National Current Operations and Monitoring FEMA

Significant Incidents or Threats:

- Tropical Cyclone Delta FINAL
- Wildfires Western U.S.
- COVID-19

Tropical Activity:

- Atlantic:
 - Disturbance 1: Low (20%)
- Eastern Pacific:
 - Disturbance 1: High (70%)
- Central Pacific: No new tropical cyclones expected during the next five days
- Western Pacific: No activity affecting U.S. interests


Tropical Outlook

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- Located ESE of the Socorro Island, Mexico
- Moving slowly WNW
- A short-lived tropical depression could form today or tomorrow
- Formation chance through 48 hours: High (70%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: High (70%)

Atlantic

Disturbance 1 (as of 8:00 a.m. ET)

- 500 miles E of the Windward Islands
- Slight development possible today
- Formation chance through 48 hours: Low (20%)
- Formation chance through 5 days: Low (20%)

Tropical Cyclone Delta - FINAL



Situation: TC Delta has dissipated. FEMA Regions and their state/local partners have no reported unmet needs or shortfalls, and they are effectively managing recovery efforts through the operational Joint Field Offices.

Lifeline Impacts: (FEMA-3547-EM-LA SLB 10:30 a.m. ET, October 12, 2020)

Food, Water, Shelter

- 71 (-27) water systems serving a population of 32k (-31k) are non-operational, 74 (+42) systems serving a population of 227k (+58k) are under boil water advisories. Restoration ongoing.
- 3 (-4) congregate shelters / 729 (-146) occupants (ARC Midnight Shelter Count)

Health and Medical:

6 (-25) medical facilities evacuated; 27 (-52) on generator power (HHS SLB as of 5:00 p.m. ET, October 12, 2020)

Energy: (Eagle-I as of 7:45 a.m. ET, Oct 13)

• 100k (-92k) (4.5%) customers without power; restoration ongoing.








Fire Weather Outlook


