## Questions from the field...

Is the state considering flexibility with reading camp invites?

The state is currently looking at MOY data...a memo will be sent to districts with additional guidance soon.

Have districts received summer stipend funding?

Yes, funding was sent to district finance departments for payout to teachers who attended and signed in at one of the Summer Istation training. Teachers should receive this payment via their paycheck.

When will districts receive devices/headphones?

This process is currently in procurement...districts will receive devices/headphones once this process is complete. When will districts receive twice retained tutoring and reading camp funding?

Distribution of funding for twice retained tutoring and reading camp is being processed and will be sent to districts soon.
