



- Moving W at 10 mph

- Steady strengthening is anticipated
- Expected to become a tropical storm today

Atlantic

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the western Caribbean Sea
- Tropical depression could form late this week or this weekend
- 48-hour Formation Chance: Low (near 0%)
- 5-day Formation Chance: Medium (50%)



Current Situation:

- Started on September 27, in Igo, CA and is burning on State and Private land
- · 3 deaths confirmed
- Threatening the communities of Igo, Ono, Platina, West Redding, West Valley, and Happy Valley; Population 5,500
- Highway 36 is closed
- · Power transmission line in Humboldt County is threatened

Response:

- CA EOC at Full Activation (Wildfires & COVID-19)
- Region IX and NWC continue to monitor
- FMAG approved Sep 28



Wildfires – Western US



<u>Situation:</u> Of the over 7 million acres burned, the National Watch Center continues to track 11 (-2) active fires that have burned over 2 million acres from the West Coast to the Rocky Mountains. Mandatory evacuations continue throughout the impacted regions. No reported unmet needs.



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 26 (+2) states/territories, with 13 (-2) states/territories in a plateau status, and 17 states/territories on a downward trajectory. 19,579 Federal employees deployed / activated; 1,465 FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Sep 28)

Nationwide Testing: 111,348,492 (+2,738,833) cumulative (as of Sep 28)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (CDC COVID-19 update as of Sep 28)



- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring




National Weather Forecast












States with Currently Occupied Units




Individual Assistance
