

## Situation:




- Fire began on March 7 and is burning on state and private land in and around the city of Beaver, OK (population 5,500)
- Threatening 714 homes, businesses, buildings, infrastructure, utilities and equipment
- 11,000 acres burned; 0% contained
- Mandatory and voluntary evacuations in effect for over 3,000 people
- Shelter numbers are unknown at this time
- 6 homes destroyed
- No fatalities; 1 injury

## Response

- OK EOC at Monitoring (COVID-19)
- FEMA Region VI at Steady State, continues to monitor
- FEMA NWC at Steady State, continues to monitor
- FMAG was approved on March 7, 2020







# Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall







**6-10 Day Precipitation Probability**





