FEMA

Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Tropical Cyclone Delta Impacts and Stabilization
- COVID-19
- Wildfires – Western U.S.

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
 - Disturbance 1: Low (30%)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Disturbance 1: High (70%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests

Situation: TC Delta has dissipated. FEMA Regions and their state/local partners have no reported unmet needs or shortfalls, and they are effectively managing recovery efforts through the operational Joint Field Offices. Lifelines are reported as green/stable except for health and medical (yellow for COVID), and energy (yellow for power outages)

Lifeline Impacts: (FEMA NRCC SLB, as of 12:00 p.m. ET, Oct 11)

Safety and Security

- Mandatory / voluntary evacuations in effect for 23 parishes

Food, Water, Shelter

- 98 drinking water systems serving a population of 63.5k are non-operational; 32 systems under boil water advisories. No reported unmet needs.
- 7 (+2) congregate shelters / 820 (+41) occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Count, Oct 12)

Health and Medical

- 31 (+1) medical facilities evacuated/sheltering in place; 79 (+25) on generator power. No reported unmet needs.

Energy: (Eagle-I as of 8:00 a.m. ET, Oct 11)


- 192k (-106k) (8.9%) customers without power; restoration ongoing.

Communications

- 3 (-18) of 141 LWIN sites throughout LA are out of service; no significant impact
- 3 - 911 Dispatch Centers being rerouted; no significant impact

Transportation

- Port status: Lake Charles, Iberia, Vermillion Bay closed; Morgan City & Port Fourchon open w/restrictions. All others open.

- LA EOC at Partial Activation (TC Delta & COVID-19); Governor declared State of Emergency; EM approved; National Guard activated

- NRCC at Level III (days) (COVID); NWC at Monitoring

Situation: Upward trajectory in COVID-19 case count continues across 27 states/territories, with 13 jurisdictions in a plateau status, and 16 jurisdictions on a downward trajectory; 1,231 FEMA employees deployed. (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 9)


Nationwide Testing: 123,094,477 cumulative (COVID-19 SLB, as of Oct 9)

COVID-19 positive cases continue to increase globally



Response:


- NRCC conducting COVID response operations

- NWC, all RWCs, and MOCs are monitoring








Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Remnants of Norbert are a few hundred miles SW of the southwestern coast of Mexico
- Moving slowly WNW or NW
- A tropical depression is likely to form in a few days
- 48-hour formation chance: **Medium (60%)**
- 5-days formation chance: **High (70%)**


Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 750 miles east of the Windward Islands
- Moving westward at 15 mph
- Slow development possible during the next day or so
- 48-hour formation chance: **Low (30%)**
- 5-days formation chance: **Low (30%)**


National Weather Forecast



Fire Weather Outlook





6-10 Day Precipitation Probability





