FEMA Response:

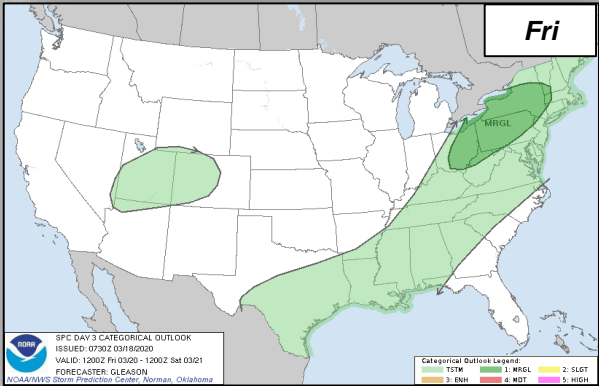
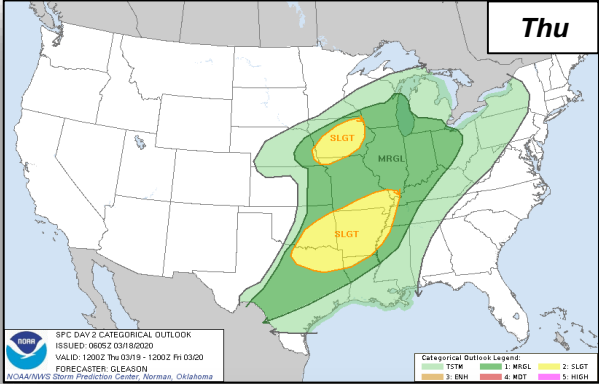
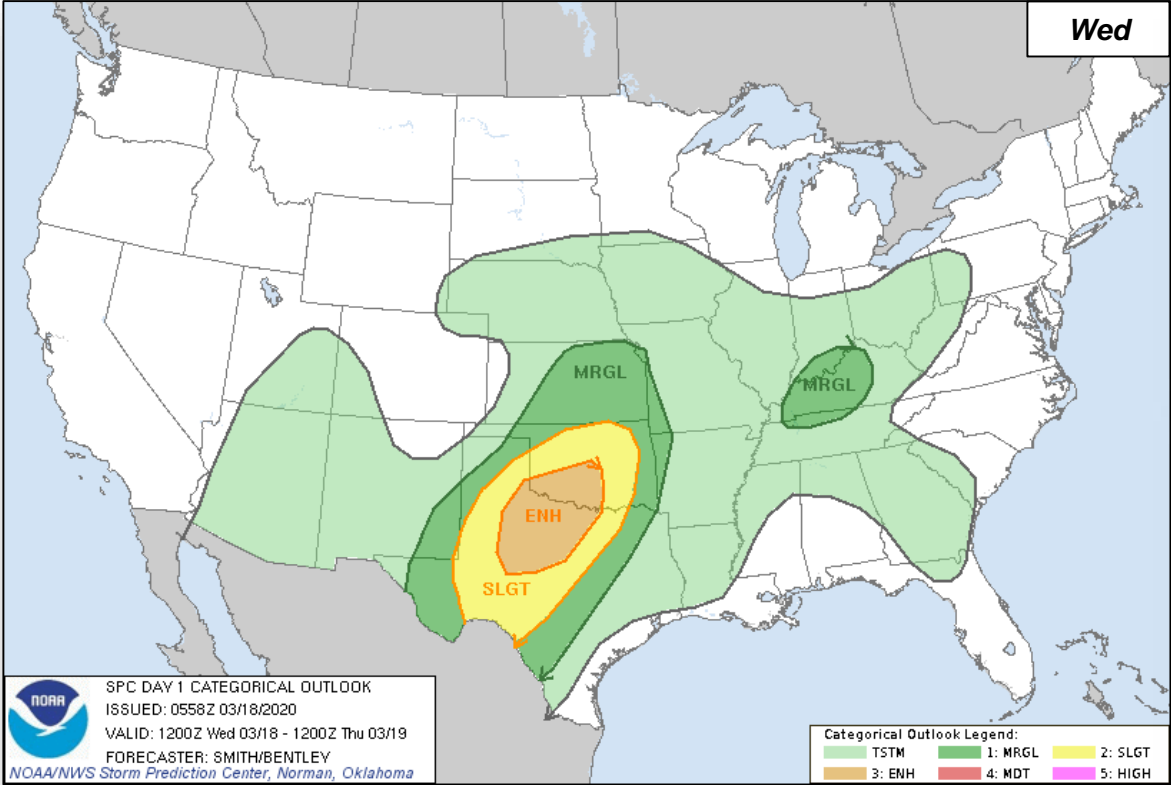
- POTUS declared National Emergency on Mar 13
- 57 Emergency Declarations were declared in support of the nationwide emergency
- NRCC at Level II (day shift)
- All RRCCs at Level III (day shift)
- IMAT-As deployed to 20 (+2) states and territories
- LNOs: Deployed to 24 (+10) states and territories

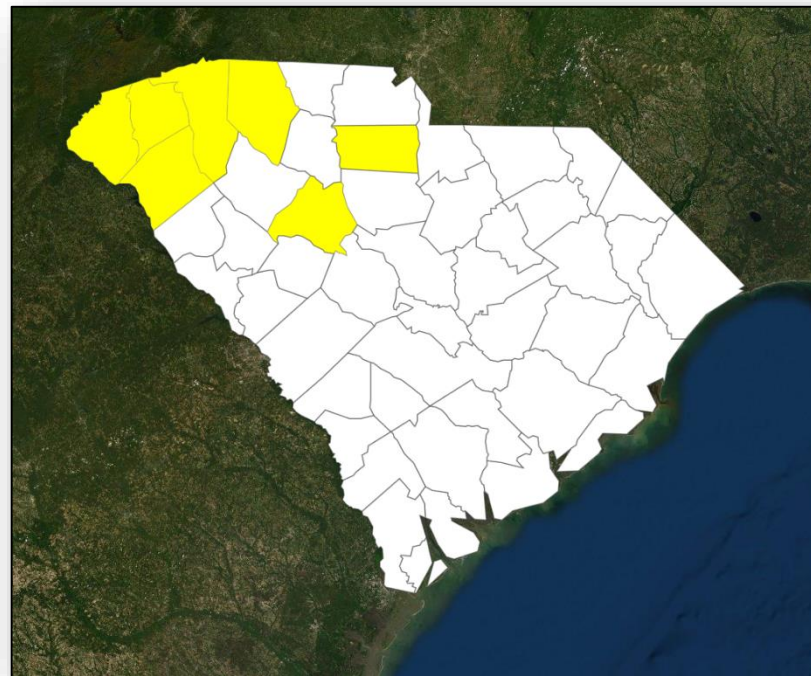
