nursing homes evacuated, 5 (-2) on generators
- COVID-19 testing sites resuming across the state


Energy: (EAGLE-I as of 8:20 a.m. ET, Sep 6)

- Customers without power: LA: 152k (-16k);
- USACE: 84 generators assigned; 80 temporary emergency power assessments complete (42 water/wastewater facilities); 19 pre-installation inspections complete

FEMA / Federal Preparations/Response:

- NRCC remains activated for COVID-19 Response Operations
- N-IMAT Red & Regions I, V, VI-2 IMATs deployed to LA
- SMTs (2) & N-ISB Team deployed to LA
- MERS (8 Teams) deployed LA










National Weather Forecast











Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall






Severe Weather Outlook






Fire Weather Outlook









