COUNTY MANAGER'S

DECLARATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY

The County Manager of Arlington County, Virginia does hereby find:

- That due to the growing occurrences of COVID-19, a communicable disease that threatens the public health, the County of Arlington is facing dangerous public health and safety conditions that necessitate the proclamation of the existence of an emergency;
- 2. The Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia has declared a statewide state of emergency due to COVID-19;
- 3. Under the authority of the Code of Virginia § 44-146.21, the County Manager has declared a Local Emergency;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that I declare that a Local Emergency now exists throughout Arlington County effective at 7:00 p.m. on March 13, 2020.

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that the Comprehensive Emergency Management Program Emergency Operations Plan is now in effect.
