


- Mixed precipitation and mountain snow in the Pacific Northwest
- Elevated fire weather for portions of Southern California, Texas, Oklahoma and Kansas



Winter Precipitation Outlook








Forecast Snowfall


Forecast Ice Accumulation

6-10 Day Temperature Probability




6-10 Day Precipitation Probability




