Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Freezing Rain – Southern/Central Appalachians spanning the Ohio Valley into the Great Lakes
- Heavy snow – Northern Intermountain
- Earthquake/Aftershocks – Puerto Rico

Declaration Activity:

- Approval: Major Disaster Declaration – FEMA-DR-4474 – Vermont

Earthquake (M6.4) – Puerto Rico



Situation: Primary focus for FEMA is replenishment of commodity resources, meeting mass care shelter requirements, power restoration, providing crisis counseling, and conducting damage assessments. **Aftershocks continue, strongest in the last 24 hours was M4.3.**

Lifeline Impacts: (Source: NRCC SLB, as of 6:00 a.m. EST, Jan 17)

Food, Water & Shelter: Yellow

- Five survivor base camps being established
- **13 (-28) shelters open, 3,502 (-3,957) occupants** (ESF6, as of 7:34 a.m. EST)

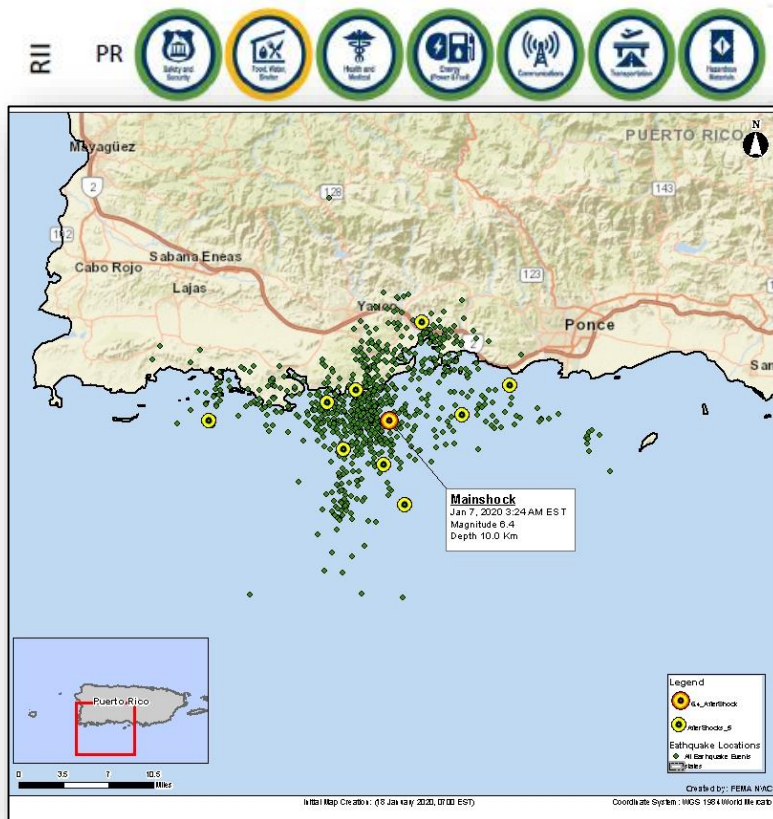

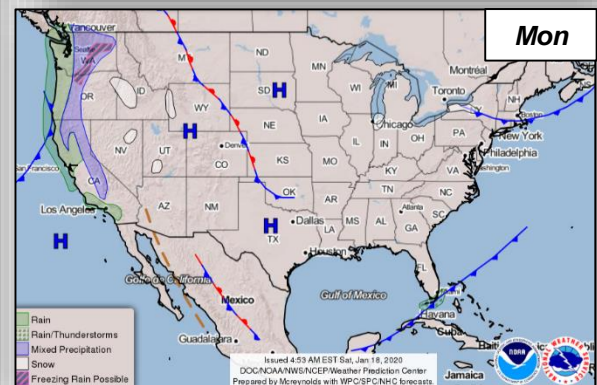
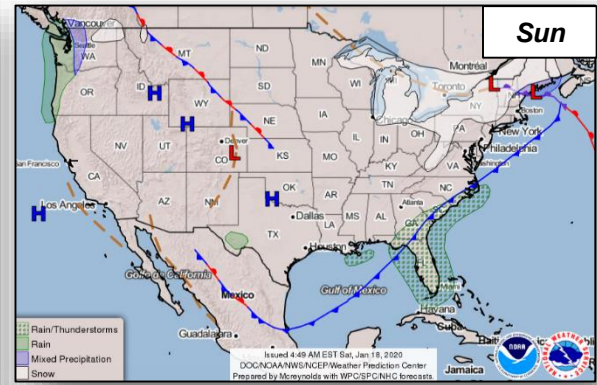
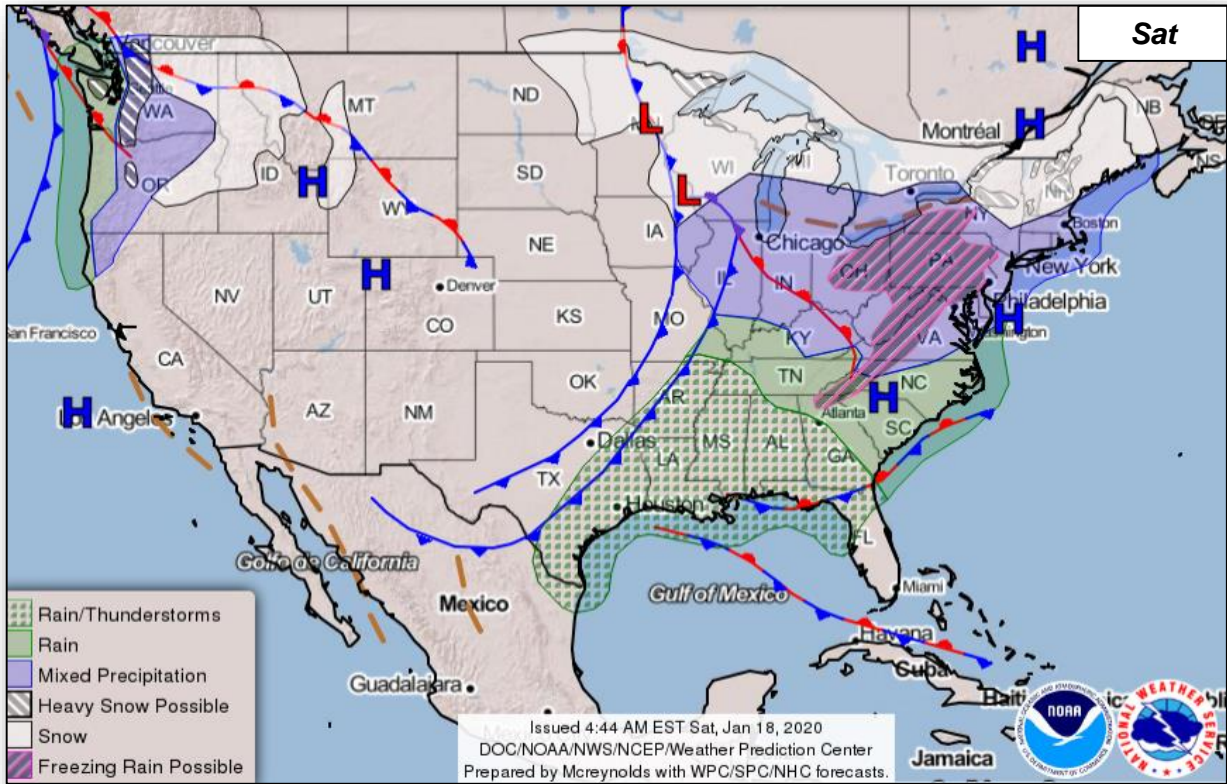
- Puerto Rico EOC - Full Activation
- Approved: Disaster Declaration – Puerto Rico (FEMA-4473-DR-PR)

FEMA / Federal Response:

- Region I IMAT and Region II IMAT and LNOs to PR
- **ROC deactivated; NWC returned to Monitoring**
- Deployed:
 - N-IMAT Blue and N-IMAT Gold deployed to PR; Gold in process of demobilizing
 - ESF #3 Infrastructure Assessment Planning and Response Team (PRT)
 - US&R activated (White IST & FL-TF2)
 - Staging Management Team (SMT)/National ISB Team to DC Caribbean



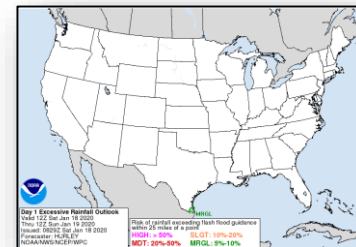
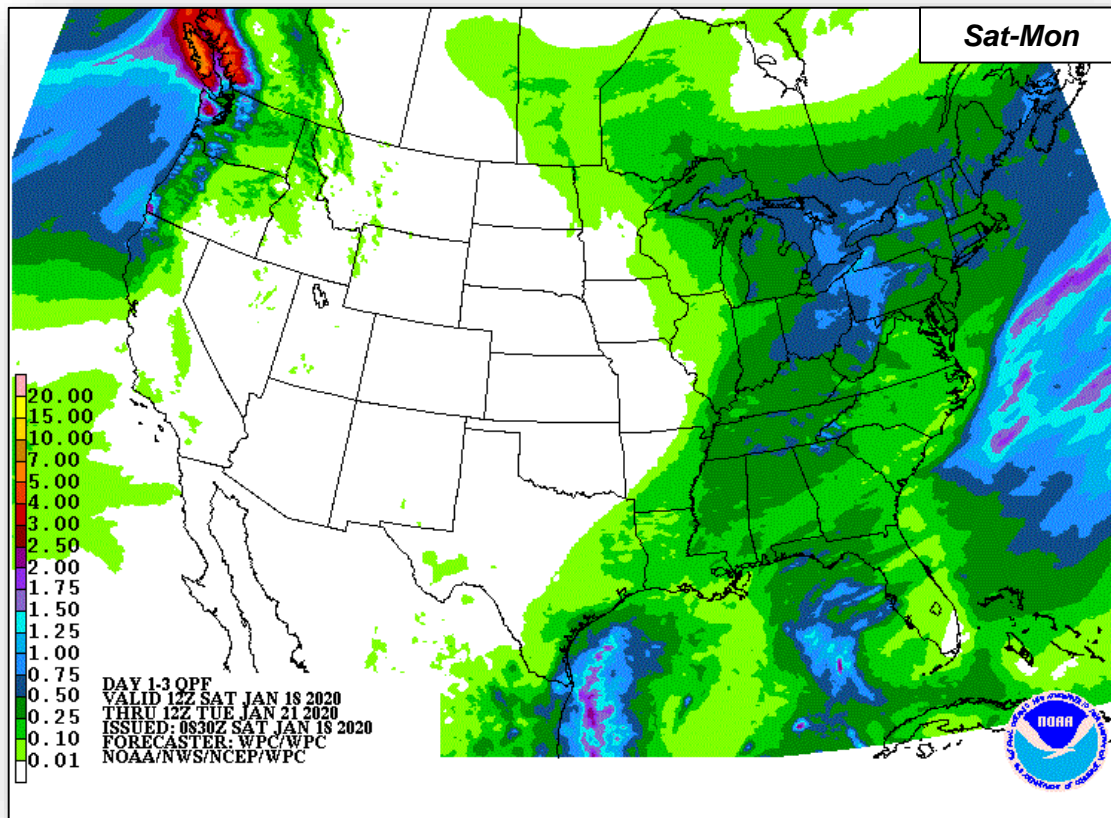
National Weather Forecast



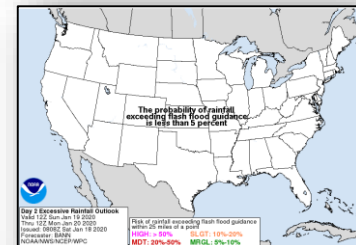
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



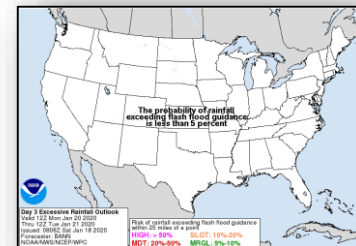

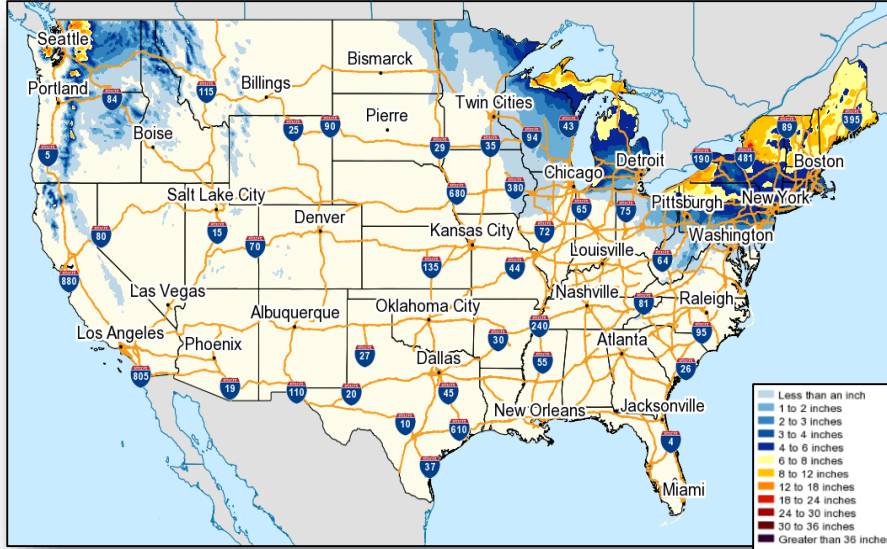

Forecast Snowfall

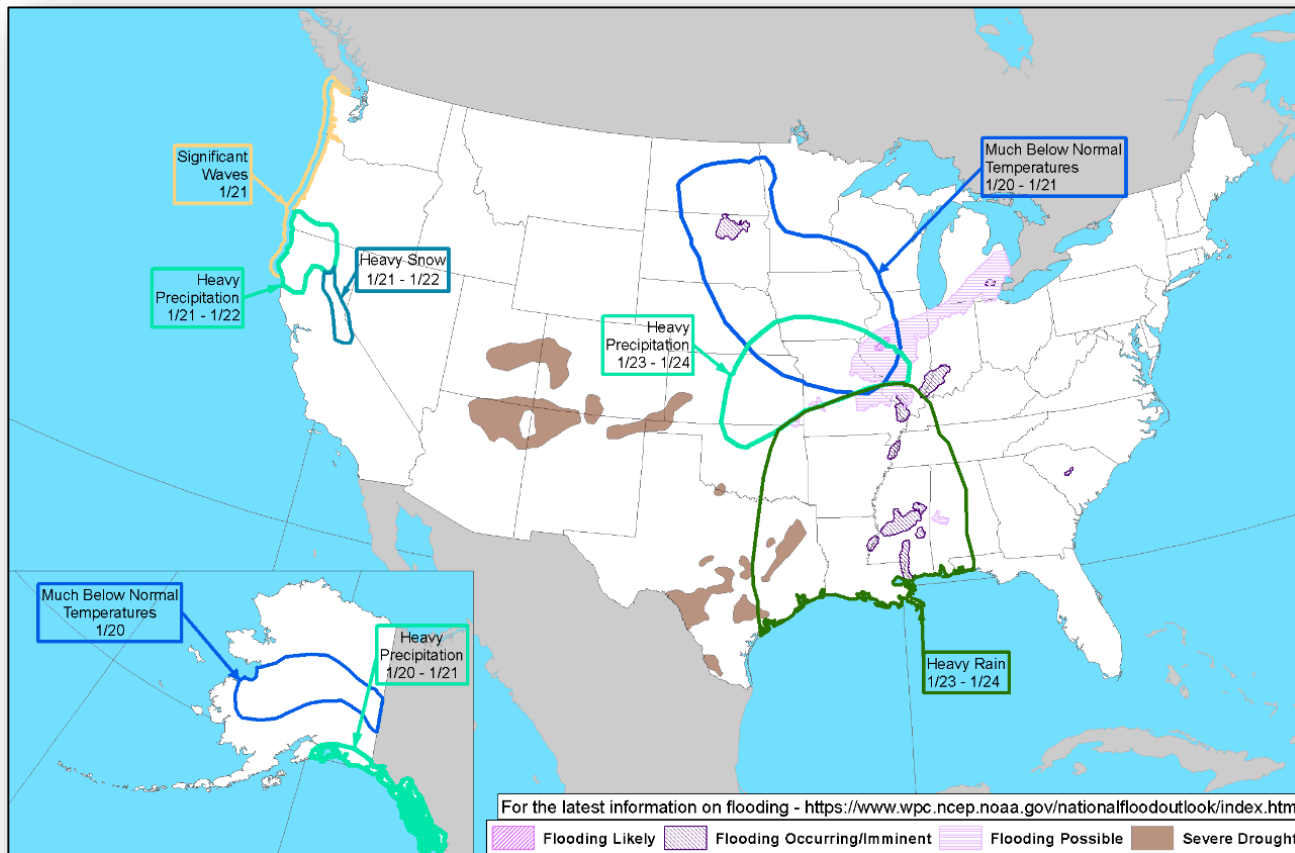


Forecast Ice Accumulation
