## Situation

Tropical Cyclone 18P (Wasi) (as of 4:00 a.m. ET)

- 188 miles S of Pago Pago, American Samoa
- Moving SSE at 12 mph
- Maximum sustained winds 46 mph
- Flash Flood Watch in effect
- No request for FEMA assistance

## Lifeline Impacts

Food, Water, Shelter:

- 7 (-5) shelters open; 270 (-124) occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Count)

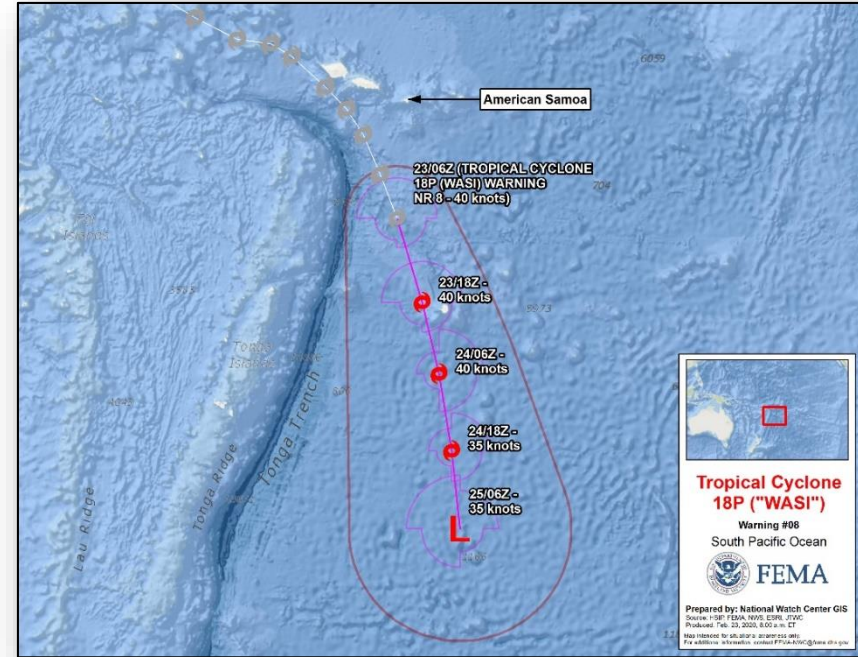
Transportation: Seaport and airport reopened

- American Samoa EOC at Full Activation (already activated for measles outbreak)

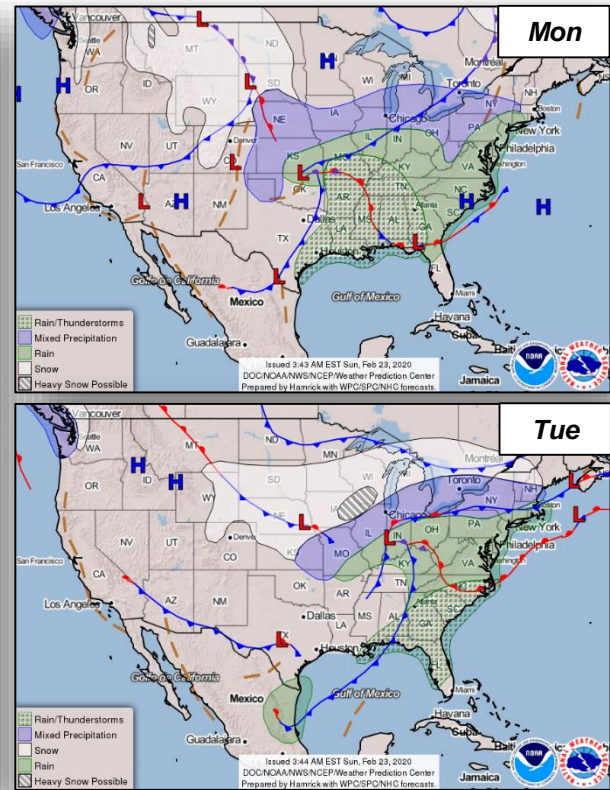
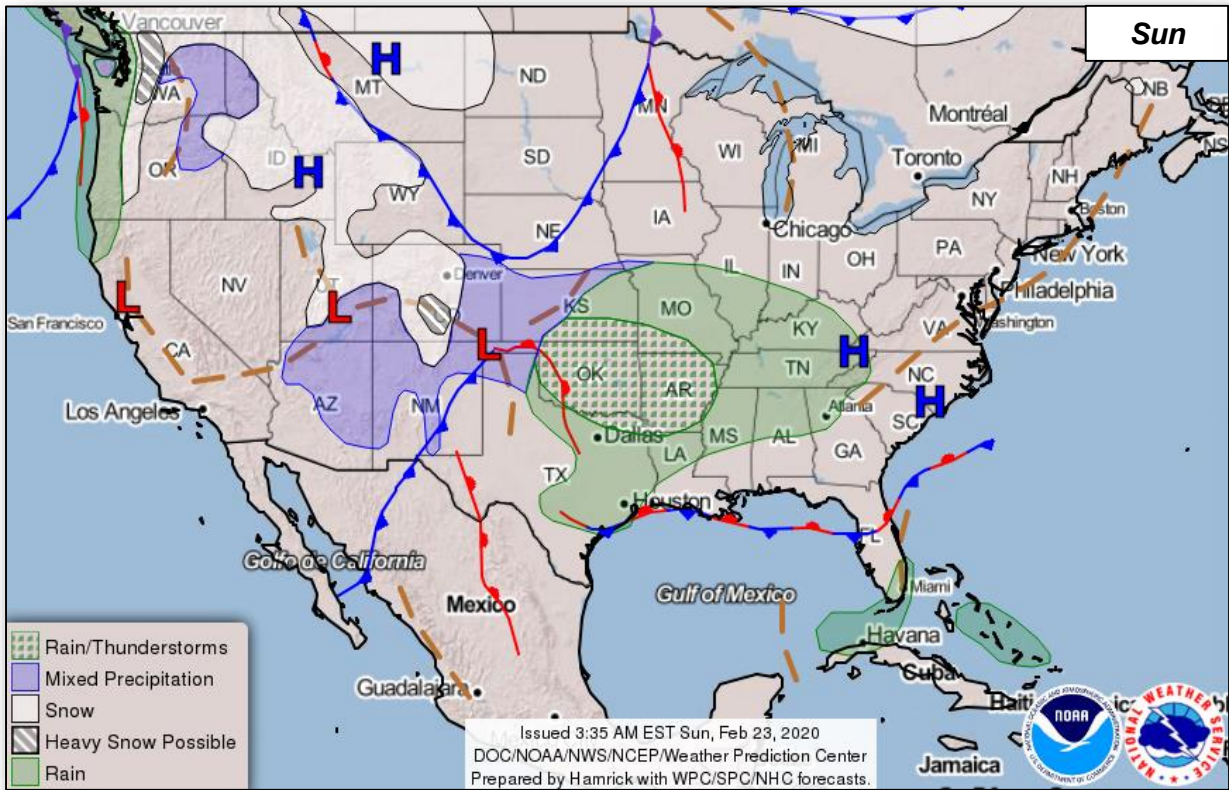
## FEMA / Federal Preparations and Response

- Region IX deployed IMAT 1 (nine people) Point Team, ESF 3, and MERS assets to American Samoa
- Three DoD LNOs deployed to American Samoa; demobilizing today
- NWC and Region IX RWC at Steady State; continuing to monitor

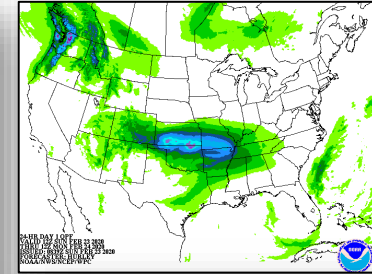
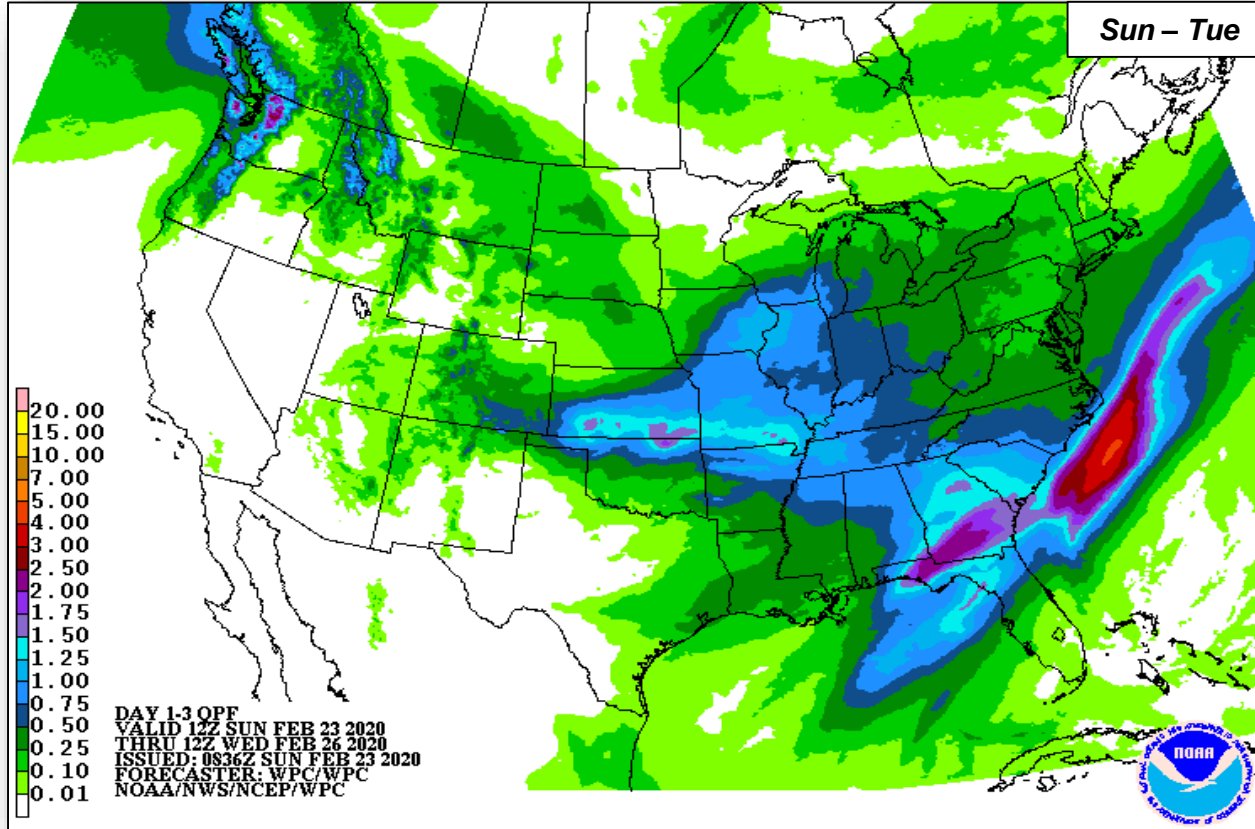




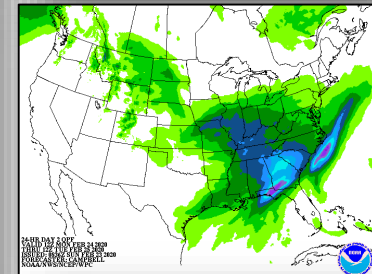

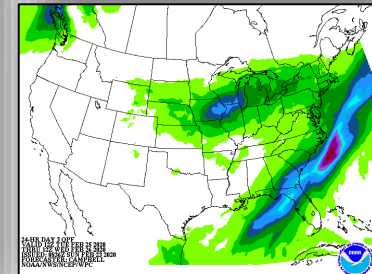

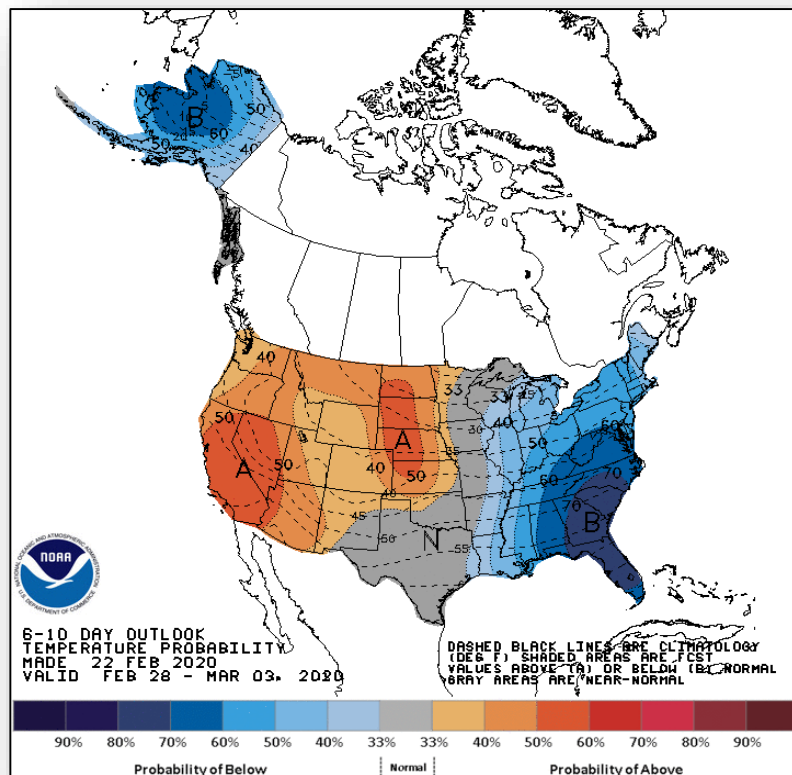

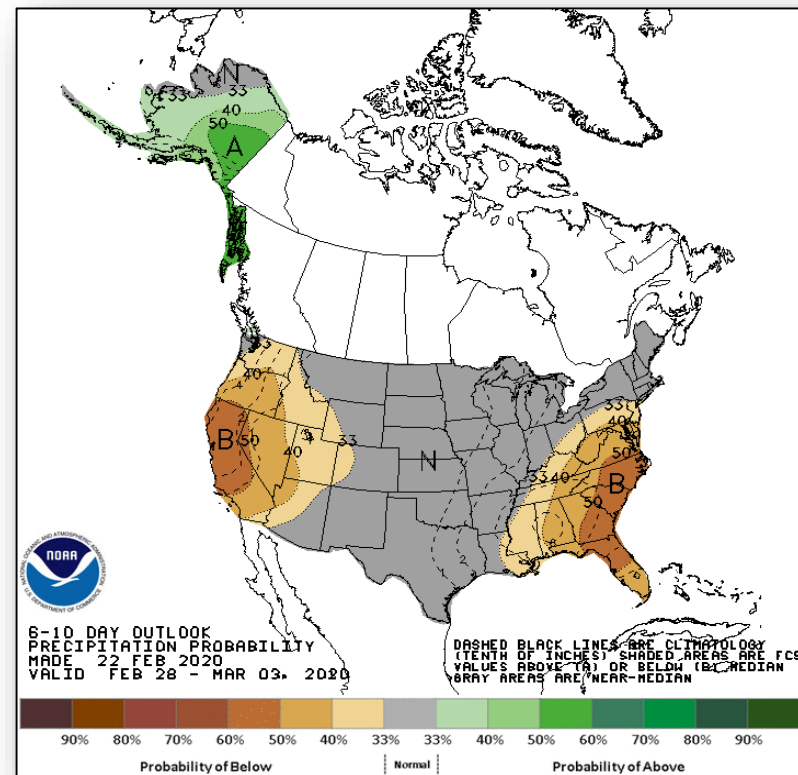
# Long Range Outlooks – Feb 28-Mar 3
