



- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests



Central Pacific

Eastern Pacific

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located several hundred miles S of the coast of southwestern coast Mexico
- 48-hour Formation Chance: Medium (40%)
- 5-day Formation Chance: Medium (60%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Could form SSE of the Gulf of Tehuantepec
- Gradual development possible
- 48-hour Formation Chance: Low (near 0%)
- 5-day Formation Chance: Low (20%)

Atlantic

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- · Located over central Caribbean Sea
- Tropical depression likely to form next week
- 48-hour Formation Chance: High (70%)
- 5-day Formation Chance: High (80%)

Disturbance 2 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located over the central tropical Atlantic
- 48-hour Formation Chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day Formation Chance: Low (10%)

Disturbance 3 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 1.000 miles ESE of Bermuda
- 48-hour Formation Chance: Low (10%)
- 5-day Formation Chance: Low (10%)

Tropical Outlook – Atlantic



Tropical Storm Gamma (Advisory #8A as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 110 miles ENE of Progreso, Mexico
- Maximum sustained winds 50 mph
- Moving N at 4 mph
- Tropical storm force winds extend outward up to 115 miles
- Some re-strengthening expected today




Tropical Outlook – Eastern Pacific



Hurricane Marie (CAT 2) (Advisory #21 as of 5:00 a.m. ET)

- 1,185 miles W of the southern tip of Baja California
- Moving NW at 8 mph
- Maximum sustained winds at 105 mph
- Hurricane strength winds extend 45 miles
- Tropical storm force winds extends 150 miles
- Forecast to become a tropical storm by Sunday night



Wildfires – Western US



<u>Situation:</u> Of the over 7 million acres burned, the National Watch Center continues to track 11 active fires that have burned nearly 2 million acres from the West Coast to the Rocky Mountains. Mandatory evacuations continue throughout the impacted regions. No reported unmet needs.









Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall
















COVID-19 Update



<u>Situation:</u> Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 29 states/territories, with 8 states/territories in a plateau status, and 19 states/territories on a downward trajectory. 16,763 National Guard deployed / activated; 1,293 FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 2)

Nationwide Testing: 115,475,943 cumulative (as of Oct 2)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally (CDC COVID-19 as of Oct 3)

o Worldwide: 34,396,222 (+312,868)




