






Hurricane Teddy FORECAST TRACK












Tropical Storm Beta PEAK STORM SURGE FORECAST



Tropical Storm Beta – Response




<u>Situation:</u> Beta made landfall at approximately 11:00 p.m. ET last evening; 5 miles north of Port O'Connor, Texas. Beta is moving toward the northwest and expected to stall inland over Texas today, before moving slowly toward the east-northeast tonight. Significant flash and urban flooding is occurring and expected to continue for the Texas and Louisiana coasts. Rainfall will gradually spread across the Southeast through the week.

- Voluntary evacuations ongoing for coastal counties of TX
- Governor of TX declared State of Emergency

Wildfires – Western US



<u>Situation:</u> Of the over 6 million acres burned, the National Watch Center continues to track 13 active fires that have burned over 1.9 million acres from the West Coast to the Rocky Mountains. Mandatory evacuations continue throughout the impacted regions. Current U.S. Air Quality Index ranges from "Moderate" to Very Unhealthy" for Central California to northern Washington state. No unmet needs at this time.








National Weather Forecast






