Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Earthquake/Aftershocks – Puerto Rico
- Freezing rain – Upper Mid-West to New England

Declaration Activity: None

Earthquake (M6.4) – Puerto Rico



Situation: Power generation is at near full restoration across PR; Energy Lifelines continue to trend towards Green. Primary focus for FEMA is mass care support to impacted population and assistance in the build out of the Survivor Base Camps. Aftershocks continue but are consistent with the USGS forecast of 56% (+3%) probability for M5.0 earthquakes in the next 7 days.

Lifeline Impacts: (Source: NRCC SLB, as of 06:00 a.m. EST, Jan 15)

Safety & Security: Green

Food, Water & Sheltering: Yellow

- Five survivor base camps being established
- 42 (+13) shelters open, 7,965 (+3,199) occupants

Health & Medical: Green

Energy: Yellow

- Rolling blackouts may continue and potential remains for outages due to aftershocks
- Repairs ongoing at several generating plants; return to service estimates by Feb 10
- Approximately 6.8k customers without power due to damaged feeders and equipment

Communication: Green

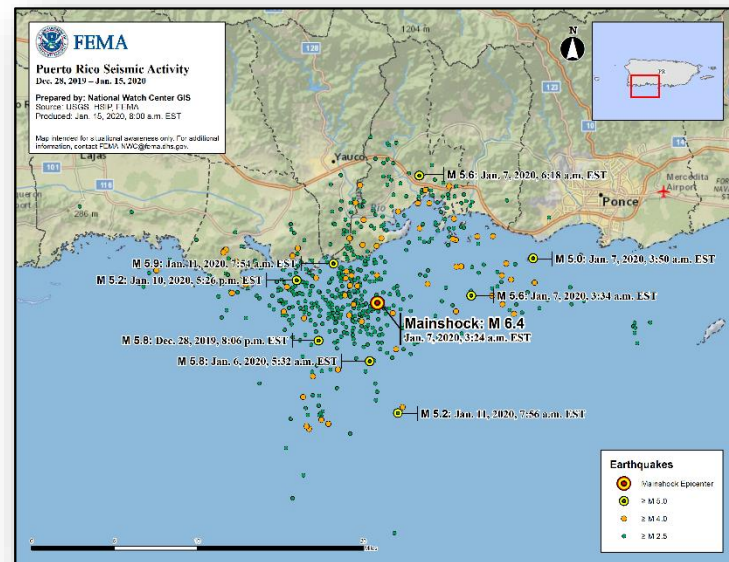

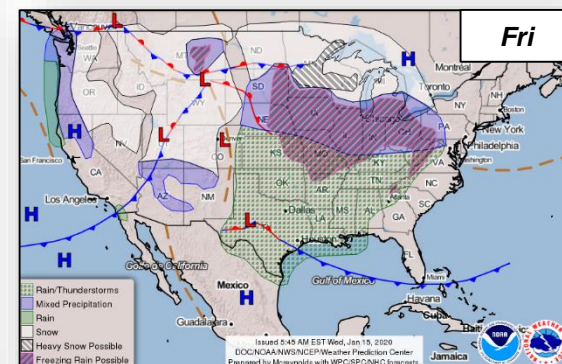

National Weather Forecast



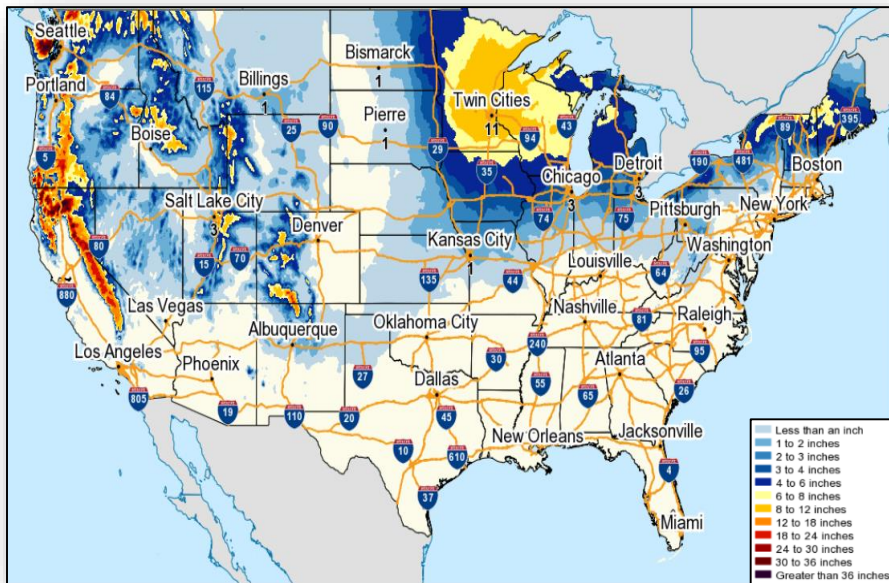

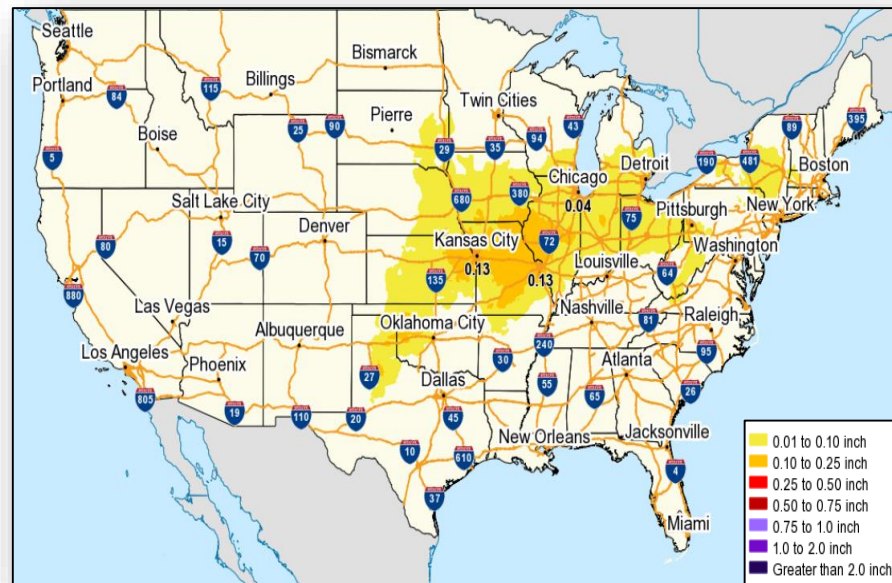
Winter Precipitation Outlook

Forecast Snowfall



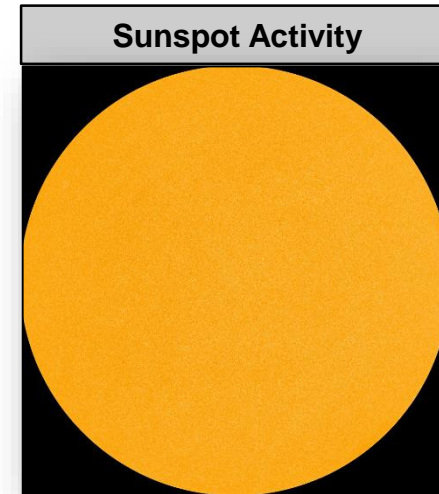
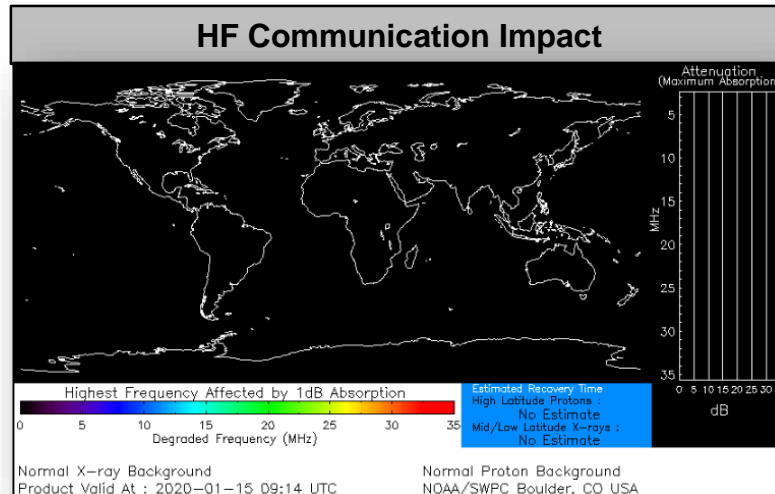
Forecast Ice Accumulation


