

#### **Current Situation:**

- The fire began on Sep 17 and is burning on Federal and private land in and around the subdivisions of Albany, Jelm, Keystone, Rambler, Woods Landing, and Double Creek, WY (pop. 249)
- Threatening 300 homes, utilities, and a watershed

#### Response:

- WY EOC at Partial Activation (Wildfires & COVID-19)
- Region VIII and NWC continue to monitor
- FMAG approved Sep 26



### COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 24 states/territories, with 15 states/territories in a plateau status, and 17 states/territories on a downward trajectory. 19,685 Federal employees deployed / activated; 1,465 FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Sep 25)

Nationwide Testing: 108,609,659 cumulative (as of Sep 25)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (CDC COVID-19 update as of Sep 24)



#### Response:


- NRCC conducting COVID response operations

- 5-day Formation Chance: High (70%)


#### <u>Disturbance 1</u> (Remnants of Pauline) (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 5-day Formation Chance: Low (near 0%)




### Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall












#### Fire Weather Outlook










6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability



#### Wildfires – Western US




<u>Situation:</u> Of the over 7 million acres burned, the National Watch Center continues to track 12 active fires that have burned over 2 million acres from the West Coast to the Rocky Mountains. Mandatory evacuations continue throughout the impacted regions. Current U.S. Air Quality Index ranges from "Moderate" to Very Unhealthy" for Central California to northern Washington state. No reported unmet needs.


