National Current Operations & Monitoring



Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Earthquake/Aftershocks Puerto Rico
- Freezing rain Upper Mid-West to New England

Declaration Activity: None

Earthquake (M6.4) – Puerto Rico



<u>Situation:</u> Power generation is at near full restoration across PR; Energy Lifelines continue to trend towards Green. Primary focus for FEMA is mass care support to impacted population and assistance in the build out of the Survivor Base Camps. Aftershocks continue but are consistent with the USGS forecast of 56% (+3%) probability for M5.0 earthquakes in the next 7 days.

Safety & Security: Green

Food, Water & Sheltering: Yellow

- Five survivor base camps being established
- 42 (+13) shelters open, 7,965 (+3,199) occupants

Health & Medical: Green

- Rolling blackouts may continue and potential remains for outages due to aftershocks
- Repairs ongoing at several generating plants; return to service estimates by Feb 10
- Approximately 6.8k customers without power due to damaged feeders and equipment










National Weather Forecast








Winter Precipitation Outlook


Forecast Snowfall


