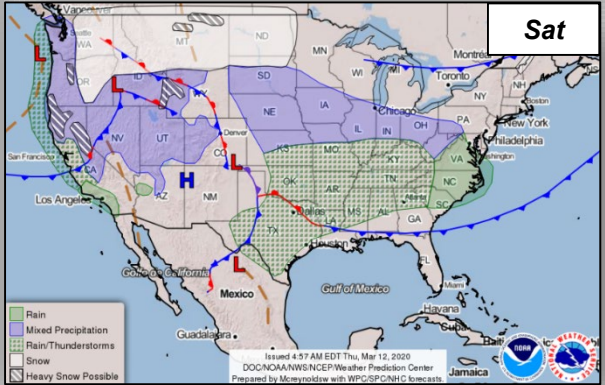
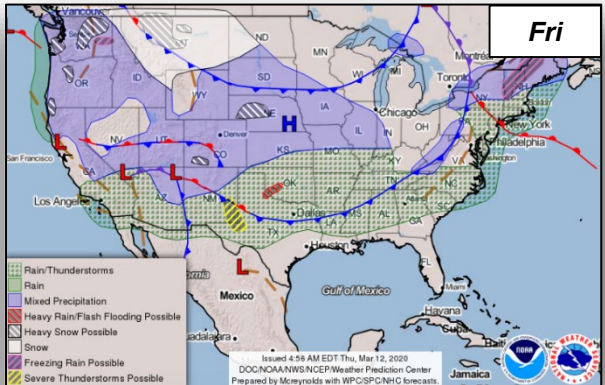
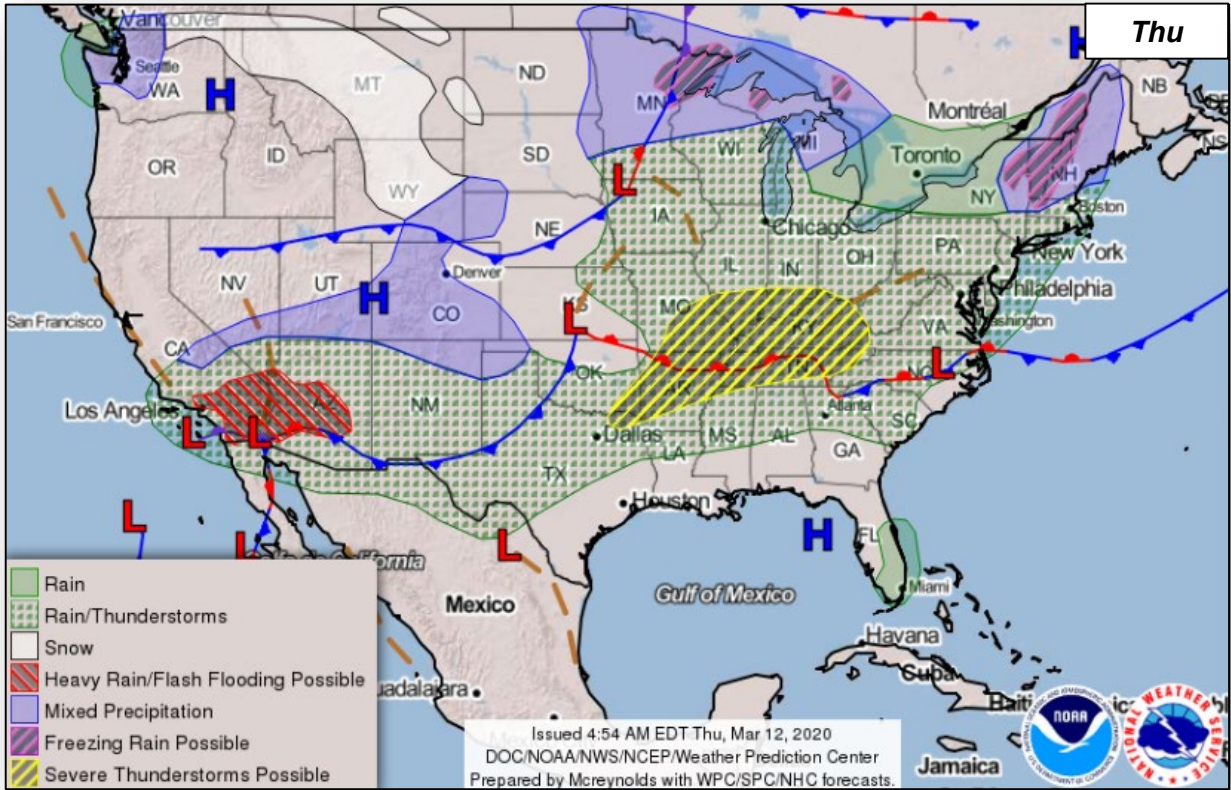
Significant Incidents or Threats:

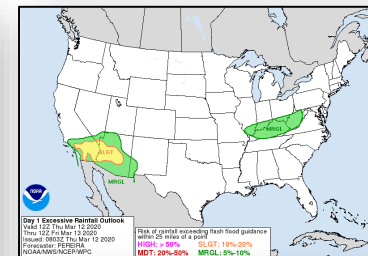
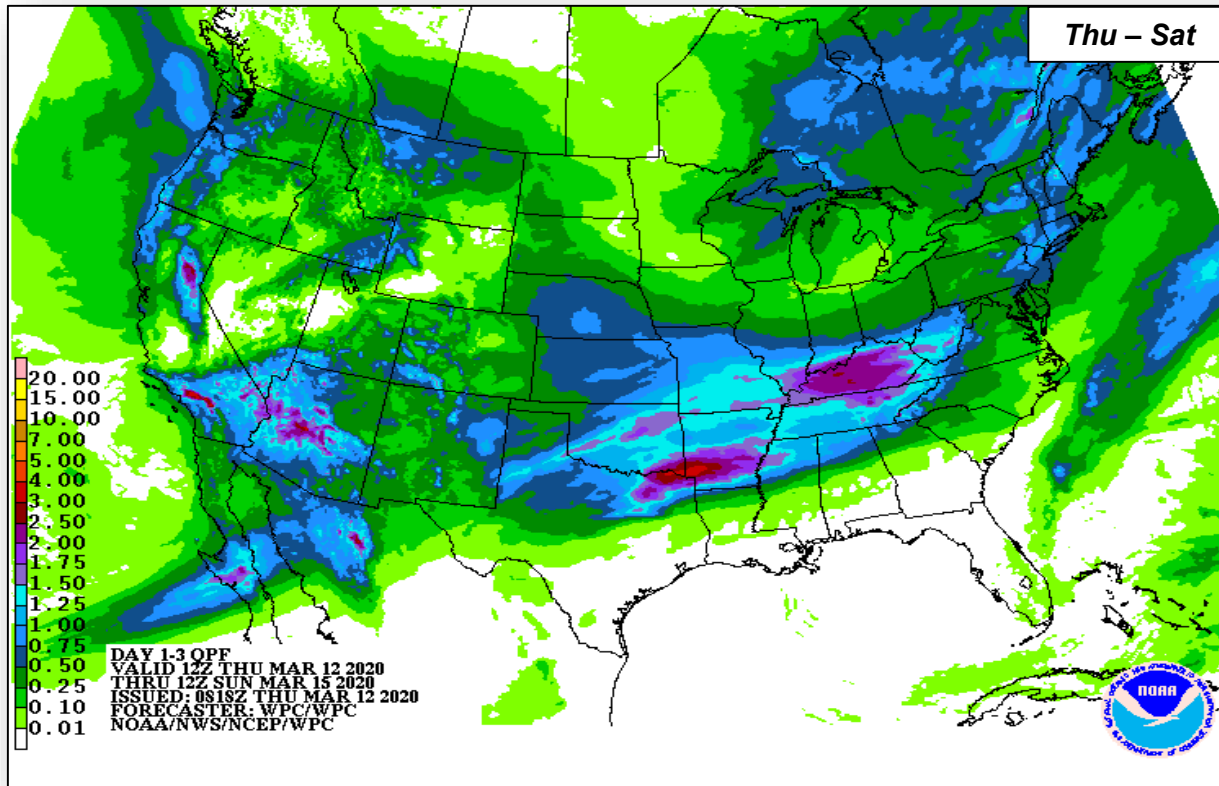
National Weather Forecast



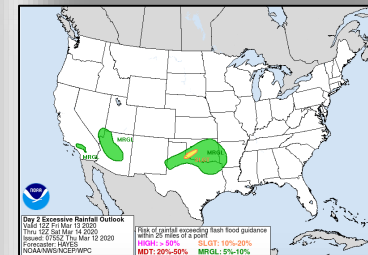
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall



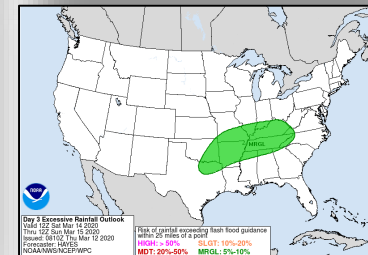

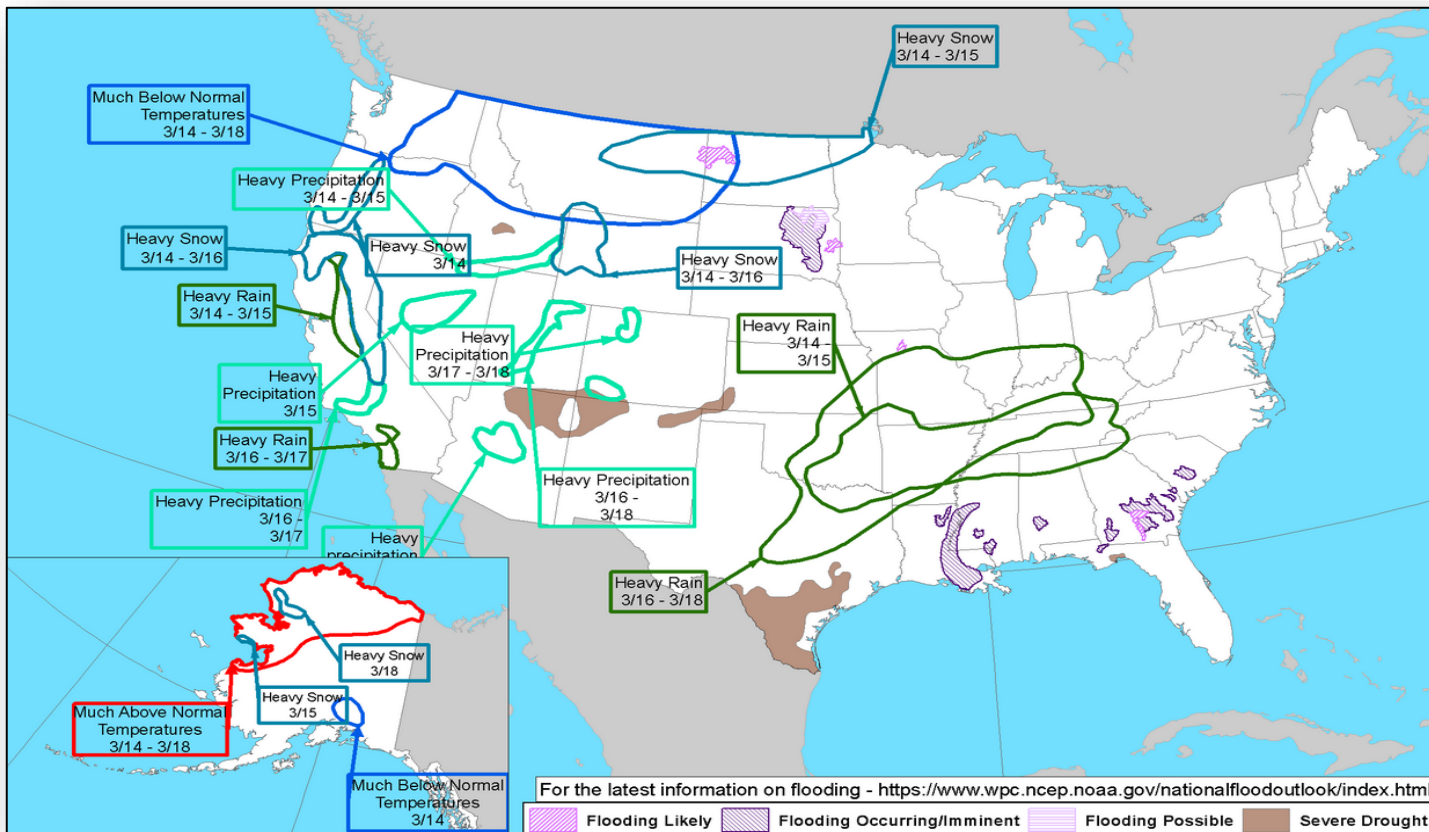
Severe Weather Outlook

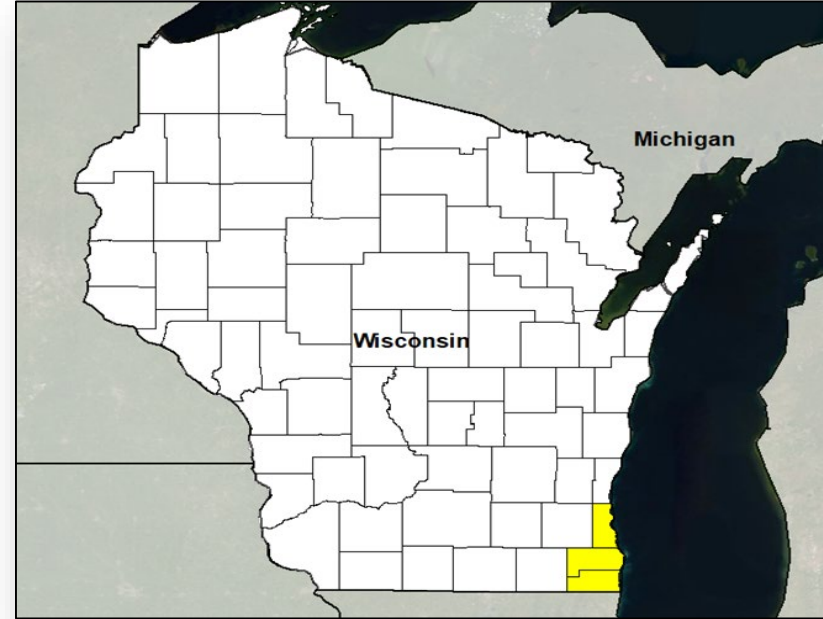
